

North Texas (6-3, 5-1 C-USA) returns to Denton for homecoming weekend and a date with Conference USA West division foe UTEP (0-9, 0-5 C-USA) Saturday at 4 p.m. CT at Apogee Stadium in Denton, Texas. North Texas has the opportunity to clinch the division and a spot in the C-USA Championship game with a win. The Mean Green came back to knock off Louisiana Tech on the road in Ruston last week, 24-23, while UTEP enters week 10 after a 30-3 loss at MIddle Tennessee last week to drop their ninth straight game.

Saturday's game will be broadcast live on ESPN3 with Doug Anderson (pxp) and LaDarrin McLane (analyst) as well as on the radio on the Mean Green Sports Network with Dave Barnett (pxp) and Hank Dickenson (analyst).

Next Up

The Mean Green remain in Denton to host Army on Nov. 18. That game kicks off at 5:30 p.m. CT from Apogee Stadium in Denton, Texas, and will be broadcast live on beIN Sport and the Mean Green Sports Network. It will be the third meeting between the two teams in 13 months. North Texas won at West Point last October (35-18) and the Black Knights won an overtime thriller in the Zaxby's Heart of Dallas Bowl last December.

Mean Green Lead C-USA West

Following last week's 24-23 win at Louisiana Tech, the Mean Green enter Week 11 of the season alone atop the Conference USA's West division at 5-1, with an opportunity to clinch the division with a win Saturday against UTEP.

The Mean Green hold head-to-head tiebreakers over UAB, Southern Miss, UT San Antonio and Louisiana Tech (all have either two or three losses in conference play) by virtue of head-to-head wins. With two conference games remaining, North Texas controls its own destiny to reach the Conference USA Championship game.

Looking across the conference, the East division is being led by Florida Atlantic (5-0 in C-USA), the only conference foe to beat North Texas this season. The Owls travel to Ruston this week to battle Louisiana Tech before hosting FIU the following week and closing conference play in Charlotte against the 49ers.

FIU appears to be the Owl's primary challenger, since Florida Atlantic dispatched Marshall 30-25 last week, leaving the Herd with two losses in league play and on the wrong side of a head-to-head tiebreaker with the Owls. FIU is now 4-1 in conference play after holding off UTSA last week, 14-7 in Miami. Should the Panthers win out, FIU would hold a head-to-head tiebreak advantage over Florida Atlantic.

Should North Texas win the division, it would clinch their first-ever spot in the Conference USA Championship game. The Mean Green joined C-USA ahead of the 2013 season. The Mean Green's last conference title came as members of the Sun Belt in 2004.

UNT Becomes Bowl Eligible

The Mean Green earned their sixth win of the season last week in a 24-23 victory at Louisiana Tech, which makes them bowl eligible. Though the six wins make the Mean Green eligible, it does not guarantee a bowl berth. Heading into Week 11, there are 71 Football Bowl Subdivision teams at or within one win of bowl eligibility and 25 more two wins away. With 80 bowl slots available this season, some six-win teams may be left without one.

- * Should the Mean Green be selected for a bowl game, it would mark the second straight year that North Texas will have gone bowling. The Mean Green made a bowl last season at 5-7 by virtue of not enough six-win programs and North Texas' exceptional APR score (Academic Progress Rate).
- * The last time the Mean Green went to bowls in consecutive season was 2003 and 2004, part of a run of four consecutive trips to the New Orleans Bowl (2001-04), which included three outright Sun Belt championships and a share of another.

The Mean Green are averaging 35.9 points per game through nine games, which is second in Conference USA and 25th in the country.

- * North Texas averaged 24.8 ppg in 2016, taking an 11.1 ppg jump in 2017.
- * The Mean Green made a 9.6 ppg jump in 2016, head coach Seth Littrell's first season in Denton.

That's Offensive

The Mean Green lead the conference in total offense, averaging 476.7 yards per contest, which ranks 18th nationally.

- * North Texas averaged 341.8 yards per game last season, which ranked 12th out of 13 teams in conference last season.
- * The Mean Green are averaging 6.44 yards per play, which ranks 23rd-best nationally.
- * North Texas ranked 117th nationally each of the previous two seasons (5.08 yards per play in 2016 and 4.56 yards per play in 2015). The 2013 team that won the Heart of Dallas Bowl at 9-4, finished 63rd in that category at

5.61 yards per play.

- * North Texas is averaging 74 plays per game in 2017, compared to 67 per game in 2016, Littrell's first year in Denton.
- * The Mean Green have surpassed 400 yards of offense in eight of their first nine games in 2017 and 500 yards on three occasions. North Texas had only five games in 2016 (in 13 games) that they went over 400 yards of total offense, none of which topped 500.

First Downs

North Texas has posted 216 first downs over the first nine games, and their 24.0 first downs per game ranks best in Conference USA.

- * The Mean Green had 26 first downs last week in the win at Louisiana Tech.
- * The 216 first downs rank 19th in the country.

Explosive Plays

The Mean Green had eight plays of 15-yards or more from scrimmage last week in the win at Louisiana Tech.

- * Sophomore quarterback Mason Fine (Locust Grove, Oklahoma) completed three passes of 15 yards or more, last week in the win over La Tech. Each of those were for 20 or more yards, including a touchdown pass of 22 yards in the third quarter to fellow sophomore and Oklahoman, Rico Bussey, Jr. (Lawton, Oklahoma). Fine connected with Bussey, Jr. for a touchdown for the fourth time in the last five games (going back to Sept. 30 at Southern Miss). Fine also hit sophomore Michael Lawrence (Sweetwater, Texas) and freshman Jaelon Darden (Houston) for 25-yard completions. Fine picked out Darden late in the second quarter on the Mean Green's field goal drive that started with 39 seconds to go in the half to pull within a touchdown at 17-10. Fine's pass to Lawrence came on the game-winning touchdown drive to move the Mean Green into Bulldog territory.
- * Fine has thrown 12 touchdown passes of 20 or more yards this season. (18 total)
- * Senior running back Jeffery Wilson (Elkhart, Texas) had seven runs of 10 or more yards last week, including the game-

Wilson Climbs Record Books

Mean Green senior running back Jeffery (Elkhart, Texas), two-time Conference USA Player of the Week (weeks one and four), carried 20 times for 165 yards and two touchdowns last week in the at Louisiana Tech. Wilson is the conference's third-leading rusher at 111.0 yards per game, which also ranks 19th nationally. Wilson's 13 rushing scores are eighth-best in the nation and his 999 rushing yards also rank 19thbest in the country.

- * Wilson has 149 carries for 999 yards and 13 touchdowns this season through nine games and is on pace for 1,332 yards and 17 touchdowns over the course of a 12-game season. That would tie for second-best single season performance in program history in rushing touchdowns and sixth-best in rushing yards.
- * Wilson had two rushing scores last week during the win at La Tech when he scored from eight yards out in the first quarter and again with 6:04 to go in the fourth, to put North Texas ahead for good. Wilson has scored at least one rushing touchdown in nine of his last 10 games, dating back to the Zaxby's Heart of Dallas Bowl in 2016.
- * Wilson's 6.70 yards per carry ranks 15thbest in the nation and he is second in C-USA, behind Florida Atlantic's Devin Singletary
- * His 211-yard performance in week four tied for the third-best in the nation that week.
- * Wilson has rushed for 2,989 yards in his career, which places him fifth in school history. He is 11 yards shy of becoming just

the fifth player in school history to reach 3,000 career rushing yards.

- * Wilson is 131 yards from Ja'Quay Wilburn's (1997-00) fourth spot.
- * Wilson has 523 career carries after his 20 totes last week at La Tech, which ranks eighth in school history in that category and is nine carries behind Ken Washington (1974-77) for seventh and 21 behind Darrin Collins (1986-89) for sixth place.
- * Last season Wilson finished with 169 carries for 936 yards and 14 touchdowns, which were career highs for a single season in just 11 games.

Fine Leading Mean Green Offense

Sophomore quarterback Mason Fine (Locust Grove, Oklahoma) completed 23-of-37 passes for 211 yards and one touchdown with an interception last week in the win at Louisiana Tech. Fine has completed 201-of-317 passes (63.4 percent) for 2,599 yards with 18 touchdowns and nine interceptions.

- * Fine is now sixth in program history for most passing yards in a single season after passing Giovanni Vizza's 2007 season (2,388 yards), Scott Davis' 1988 season (2,409) and Mitch Maher's 1993 season (2,595) last week with his 211-yard performance at La Tech. Fine trails Derek Thompson's 2012 season total by 50 yards for the five spot, Vizza's 2008 season by 159 yards for fourth, Steve Ramsey's 1969 season by 229 yards for third and Thompson's 2013 campaign by 297 yards for second place.
- * Fine is on pace to throw for 3,465 yards and 24 touchdowns in a 12-game season, which would put him first in program history in passing yards and tie for second in single-season passing touchdowns with Steve Ramsey's 1968 and 1969 seasons, as well as Mitch Maher's 1993 season.
- * Fine surpassed 4,000 yards passing for his career in the win at La Tech last week, becoming the seventh North Texas quarterback to hit that milestone.
- * Fine is in seventh place in program history in career passing yards (4,171) with his 211-yard performance last week in the win at La Tech. Fine is 975 yards behind the sixth spot, held by Giovanni Vizza (2007-08).
- * Fine is also seventh in program history in

career completions (356) after passing Jason Mills (1995-97) last week. Fine trails Scott Hall (2000-04) by 66 completions heading into this week's game against UTEP.

- * Fine is in ninth place in school history for his career in passing attempts. The sophomore has 578 through 19 games, and trails Vidal Carlin (1965-66) by 55 attempts for eighth.
- * Fine is in second in Conference USA in passing yards per game (288.8), in passing yards (2,599) and is tied for the league-lead in passing touchdowns (18).
- * He has thrown for multiple touchdowns in a game six times this year (each of the first two weeks, vs. Lamar, and at SMU, vs. UAB, at Southern Miss, vs. UTSA and at Florida Atlantic).
- * Fine's 18 touchdown passes through nine games surpass his output from 10 games last season (six). The 18 touchdown passes also rank 23rd in the nation.
- * His 145.34 pass efficiency rating is also second-best in the conference.
- * Fine's 424-yard performance in week two at SMU was the sixth-best in program history and the best since Giovanni Vizza threw for 478 against Navy in 2007. Fine is one of eight players in Mean Green history to have thrown for 400 yards or more in a game.

Redshirt sophomore wide receiver Jalen Guyton (Allen) caught a team-high five passes for 37 yards in the win at Louisiana Tech last week.

- * Guyton was recently added to the Biletnikoff Award Watch List.
- * Guyton was named Conference USA co-Offensive Player of the Week for his performance on Sept. 30 at Southern Miss Guyton's 14 catches (and 211 yards) were the most in a single game for the Mean Green since Carlos Harris' 15 grabs for 216 yards against Southern Miss in 2014. It is also the most catches by anyone in C-USA this year.
- * Guyton's 211 yards were the ninth-most in a single game in school history and the 14 catches tied several players for fourth-most in school history in a single game.
- * Guyton leads the team in receiving yards with 729 on a team-high 44 catches (16.6 yards per catch), and has seven touchdowns.
- * Guyton's seven receiving touchdowns through nine games would have been the highest touchdown total for a Mean Green receiver in 2016 (six players tied for the team lead with two).
- * He is tied for the conference lead in touchdown grabs, which also is 21st

nationally.

- * Guyton is averaging 81.0 yards per game receiving, which is third-best in C-USA.
- * His 729 receiving yards are third-most in C-USA.
- * Guyton is averaging 4.9 catches per game, which ranks sixth in C-USA.
- * Guyton began his career at Notre Dame before transferring to Trinity Valley Community College.
- * Guyton caught 45 passes for 968 yards and 12 touchdowns in 2016 at Trinity Valley.

Moore, Moore, Moore

Senior kicker Trevor Moore holds the school record for most consecutive made extra points, and recently set the record for most career PATs (135). The Edmond, Oklahoma, native pushed his school record to 135 straight made PATs after going 3-for-3 last week in the win at Louisiana Tech. Moore has never missed an extra point attempt in his career. Moore broke the record of 61 straight that was previously held by Keith Chapman (1987-89) last season.

* Moore converted his only field goal attempt last week in the win at La Tech, connecting from 48 yards out to equal a season-long. Moore is 13-of-15 on field goals this season.

- * Moore has one Conference USA Special Teams Player of the Week honor this season, after converting on all four field goals, all four extra points, posting five touchbacks and he even recovered a fumble on the final play of the game against UAB in week four.
- * Moore sits atop eight statistical categories in school history. In addition to field goal percentage in a single season and career and most consecutive extra points made, Moore also is the leader in extra point percentage in a single season and career (100 percent), extra points made in a single game (11 against Nicholls in 2014) and field goals made in a single game (five against SMU in 2014). His 135 extra points made are the most in school history, after passing Nick Bazaldua's (2002-05) 121 earlier this season.
- * Moore ranks in the top three in three other North Texas statistical categories, and is tied for third among active Football Bowl Subdivision kickers in consecutive extra points made. The senior aims to wrap his career as the most decorated kicker in school history.

* Bussey, Jr. has 22 catches for 283 yards and four touchdowns on the season.

North Texas ranks second nationally with three blocked punts this season, tied with Texas A&M and Arizona State. Utah State leads the nation with four. The Mean Green

Muhammad Leading The Way

Sophomore safety Khairi Muhammad (Dallas) posted seven tackles last week in the win at Louisiana Tech.

- * Muhammad is the team-leader in tackles with 74 total tackles (41 solo) with a sack, three tackles for loss, a forced and recovered fumble and a pass break-up.
- * His 8.2 tackles per game are ninth-best in Conference USA.

#TheStandard

Sophomore wide receiver Michael Lawrence (Sweetwater, Texas) caught four passes for a team-high 47 yards last week in the win at Louisiana Tech, and is second on the team in receptions with 40, for 529 yards and two touchdowns (13.2 yards per catch).

- * Lawrence is averaging 4.4 catches per game, which is tied for ninth in Conference USA, and is averaging 58.8 yards per game, ranking ninth in the conference.
- * He caught just one pass for 16 yards as a true freshman last year.

McClain Surpasses 300

A preseason All-Conference USA selection for the second consecutive year, senior safety Kishawn McClain (Rosenberg, Texas) garnered second team All-Conference honors in 2016 in Conference USA. For the second straight season, McClain led the team in tackles with 91 (67 solo) to go along with one-and-a-half sacks, five tackles for loss, three interceptions, two forced fumbles and three pass break-ups in 13 appearances.

- * McClain recorded a team-high eight tackles last week in the win at Louisiana Tech and has a total of 66 stops (3.5 for loss), a forced fumble, an interception and two pass breakups in 2017.
- * McClain has 306 career tackles for the Mean Green. He is 19 tackles shy of Lance White (1983-86) for seventh on the program's alltime tackles list.
- * McClain has 39 tackles in his last four games dating back to the win over UT San Antonio
- * McClain had double-digit tackles four different times in 2016 and has done it twice thus far in 2017.

Ejiya Keeps Making Stops

Redshirt junior linebacker E.J. Ejiya (Blaine, Minnesota) recorded six tackles last week in the win at Louisiana Tech. He has a teamhigh 4.5 sacks on the season.

- * Ejiya is second on the team with 73 total tackles, and a team-high 7.5 tackles for loss.
- * Ejiya has had double-digit tackles three times this season (in three of his last five games) dating back to the win at Southern Miss on Sept. 30.
- * Ejiya also leads the team in sacks, with 4.5. Those 4.5 are the first of Ejiya's Mean Green career.
- * Ejiya's 4.5 sacks are tied for sixth in Conference USA.

Young(er) Than Yesterday

Junior defensive lineman Roderick Young (Spring, Texas) posted a season-best five tackles, a sack and a career-high three tackles for loss in the win at Louisiana Tech last week.

* Young now has 29 tackles on the season, 5.5 for loss, 2.0 sacks and seven quarterback hurries in nine starts.

Ozougwu Busts Out

Redshirt freshman linebacker Joe Ozougwu (Alief, Texas) earned his first career start last week in the win at Louisiana Tech and didn't disappoint. Filling in for Joshua Wheeler (Grand Prairie, Texas), Ozougwu had a career-high seven tackles, a half sack (the first of his career) and forced a fumble.

* His seven-tackle performance was one more tackle than he had coming into the game.

Starting Fast At Home

North Texas has won all four of its home games in 2017 and a lot of that can be attributed to their quick starts at Apogee Stadium. The Mean Green have scored on their first two possessions in each of those four games, three of which were by virtue of back-to-back touchdown drives to open the game.

Quick-Strike Offense

North Texas can score, and it can score quickly. The Mean Green have 15 touchdown drives this season of two minutes or less.

* North Texas just missed their 16th such drive of the season last week in the win at Louisiana Tech, posting a 2:01 touchdown drive that culminated with 22-yard scoring toss from sophomore quarterback Mason Fine (Locust Grove, Oklahoma) to sophomore receiver Rico Bussey, Jr. (Lawton, Oklahoma).

Cardiac Kids

Following the 24-23 win at Louisiana Tech the Mean Green are 4-0 in 2017 in games decided by seven points or less. They were 2-1 in such games last season.

The win last week at La Tech marked the fourth time North Texas has won this season when the Mean Green were either tied or trailing in the fourth quarter.

Win The Third Quarter

The Mean Green outscored Louisiana Tech 7-3 in the third quarter in last week's win, which was key to bringing North Texas back into the game. The Mean Green had been outscored in third quarters in six of its first eight games before turning the tables in Ruston. They have been outscored 87-61 in third stanzas this season.

Fourth Quarter Team

North Texas has outscored its opponents 85-58 in fourth quarters this season, including 7-3 last week in the win at Louisiana Tech.

Conference Success

With its fifth conference win coming last week at Louisiana Tech, the Mean Green have their most conference wins since the 2013 season, when they finished 6-2 in

Conference USA on their way to a Heart of Dallas Bowl victory.

Red Zone Success

North Texas has scored on 92 percent of its red zone chances this season (29-of-32) with 23 touchdowns. The red zone scoring percentage ranks 21st in the nation.

Littrell's Second Year Boost

Prior to his arrival in Denton Littrell was an offensive coordinator in three stops throughout his career. Each time his offense hit year two, there was an uptick in total offense and points per game. That is certainly the plan for the Mean Green offense, which was much improved in Littrell's first season at the helm.

- * Through nine games of year two in Denton, Littrell's team is averaging 35.9 points per game and they hung 59 on Lamar in the season-opener, the most points scored under Littrell. The Mean Green have topped 40 points on four occasions this season after doing so twice in 2016.
- * The Mean Green also posted a school-record 668 yards of total offense (436 on the ground) in week one and are averaging 476.7 yards of total offense per game (18th-best in the nation and best in Conference USA).
- * When Littrell took over as co-offensive coordinator at Arizona, the Wildcats ranked 53rd nationally in scoring at 28.2 points per game, 24th in total offense (439.4 per game) and ninth in passing yardage (307.7 per game). Year two saw the Arizona offense score 2.6 points per game more (30.8), and the team improved to the third-best team in the country in terms of passing yardage (370.8 yards per game), as well as a 37-spot improvement in total offense (465.2).
- * At Indiana in 2012, the Hoosier offense finished 51st in scoring offense (30.8 points per game), 17th in passing offense (311.2) and 34th in total offense (442.0). The Hoosiers then spiked all the way up to 16th nationally in scoring (38.4 points per game), increasing their output by 7.6 points each game. The passing yards per game actually decreased in 2013, however the total offensive output increased by 66.5 yards per game, and finished ninth in the nation in that category.
- * At North Carolina the Tar Heels ranked

36th nationally in scoring offense at 33.2 points per game in 2014, while posting 429.8 vards per game of total offense (45th best in the country) and 278.4 yards per game in passing offense (27th in the nation). In 2016, the Heels improve immensely in one of the program's most successful seasons in its history. North Carolina went 11-1 before Littrell's was hired by the Mean Green on the day of the ACC Championship game. An 8.9 points per game jump (41.2 through 12 games) saw the Heels rank 11th in the country at that time. A 65.9 yards per game increase in total offense saw North Carolina leap 29 spots in the national rankings to 16th. Like his second-year squad in Bloomington, Littrell's offense saw a more balanced attack, achieving that total offensive bump with a slightly decreased production in passing yardage per game.

Tough Sledding

There are six teams that reached bowl games a year ago on the Mean Green's 2017 schedule; Iowa, Southern Miss, UT San Antonio, Old Dominion, Louisiana Tech and Army.

* After winning 24-23 at Louisiana Tech last week, the Mean Green are 4-1 against such opponents (lost to Iowa on Sept. 16, also beat Southern Miss on Sept. 30, UTSA on Oct. 14 and Old Dominion on Oct. 28).

Halftime Leads (Usually) Equal Success

North Texas is 7-1 under head coach Seth Littrell in games where they lead at halftime after winning in last week over Old Dominion. North Texas held a 35-23 halftime lead over the Monarchs and are 3-1 when leading at the half in 2017.

- * The only loss came after failing to hold on to a 14-10 lead at Iowa on Sept. 16.
- * Conversely, they are 4-10 when trailing at the break. The four wins in Littrell's tenure when trailing at the half came last week at Louisiana Tech (trailed 17-10), on Oct. 14 against UT San Antonio (trailed 17-16), on Sept. 30 with a win at Southern Miss (trailed 21-17) and against Rice in 2016 (trailed 17-14).

Home Cooking

North Texas is 7-3 at home during the Seth Littrell era after a 45-38 win over Old Dominion two weeks ago. North Texas is 4-0 at Apogee Stadium in 2017.

* The Mean Green have won each of their last five home games, dating back to last season, when North Texas beat Southern Miss on Nov. 19, 2016.

What's The Rush?

North Texas added two more touchdowns on the ground last week in the win at Louisiana Tech, giving the Mean Green 21 in 2017. They scored 24 rushing touchdowns in 2016.

- * The 21 touchdowns on the ground equals the eighth-most in a single season in Mean green history.
- * North Texas has the third-most rushing touchdowns in Conference USA.
- * Prior to Littrell's arrival, the Mean Green reached the end zone only seven times that way in 2015.

North Texas is second in Conference USA in passing yards per game, at 291.7. (Western Kentucky leads the way at 314.4 yards per game). North Texas has the 20th-ranked passing offense in the country.

- * The Mean Green also rank second in the conference in passing efficiency, at 144.8.
- * North Texas has thrown 19 passing touchdowns, which leads C-USA.
- * The Mean Green are averaging 8.10 yards per pass through eight games in 2017, which leads C-USA and ranks 27th in the country, compared to 6.0 yards per pass in 2016.

O-Line Improvement

North Texas has allowed just 18 sacks in its first nine games (2.00 per game). Last season, North Texas surrendered 43 (3.31 per game).

Third Down Improvement

North Texas struggled in the early stages of 2017 on third downs on both sides of the ball. They have been much-improved offensively lately and continued that trend last week, converting on 9-of-15 tries against Louisiana Tech in a win.

- * Offensively, North Texas is 55-for-127 (43.3 percent) on third downs. That is fourth in Conference USA.
- * Defensively, opponents have converted 66-of-148 third downs (44.6 percent), which

ranks 10th in C-USA.

Turnover Margin

The Mean Green are minus-seven in 2017 in turnover differential after turning it over once last week in the win at Louisiana Tech. Last season North Texas was plus-one.

Harrell Moves Upstairs

Offensive coordinator Graham Harrell has transitioned from an on-field position up into the press box for his second year in charge of the Mean Green offense.

Seth Littrell

Head Coach

Second Year → Oklahoma '01

The University of North Texas named Seth Littrell as its 19th head football coach, University President Neal Smatresk announced on December 5, 2015.

Littrell, 39, led the Mean Green to the second-best turnaround in the Football Bowl Subdivision in 2016, his first season at the helm. North Texas improved its win total by four games, finishing 5-8 on the season with a

Zaxby's Heart of Dallas Bowl appearance. Littrell helped lead the Mean Green to a 9.6 points per game jump in scoring offense from it's output in 2016, which ranked 11th-best in the nation, and the 2016 defense allowed 8.7 points per game fewer than it did in 2015, which was the 13th-best turnaround in the country.

One of the brightest offensive minds in college football, Littrell came to North Texas after serving as the assistant head coach for offense and tight ends at North Carolina. At the time of his hire, the Muskogee, Oklahoma, native was the youngest coach in Conference USA and fifth-youngest in the nation.

North Carolina scored over 30 points nine times in 2015, topped the 40-point mark seven times and scored over 50 points in four games, which is a school record. Through 12 games, UNC averaged 41.2 points a game, which was 11th in the nation.

Under the guidance of Littrell, quarterback Marquise Williams set a new school record for career touchdowns (90) and total offense at North Carolina.

In 2015 with Littrell, the UNC offense averaged 7.46 yards per play, which was second in the nation, and ran the ball for 6.0 yards a carry, which ranked third in the country. UNC was one of just 11 schools in the nation averaging more than 200 yards rushing (229.7) and 250 yards passing (266.0). UNC rushed for over 200 yards eight times and had over 500 yards of total offense in four games in 2015, including 704 yards in a 66-31 win over Duke.

In his first season in Chapel Hill in 2014, Littrell helped Carolina establish several school records, including most passing yards, most passing touchdowns and most first downs. Williams was a second-team all-conference pick after leading the Tar Heels to a bowl game in his first year as the starter, and set several individual school records, including most rushing yards and rushing touchdowns by a quarterback. Carolina gained more than 5,000 yards in Littrell's first season as the play-caller and averaged 429.8 yards per contest.

Littrell came to Chapel Hill from Indiana where he guided one of the most prolific offenses in the country. Indiana finished ninth in the nation in total offense in 2013, averaging 508.5 yards per game. The Hoosiers were 17th in passing offense (306.7 avg.) and 30th in rushing offense (201.8). Indiana was one of only three teams to average more than 300 yards passing and 200 yards rushing

Under Littrell's guidance in 2013, Indiana set single-season records with 6,102 total yards, (508.5 ypg), 461 points, (38.4 ppg), 36 passing touchdowns, 62 total touchdowns and 300 first downs. Tight end Ted Bolser thrived in his system, setting IU career records for receptions, receiving yards and touchdowns by a tight end. Bolser and wide receiver Cody Latimer were selected in the 2014 NFL Draft. Latimer was taken in the second round (56th overall) by the Denver Broncos, while Bolser went in the seventh round to Washington.

In Littrell's first season as Indiana's offensive coordinator in 2012, the Hoosiers led the Big Ten and ranked 17th nationally in passing offense (311.2). They finished second in the conference in total offense (442.0) and fourth in scoring offense (30.8).

Prior to his stint at Indiana, Littrell coached three seasons at Arizona, where his 2011 offense ranked third nationally in passing offense (370.8) and 15th in total offense (465.2).

Three of his Arizona players were selected in the NFL draft: tight end Rob Gronkowski (New England - 2010 second round), quarterback Nick Foles (Philadelphia - 2012 third round) and wide receiver Juron Criner (Oakland - 2012 fifth round).

Prior to Arizona, Littrell served four years as running backs coach at Texas Tech (2005-08) under Mike Leach. The 2008 Red Raiders rushed for 119 yards per game, the highest total in the Leach era. Running back Shannon Woods earned All-Big 12 Conference honors in 2006 after averaging 6.1 yards per carry and snagging 75 receptions, totaling a top 15 national figure of 139 all-purpose yards per game.

Littrell began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Kansas from 2002-04. The Jayhawks played in the 2003 Tangerine Bowl.

Littrell has coached in eight bowl games, played in two and was team captain on Oklahoma's 2000 national championship team. He was a four-year letterwinner at Oklahoma where he rushed for 231 yards and seven touchdowns in 1999 and finished his career with 11 rushing scores.

The Muskogee, Oklahoma, native graduated from Oklahoma with a degree in communications in 2001. Littrell and his wife, Becca, have a son, Tripp, and a daughter, Elle.
