Senior K Trevor Moore has made 126 consecutive extra points heading into week nine, a school record. He is also holds the school record for most PATs made in a career.



North Texas (4-3, 3-1 C-USA) returns home to host Conference USA East division foe Old Dominion (2-5, 0-3 C-USA) Saturday at 5:30 p.m. CT at Apogee Stadium in Denton. The Mean Green were beaten 69-31 at Florida Atlantic last week, while Old Dominion enters week nine after a 35-31 loss at the hands of Western Kentucky in Norfolk, Virginia.

Saturday's game will be broadcast live on ESPN3 with Doug Anderson (pxp) and LaDarrin McClane (analyst) as well as on the radio on the Mean Green Sports Network with Dave Barnett (pxp) and Hank Dickenson (analyst).

Next Up

The Mean Green head out on the road next week for a key C-USA West division matchup at Louisiana Tech. That game kicks off at 2:30 p.m. CT from Joe Aillet Stadium in Ruston, Louisiana, and will be broadcast live on Stadium on Facebook and the Mean Green Sports Network.

Mean Green Lead C-USA West

Despite last week's loss at Florida Atlantic, the Mean Green enter Week 9 of the season atop the Conference USA's West division at 3-1.

The Mean Green hold a head-to-head tiebreaker over Southern Miss (also 3-1 in conference play), by virtue of the 43-28 win in Hattieburg last month. With four conference games remaining, North Texas controls its own destiny.

First Downs

North Texas has posted 166 first downs over the first five games, and their 23.9 first downs per game ranks second-best in Conference USA. * The Mean Green had 25 first downs last week at Florida Atlantic.

Score!

The Mean Green are averaging 36.3 points per game through seven games, which is second in Conference USA and ranks 28th in the country.

- * North Texas averaged 24.8 ppg in 2016, taking an 11.5 ppg jump in 2017.
- * The Mean Green made a 9.6 ppg jump in 2016, head coach Seth Littrell's first season in Denton.

Explosive Plays

The Mean Green had eight plays of 15-yards or more from scrimmage last week at Florida Atlantic.

* Sophomore quarterback Mason Fine (Locust Grove, Oklahoma) completed six passes of 15 yards or more, as well as a 16-yard run last week at Florida Atlantic. He completed two passes of 20 or more yards, a 25-yard pass to freshman receiver Jaelon Darden (Houston) and a 20-yard

connection with receiver Michael Lawrence (Sweetwater, Texas).

* Fine has thrown 10 touchdown passes of 20 or more yards this season.

Wilson's Success Drives Mean Green

Mean Green senior running back Jeffery Wilson (Elkhart, Texas), two-time Conference USA Player of the Week (weeks one and four), carried 11 times for 49 yards last week at Florida Atlantic, with one touchdown. Wilson ranks inside the top 15 nationally in three categories (rushing yards per game - 114.0, rushing yards - 798 and rushing touchdowns - 10) and is 17th nationally in yards per carry at 6.65.

- * Wilson has 120 carries for 798 yards and 10 touchdowns this season through seven games and is on pace for 1,368 yards and 17 touchdowns over the course of a 12-game season. That would rank as the sixth-best in school history in a single season in yardage and tie for second-best in program history in rushing touchdowns.
- * Wilson had one rushing score last week at Florida Atlantic when he scored from six yards out. Wilson has now scored at least one rushing touchdown in seven of his last eight games, dating back to the Zaxby's Heart of Dallas Bowl in 2016.
- * The 30 carries Wilson had on Sept. 30 against Southern Miss are the second-most by anyone in Conference USA this season in a single game.
- * Wilson ranks second in C-USA in rushing with 114.0 yards per game, which is 14th nationally, is also second in the conference in rushing yards (798), which ranks 14th in the country and is tied for 11th nationally in rushing touchdowns (10), which is second in C-USA, behind last week's opponent, Florida Atlantic's Devin Singletary, who is tied for the national lead with 14.
- * His 6.65 yards per carry ranks 17th-best in the nation and he is second in C-USA, behind Florida Atlantic's Greg Howell, who has 69 carries.
- * His 211-yard performance in week four tied for the third-best in the nation that week.
- * Wilson has rushed for 2,788 yards in his career, which places him fifth in school

history.

- * Wilson is 332 yards from Ja'Quay Wilburn's (1997-00) fourth spot.
- * Wilson is in a tie for fifth in school history in rushing touchdowns (26) with Ken Bahnsen (1950-52) and is just one behind Jamario Thomas (2004-07) for fourth.
- * Wilson has 494 career carries and is expected to pass the 500 mark for his career Saturday against Old Dominion. He ranks eighth in school history in that category and is 38 carries behind Ken Washington (1974-77) for seventh.
- * Last season Wilson finished with 169 carries for 936 yards and 14 touchdowns, which were career highs for a single season in just 11 games.

Mason More Than Fine

Sophomore quarterback Mason Fine (Locust Grove, Oklahoma) completed 31-of-47 passes for 283 yards and two touchdowns last week at Florida Atlantic. Fine has completed 153-of-244 passes (62.7 percent) for 2,079 yards with 16 touchdowns and seven interceptions.

- * Fine surpassed the 2,000-yard mark for the season last week at Florida Atlantic, and he is just 11 yards shy of the 10th spot for most single-season passing yards in program history. Mitch Maher holds the 10-spot with 2,090 in 1992.
- * Fine is on pace to throw for 3,564 yards and 27 touchdowns in a 12-game season, which would put him first in program history in those two categories: single-season passing yards and single-season passing touchdowns.
- * Fine is quickly approaching 4,000 yards passing for his career, and is 349 yards away from becoming the seventh North Texas quarterback to hit that milestone.
- * Fine leads Conference USA in passing yards per game (297.0) and in passing yards (2,079).
- * He has thrown for multiple touchdowns in a game six times this year (each of the first two weeks, vs. Lamar, and at SMU, vs. UAB, at Southern Miss, vs. UTSA and last week at Florida Atlantic).

- * Fine's 16 touchdown passes through seven games surpass his output from 10 games last season (six). The 16 touchdown passes also rank best in Conference USA and 17th in the nation.
- * His 150.18 pass efficiency rating is also second-best in the conference and 26th-best in the country.
- * Fine is in eighth place in program history in career passing yards (3,651) with his 283-yard performance last week at Florida Atlantic. Fine is 330 yards behind the seventh spot, held by Jason Mills (1994-97).
- * Fine is also ninth in program history in career completions (308), trailing Riley Dodge (2008-10) by three.
- * Fine moved into ninth place in school history for his career in passing attempts, surpassing Riley Dodge (2008-10) and Ken Washington (1974-77). The sophomore has 505 through 17 games, and trails Vidal Carlin (1965-66) by 128 attempts for eighth.
- * Fine's 424-yard performance in week two at SMU was the sixth-best in program history and the best since Giovanni Vizza threw for 478 against Navy in 2007. Fine is one of eight players in Mean Green history to have thrown for 400 yards or more.

- * Fine's 424-yard performance at SMU remains the most passing yards in a single game this season in Conference USA.
- * After his 283-yard performance last week at Florida Atlantic, Fine has 11 200-yard passing games in his career, which is the fifthmost in school history. He trails Giovanni Vizza (2007-08) for fourth, who had 15.
- * Fine has thrown for 200-plus yards in four straight games, dating back to the win over UAB on Sept. 23. Four straight ties Fine for fifth-most in school history with Steve Ramsey (1968) and Vidal Carlin (1965).
- * Fine's four career 300-yard passing games tie for the third-most in school history, along

Redshirt sophomore wide receiver Jalen Guyton (Allen) was held without a catch for the first time this season last week at Florida Atlantic.

- * Guyton was recently added to the Biletnikoff Award Watch List.
- * Guyton was named Conference USA co-Offensive Player of the Week for his performance on Sept. 30 at Southern Miss Guyton's 14 catches (and 211 yards) were the most in a single game for the Mean Green since Carlos Harris' 15 grabs for 216 yards against Southern Miss in 2014. It is also the most catches by anyone in C-USA this year.
- * Guyton's 211 yards were the ninth-most in a single game in school history and the 14 catches ties several players for fourth-most in school history in a single game.

- * Guyton leads the team in receiving yards with 626 on 32 catches (19.6 yards per catch) and has seven touchdowns. He is second in catches.
- * Guyton's seven receiving touchdowns through seven games would have been the highest touchdown total for a Mean Green receiver in 2016 (six players tied for the team lead with two).
- * He is the conference leader in touchdown grabs, which also is seventh nationally.
- * Guyton is averaging 89.4 yards per game receiving, which is second-best in C-USA and 27th in the country.
- * His 626 receiving yards rank 23rd in the country and lead C-USA.
- * Guyton is on pace for 1,073 receiving yards and 12 touchdowns over the course of 12 games. That would rank fifth in school history (receiving yards) for a single-season and tie for second in program history (receiving touchdowns).
- * Guyton is averaging 4.6 catches per game, which ranks seventh in C-USA.
- * Guyton began his career at Notre Dame before transferring to Trinity Valley Community College.
- * Guyton caught 45 passes for 968 yards and 12 touchdowns in 2016 at Trinity Valley.

Moore, Moore, Moore

Senior kicker Trevor Moore holds the school record for most consecutive made extra points, and recently set the record for most career PATs (126). The Edmond, Oklahoma, native pushed his school record to 126 straight made PATs after going 4-for-4 last week at Florida Atlantic. Moore has never missed an extra point attempt in his career. Moore broke the record of 61 straight that was previously held by Keith Chapman (1987-89) last season.

- * Moore made his only field goal attempt of the game last week at Florida Atlantic, a 44-yarder. Moore is 11-of-12 on field goals this season, with his only miss coming at Iowa when he had his kick blocked.
- * Moore has one Conference USA Special Teams Player of the Week honor this season, after converting on all four field goals, all

four extra points, posting five touchbacks and he even recovered a fumble on the final play of the game against UAB in week four.

- * Moore holds the school record for career field goal percentage (78.6 percent).
- * He also holds the program record for field goal percentage in a season (88.2 percent in 2014). He has made 91.7 percent of his kicks thus far in 2017.
- * Moore sits atop eight statistical categories in school history. In addition to field goal percentage in a single season and career and most consecutive extra points made, Moore also is the leader in extra point percentage in a single season and career (100 percent), extra points made in a single game (11 against Nicholls in 2014) and field goals made in a single game (five against SMU in 2014). His 126 extra points made are now the most in school history, passing Nick Bazaldua's (2002-05) 121.
- * Moore ranks in the top three in three other North Texas statistical categories, and is fourth among active Football Bowl Subdivision kickers in consecutive extra points made. The senior aims to wrap his career as the most decorated kicker in school history.

Sophomore safety Khairi Muhammad (Dallas) posted 11 tackles at Florida Atlantic last week.

- * Muhammad leads the team in tackles with 63 total tackles (26 solo) with a sack, three tackles for loss, a forced and recovered fumble.
- *His 9.0 tackles are second-best in Conference USA and 28th-best in the nation.

Sophomore wide receiver Michael Lawrence (Sweetwater, Texas) caught 11 passes for 112 yards last week at Florida Atlantic, both career highs, and is the team-leader in receptions with 33, for 452 yards and two touchdowns (13.7 yards per catch).

2017 Conference USA Standings

- * Lawrence is averaging 4.7 catches per game, which ranks sixth in Conference USA, and is averaging 64.6 yards per game, ranking seventh in the conference.
- * He caught just one pass for 16 yards as a freshman last year.

McClain Approaches 300

A preseason All-Conference USA selection for the second consecutive year, senior safety Kishawn McClain (Rosenberg, Texas) garnered second team All-Conference honors in 2016 in Conference USA. For the second straight season, McClain led the team in tackles with 91 (67 solo) to go along with one-and-a-half sacks, five tackles for loss, three interceptions, two forced fumbles and three pass break-ups in 13 appearances.

- * McClain recorded aseason-high 11 tackles and a forced fumble last week at Florida Atlantic and has a total of 47 stops (2.5 for loss), a forced fumble, an interception and two pass break-ups in 2017.
- * McClain has 287 career tackles for the Mean Green.
- * McClain had double-digit tackles four different times in 2016.

Rutherford Finds The End Zone

Redshirt junior receiver O'Keeron Rutherford (Carthage, Texas) caught three passes for 23 yards and the first touchdown of his career last week at Florida Atlantic.

- * Rutherford's nine-yard touchdown grab was the Mean Green's first score last week.
- * Those three catches for Rutherford were the first three for the 6-5 receiver in 2017.

Ejiya Keeps Making Stops

Redshirt junior linebacker E.J. Ejiya (Blaine, Minnesota) recorded a team and career-high 12 tackles last week at Florida Atlantic. He has a team-high 4.5 sacks on the season.

- * Ejiya has 57 total tackles, which ranks second-best on the team and 6.5 tackles for loss
- * Ejiya also leads the team in sacks, with 4.5. Those 4.5 are the first of Ejiya's Mean Green career.
- * Ejiya's 4.5 sacks are tied for fifth in Conference USA.
- * Ejiya now has 100 career tackles in 20 career appearances.

The Night Was So Young

Junior defensive lineman Roderick Young (Spring, Texas) posted one tackle at Florida Atlantic last week.

* Young now has 21 tackles on the season, 2.5

for loss, a sack and six quarterback hurries in six starts.

Patterson's Strong Performance

Redshirt freshman Blake Patterson (Round Rock, Texas) had a strong performance last week at Florida Atlantic.

* Patterson averaged 47.0 yards per attempt on four punts, including a career-long of 55 and three inside the 20.

Johnson's First Score

Freshman running back Evan Johnson (Loranger, Louisiana) scored his first career touchdown last week at Florida Atlantic, scampering in untouched from eight yards out in the fourth quarter.

* Johnson carried five times for 15 yards and now has 22 carries for 134 yards and a touchdown this season, while also handling kick return duties.

Smith Finds Paydirt

Redshirt freshman running back Nic Smith (Arlington) caught his second touchdown of the season in the final 30 seconds of last week's game at Florida Atlantic.

Smith has caught nine passes for 87 yards and two touchdowns and also has carried 49 times for 235 yards and two more rushing scores.

Littrell's Second Year Boost

Prior to his arrival in Denton Littrell was an offensive coordinator in three stops throughout his career. Each time his offense hit year two, there was an uptick in total offense and points per game. That is certainly the plan for the Mean Green offense, which was much improved in Littrell's first season at the helm.

- * Through seven games of year two in Denton, Littrell's team is averaging 36.3 points per game and they hung 59 on Lamar in the season-opener, the most points scored under Littrell. The Mean Green have topped 40 points on three occasions this season after doing so twice in 2016.
- * The Mean Green also posted a school-record 668 yards of total offense (436 on the ground) in week one and are averaging 487.9 yards of total offense per game (16th-best in the nation).
- * When Littrell took over as co-offensive coordinator at Arizona, the Wildcats ranked 53rd nationally in scoring at 28.2 points per game, 24th in total offense (439.4 per game) and ninth in passing yardage (307.7 per game). Year two saw the Arizona offense score 2.6 points per game more (30.8), and the team improved to the third-best team in the country in terms of passing yardage (370.8 yards per game), as well as a 37-spot improvement in total offense (465.2).
- * At Indiana in 2012, the Hoosier offense finished 51st in scoring offense (30.8 points per game), 17th in passing offense (311.2) and 34th in total offense (442.0). The Hoosiers then spiked all the way up to 16th nationally in scoring (38.4 points per game), increasing their output by 7.6 points each game. The passing yards per game actually decreased in 2013, however the total offensive output increased by 66.5 yards per game, and finished ninth in the nation in that category.
- * At North Carolina the Tar Heels ranked 36th nationally in scoring offense at 33.2 points per game in 2014, while posting 429.8 yards per game of total offense (45th best in the country) and 278.4 yards per game in passing offense (27th in the nation). In 2016, the Heels improve immensely in one of the program's most successful seasons in its history. North Carolina went 11-1 before Littrell's was hired by the Mean Green on

the day of the ACC Championship game. An 8.9 points per game jump (41.2 through 12 games) saw the Heels rank 11th in the country at that time. A 65.9 yards per game increase in total offense saw North Carolina leap 29 spots in the national rankings to 16th. Like his second-year squad in Bloomington, Littrell's offense saw a more balanced attack, achieving that total offensive bump with a slightly decreased production in passing yardage per game.

Tough Sledding

There are six teams that reached bowl games a year ago on the Mean Green's 2017 schedule; Iowa, Southern Miss, UTSA, Old Dominion, Louisiana Tech and Army.

* After winning 29-26 over UTSA on Oct. 14, the Mean Green are 2-1 against such opponents (lost to Iowa on Sept. 16 and beat Southern Miss on Sept. 30).

Halftime Leads (Usually) Equal Success

North Texas is 6-1 under head coach Seth Littrell in games where they lead at halftime after winning in week four against UAB. North Texas held a 30-14 halftime lead.

- * The only loss came after failing to hold on to a 14-10 lead at Iowa on Sept. 16.
- * Conversely, they are 3-10 when trailing at the break. The three wins in Littrell's tenure when trailing at the half came on Oct. 14 against UT San Antonio (trailed 17-16) and on Sept. 30 with a win at Southern Miss (trailed 21-17) and against Rice in 2016.

That's Offensive

The Mean Green lead the conference in total offense, averaging 487.9 yards per contest.

- * That ranks 16th nationally and is the best in Conference USA.
- * North Texas averaged 341.8 yards per game last season.
- * The Mean Green are averaging 6.68 yards per play, which ranks 18th-best nationally.
- * North Texas ranked 117th nationally each of the previous two seasons (5.08 yards per play in 2016 and 4.56 yards per play in 2015). The 2013 team that won the Heart of Dallas Bowl at 9-4, finished 63rd in that category at 5.61 yards per play.
- * North Texas is averaging 73 plays per game

in 2017, compared to 67 per game in 2016, Littrell's first year in Denton.

* The Mean Green have surpassed 400 yards of offense in six of their first seven games in 2017 and 500 yards on three occasions. North Texas had only five games in 2016 (in 13 games) that they went over 400 yards of total offense, none of which topped 500.

Home Cooking

North Texas is 6-3 at home during the Seth Littrell era after a 29-26 win over UT San Antonio on Oct. 14. North Texas is 3-0 at Apogee Stadium in 2017.

* The Mean Green have won each of their last four home games, dating back to last season, when North Texas beat Southern Miss on Nov. 19, 2016.

What's The Rush?

North Texas added two more touchdowns on the ground last week at Florida Atlantic, giving the Mean Green 15 in 2017. They scored 24 rushing touchdowns in 2016.

- * North Texas has the third-most rushing touchdowns in Conference USA.
- * Prior to Littrell's arrival, the Mean Green reached the end zone only seven times that way in 2015.

#LetItFlv

North Texas leads Conference USA in passing yards per game, at 301.9.

- * The Mean Green also rank second in the conference in passing efficiency, at 149.4.
- * North Texas has thrown 17 passing touchdowns, which leads C-USA.
- * The Mean Green are averaging 8.4 yards per pass through seven games in 2017 compared to 6.0 yards per pass in 2016.
- * Last week at Florida Atlantic quarterback Mason Fine (Locust Grove, Oklahoma) completed passes to 11 different receivers. One key omission was Jalen Guyton (Allen), who was held without a catch for the first time this year.

O-Line Improvement

North Texas has allowed just 15 sacks in its first seven games (2.14 per game). Last season, North Texas surrendered 43 (3.31

per game).

Third Down Improvement

North Texas struggled in the early stages of 2017 on third downs on both sides of the ball. They were much-improved offensively, converting on 7-of-16 tries last week at Florida Atlantic.

- * Offensively, North Texas is 40-for-98 (40.8 percent) on third downs. That is sixth in Conference USA.
- * Defensively, opponents have converted 52-of-114 third downs (45.6 percent), which ranks 11th in C-USA.

Turnover Margin

The Mean Green are minus-seven in 2017 in turnover differential and haven't forced a turnover since the UAB game on Sept. 23. Last season North Texas was plus-one.

Harrell Moves Upstairs

Offensive coordinator Graham Harrell has transitioned from an on-field position up into the press box for his second year in charge of the Mean Green offense.

What's In A (Nick) Name?

Four defensive players in Denton have some pretty interesting nicknames. Redshirt junior defensive tackle Ulaiasi Tauaalo (Keller, Texas) is affectionately known as Toala Bear, sophomore defensive lineman LaDarius Hamilton (Corrigan, Texas) goes by Hambone, senior linebacker Joshua Wheeler (Grand Prairie, Texas) is nicknamed Earl and freshman safety Tyreke Davis (Denton) is known by his teammates simply, as Denton.

Texas-Made

There are currently 84 players on the North Texas roster who are from the state of Texas. 29 players are not from the Lone Star State, and the next highest representation comes from the north in Oklahoma, with eight.

Seth Littrell

Head Coach

Second Year → Oklahoma '01

The University of North Texas named Seth Littrell as its 19th head football coach, University President Neal Smatresk announced on December 5, 2015.

Littrell, 39, led the Mean Green to the second-best turnaround in the Football Bowl Subdivision in 2016, his first season at the helm. North Texas improved its win total by four games, finishing 5-8 on the season with a

Zaxby's Heart of Dallas Bowl appearance. Littrell helped lead the Mean Green to a 9.6 points per game jump in scoring offense from it's output in 2016, which ranked 11th-best in the nation, and the 2016 defense allowed 8.7 points per game fewer than it did in 2015, which was the 13th-best turnaround in the country.

One of the brightest offensive minds in college football, Littrell came to North Texas after serving as the assistant head coach for offense and tight ends at North Carolina. At the time of his hire, the Muskogee, Oklahoma, native was the youngest coach in Conference USA and fifth-youngest in the nation.

North Carolina scored over 30 points nine times in 2015, topped the 40-point mark seven times and scored over 50 points in four games, which is a school record. Through 12 games, UNC averaged 41.2 points a game, which was 11th in the nation.

Under the guidance of Littrell, quarterback Marquise Williams set a new school record for career touchdowns (90) and total offense at North Carolina.

In 2015 with Littrell, the UNC offense averaged 7.46 yards per play, which was second in the nation, and ran the ball for 6.0 yards a carry, which ranked third in the country. UNC was one of just 11 schools in the nation averaging more than 200 yards rushing (229.7) and 250 yards passing (266.0). UNC rushed for over 200 yards eight times and had over 500 yards of total offense in four games in 2015, including 704 yards in a 66-31 win over Duke.

In his first season in Chapel Hill in 2014, Littrell helped Carolina establish several school records, including most passing yards, most passing touchdowns and most first downs. Williams was a second-team all-conference pick after leading the Tar Heels to a bowl game in his first year as the starter, and set several individual school records, including most rushing yards and rushing touchdowns by a quarterback. Carolina gained more than 5,000 yards in Littrell's first season as the play-caller and averaged 429.8 yards per contest.

Littrell came to Chapel Hill from Indiana where he guided one of the most prolific offenses in the country. Indiana finished ninth in the nation in total offense in 2013, averaging 508.5 yards per game. The Hoosiers were 17th in passing offense (306.7 avg.) and 30th in rushing offense (201.8). Indiana was one of only three teams to average more than 300 yards passing and 200 yards rushing

Under Littrell's guidance in 2013, Indiana set single-season records with 6,102 total yards, (508.5 ypg), 461 points, (38.4 ppg), 36 passing touchdowns, 62 total touchdowns and 300 first downs. Tight end Ted Bolser thrived in his system, setting IU career records for receptions, receiving yards and touchdowns by a tight end. Bolser and wide receiver Cody Latimer were selected in the 2014 NFL Draft. Latimer was taken in the second round (56th overall) by the Denver Broncos, while Bolser went in the seventh round to Washington.

In Littrell's first season as Indiana's offensive coordinator in 2012, the Hoosiers led the Big Ten and ranked 17th nationally in passing offense (311.2). They finished second in the conference in total offense (442.0) and fourth in scoring offense (30.8).

Prior to his stint at Indiana, Littrell coached three seasons at Arizona, where his 2011 offense ranked third nationally in passing offense (370.8) and 15th in total offense (465.2).

Three of his Arizona players were selected in the NFL draft: tight end Rob Gronkowski (New England - 2010 second round), quarterback Nick Foles (Philadelphia - 2012 third round) and wide receiver Juron Criner (Oakland - 2012 fifth round).

Prior to Arizona, Littrell served four years as running backs coach at Texas Tech (2005-08) under Mike Leach. The 2008 Red Raiders rushed for 119 yards per game, the highest total in the Leach era. Running back Shannon Woods earned All-Big 12 Conference honors in 2006 after averaging 6.1 yards per carry and snagging 75 receptions, totaling a top 15 national figure of 139 all-purpose yards per game.

Littrell began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Kansas from 2002-04. The Jayhawks played in the 2003 Tangerine Bowl.

Littrell has coached in eight bowl games, played in two and was team captain on Oklahoma's 2000 national championship team. He was a four-year letterwinner at Oklahoma where he rushed for 231 yards and seven touchdowns in 1999 and finished his career with 11 rushing scores.

The Muskogee, Oklahoma, native graduated from Oklahoma with a degree in communications in 2001. Littrell and his wife, Becca, have a son, Tripp, and a daughter, Elle.




