Senior K Trevor Moore has made 148 consecutive extra points heading into week 13, a school record. He is also holds the school record for most PATs made in a career.



North Texas (8-3, 6-1 C-USA) travels to Houston to wrap up its regular season schedule by taking on Rice (1-10, 1-6 C-USA) Saturday at 12 p.m. CT at Rice Stadium. North Texas enters play fresh off a thrilling 52-49 win over Army, who had won six straight entering play. Rice dropped a 24-21 contest at Old Dominion last week. The Mean Green also learned that they will be returning to Boca Raton, Florida, on Dec. 2 for the Dynacraft Conference USA Championship Game to take on Florida Atlantic, by virtue of the Owls' win over FIU.

Saturday's game will be broadcast live on ESPN3 with Alex Del Barrio (pxp) and N.D. Kalu (analyst) as well as on the radio on the Mean Green Sports Network with Dave Barnett (pxp) and Hank Dickenson (analyst).

North Texas' Top Storylines, Streaks & Trends

Next Up

The Mean Green travel to Boca Raton, Florida, next week in search of their first Conference USA championship when they do battle with Florida Atlantic in a rematch of their Oct. 21 meeting. The title game kicks off at 11 a.m. CT and will be broadcast live on ESPN2.

The Mean Green's last conference title came as members of the Sun Belt in 2004.

Four Straight

North Texas knocked off Army West Point 52-49 last week to pick up their fourth straight win. The Mean Green are also 7-1 in their last eight games.

The four-game winning streak is the longest of the Seth Littrell era, and longest since the 2013 season, when the Mean Green had a stretch of five consecutive wins.

52 Pick-Up

The Mean Green posted 52 points, their second-highest point total of the season, and are averaging 38.2 points per game through 11 games, which is second in Conference

USA and 15th in the country.

- * North Texas averaged 24.8 ppg in 2016, taking an 13.4 ppg jump in 2017.
- * The Mean Green made a 9.6 ppg jump in 2016.

That's Offensive

The Mean Green lead the conference in total offense, averaging 477.4 yards per contest, which ranks 16th nationally.

- * North Texas averaged 341.8 yards per game last season, which ranked 12th out of 13 teams in conference last season.
- * The Mean Green are averaging 6.49 yards per play, which ranks 22nd-best nationally.
- * North Texas ranked 117th nationally each of the previous two seasons (5.08 yards per play in 2016 and 4.56 yards per play in 2015). The 2013 team that won the Heart of Dallas Bowl at 9-4, finished 63rd in that category at 5.61 yards per play.

- * North Texas is averaging 73.55 plays per game in 2017, compared to 67 per game in 2016, Littrell's first year in Denton.
- * The Mean Green have surpassed 400 yards of offense in 10 of their 11 games in 2017 and 500 yards on three occasions. North Texas had only five games in 2016 (out of 13) that they went over 400 yards of total offense, none of which topped 500.

That Old Silk Hat

The Mean Green picked up their eighth win of the season last week with their 52-49 win over Army West Point, the program's most since a nine-win season in 2013.

- * Should the Mean Green be selected for a bowl game, it would mark the second straight year that North Texas will have gone bowling. The Mean Green made a bowl last season at 5-7 by virtue of not enough six-win programs being eligible and North Texas' exceptional APR score (Academic Progress Rate).
- * The last time the Mean Green went to bowls in consecutive seasons was 2003 and 2004, part of a run of four consecutive trips to the New Orleans Bowl (2001-04), which included three outright Sun Belt championships and a share of another.

First Downs

North Texas has posted 268 first downs over the first 11 games, and their 24.4 first downs per game ranks best in Conference USA.

- * The Mean Green had 25 first downs last week in the win against Army West Point
- * The 268 first downs rank 10th in the country.

Explosive Plays

The Mean Green had seven plays of 15-yards or more from scrimmage last week in the win against Army West Point and now have 47 offensive plays of 15-plus yards on the season.

* Sophomore quarterback Mason Fine (Locust Grove, Oklahoma) completed six passes of 15 yards or more, last week in the win over Army West Point. Two were good for touchdown passes of 68 yards (in the fourth quarter) and 45 yards (in the first quarter) to senior Turner Smiley (Frisco).

Fine also connected with sophomore Michael Lawrence (Sweetwater, Texas) for a 48-yard gain in the third quarter, which also set up a Fine-to-Lawrence touchdown in the same drive. Fine also connected with fellow sophomore Oklahoman Rico Bussey, Jr. (Lawton, Oklahoma) for a 29-yard gain and an 18-yard gain in the game as well. Fine also hit redshirt sophomore Jalen Guyton for a gain of 17 in the first quarter.

- * Fine has thrown 15 touchdown passes of 20 or more yards this season (26 total).
- * Senior running back Jeffery Wilson (Elkhart, Texas) has 38 runs of 10-plus yards this season.

Wilson Continues to Climb Record Books

Mean Green senior running back Jeffery Wilson (Elkhart, Texas), two-time Conference USA Player of the Week (weeks one and four), carried 19 times for 72 yards and two touchdowns last week in the win over Army West Point. Wilson is the conference's second-leading rusher at 110.5 yards per game, which also ranks 19th nationally. Wilson's 16 rushing scores are seventh-best in the nation and his 1,215 rushing yards also rank 18th-best in the country.

- * Wilson has 188 carries for 1,215 yards and 16 touchdowns this season through 11 games.
- * Wilson had two rushing scores last week during the win over Army West Point when he scored from five and seven yards out in the first and second quarters. Wilson has scored at least one rushing touchdown in 11 of his last 12 games, dating back to the Zaxby's Heart of Dallas Bowl in 2016, also against Army West Point.
- * Wilson's 6.46 yards per carry ranks 15thbest in the nation and he leads C-USA.
- * His 211-yard performance in week four tied for the third-best in the nation that week.
- * Wilson has rushed for 3,205 yards in his career, which places him fourth in school history. Two weeks ago against UTEP he became just the fifth player in school history to reach 3,000 career rushing yards.
- * Wilson is 291 yards from Jamario Thomas' (2004-07) third spot.

- * Wilson has 562 career carries after his 19 totes last week against Army West Point, which ranks sixth in school history in that category after passing Darrin Collins (1986-89) and is 16 behind Kevin Galbreath (2001-02) for fifth.
- * Wilson has a single-season career high of 188, exceeding last season's workload.
- * Last season Wilson finished with 169 carries for 936 yards and 14 touchdowns, which were career highs for a single season in 11 games.

Fine Leading Mean Green Offense

Sophomore quarterback Mason Fine (Locust Grove, Oklahoma) completed 24-of-36 passes for 386 yards and a career-high-tying four touchdown passes with one interception last week in the win over Army West Point. Fine has completed 248-of-388 passes (63.9 percent) for 3,198 yards with 26 touchdowns and 10 interceptions in 2017.

- * Fine is now the school record-holder for most passing yards in a single season after his 386-yard performance against Army West Point. Fine passed Mitch Maher's 1994 season (3,103) yards last week in the win.
- * Fine is on pace to throw for 4,070 yards and 33 touchdowns in a 14-game season (which includes the conference championship and potential bowl game). That would put him first in program history in both passing yards and single-season passing touchdowns.
- * Fine surpassed 4,000 yards passing for his career in the win at La Tech three weeks ago, becoming the seventh North Texas quarterback to hit that milestone.
- * Fine is in seventh place in program history in career passing yards (4,770) with his 386-yard performance last week in the win over

Army. Fine is 376 yards behind the sixth spot, held by Giovanni Vizza (2007-08).

- * Fine is also seventh in program history in career completions (403). Fine trails Scott Hall (2000-04) by 19 completions heading into this week's game at Rice.
- * Fine is in eighth place in school history for his career in passing attempts. The sophomore has 649 through 21 games, and trails Jason Mills (1994-97) by 48 attempts for seventh. Fine passed Vidal Carlin (1965-66) in the win over Army.
- * Fine is in second in Conference USA in passing yards per game (290.7), in passing yards (3,198) and leads the league in passing touchdowns (26).
- * He has thrown for multiple touchdowns in a game eight times this year (each of the first two weeks, vs. Lamar, and at SMU, vs. UAB, at Southern Miss, vs. UTSA, at Florida Atlantic, against UTEP and last week against Army West Point).
- * Fine's 26 touchdown passes through 11 games surpass his output from 10 games last season (six). The 26 touchdown passes also rank 12th in the nation.
- * His 150.1 pass efficiency rating is also the best in the conference.
- * Fine's 424-yard performance in week two at SMU was the sixth-best in program history and the best since Giovanni Vizza threw for 478 against Navy in 2007. Fine is one of eight players in Mean Green history to have thrown for 400 yards or more in a game.

- * Fine's 424-yard performance at SMU is the second-most passing yards in a single game this season in Conference USA after Western Kentucky's Mike White passed for 485 last week in a triple overtime win over Middle Tennessee.
- * After Fine's 386-yard performance last week in the win against Army West Point, Fine has 15 200-yard passing games in his

career, which is the fourth-most in school history. He is tied with Giovanni Vizza (2007-08), who also had 15 and trails Steve Ramsey (1966-69) and Derek Thompson (2009-2013), who each have 20 and are tied for second in that category.

- * Fine has thrown for 200-plus yards in eight straight games, dating back to the win over UAB on Sept. 23.
- * Fine leads C-USA and ranks 19th in FBS in total offense (298.8 yards per game).

Big-Play J-G

Redshirt sophomore wide receiver Jalen Guyton (Allen) caught two passes for 27 yards and a touchdown in the win over Army West Point last week.

- * Guyton was added to the Biletnikoff Award Watch List earlier this season.
- * Guyton was named Conference USA co-Offensive Player of the Week for his performance on Sept. 30 at Southern Miss Guyton's 14 catches (and 211 yards) were the most in a single game for the Mean Green since Carlos Harris' 15 grabs for 216 yards against Southern Miss in 2014. It is also tied for the most catches by anyone in C-USA this year after Western Kentucky's Nacarius Fant hauled in 14 last week in a triple overtime win over Middle Tennessee.
- * Guyton's 211 yards were the ninth-most in a single game in school history and the 14 catches tied several players for fourth-most in school history in a single game.
- * Guyton leads the team in receiving yards with 758 on 47 catches (16.1 yards per catch), and has nine touchdowns.
- * Guyton's nine receiving touchdowns through 11 games would have been the highest touchdown total for a Mean Green receiver in 2016 (six players tied for the team lead with two).
- *He is second in the conference in touchdown grabs, which also is 15th nationally.
- * Guyton is averaging 68.9 yards per game receiving, which is sixth-best in C-USA.
- * His 758 receiving yards are sixth-most in C-USA.
- * Guyton is averaging 4.3 catches per game,

- * Guyton began his career at Notre Dame before transferring to Trinity Valley Community College.
- * Guyton caught 45 passes for 968 yards and 12 touchdowns in 2016 at Trinity Valley.

Moore, Moore, Moore

Senior kicker Trevor Moore holds the school record for most consecutive made extra points, and recently set the record for most career PATs (148). The Edmond, Oklahoma, native pushed his school record to 148 straight made PATs after going 7-for-7 last week in the win over Army West Point. Moore has never missed an extra point attempt in his career. Moore broke the record of 61 straight that was previously held by Keith Chapman (1987-89) last season.

- * Moore converted his only field goal attempt last week in the win over Army West Point, connecting from 39 yards out on a gamewinner with five seconds left in the fourth quarter. Moore is 15-of-17 on field goals this season. His 15th field goal ties him for second-most in a single season in school history with his 2014 season (also 15-for-17) and Dennis Hopovac (2006).
- * Moore's 88.2 field goal percentage ranks seventh-best in FBS.

- * Moore has one Conference USA Special Teams Player of the Week honor this season, after converting on all four field goals, all four extra points, posting five touchbacks and he even recovered a fumble on the final play of the game against UAB in week four.
- * Moore sits atop eight statistical categories in school history. In addition to field goal percentage in a single season and career and most consecutive extra points made, Moore also is the leader in extra point percentage in a single season and career (100 percent), extra points made in a single game (11 against Nicholls in 2014) and field goals made in a single game (five against SMU in 2014). His 148 extra points made are the most in school history, after passing Nick Bazaldua's (2002-05) 121 earlier this season.
- * Moore ranks in the top three in three other North Texas statistical categories, and is tied for third among active Football Bowl Subdivision kickers in consecutive extra points made. The senior aims to wrap his career as the most decorated kicker in school history.

Sophomore wide receiver Michael Lawrence (Sweetwater, Texas) caught four passes for 79 yards and a touchdown last week in the win over Army West Point and is the team-leader in receptions with 49, for 671 yards and three touchdowns (13.2 yards per catch).

- * Lawrence caught an eight-yard strike from fellow sophomore, quarterback Mason Fine (Locust Grove, Oklahoma) in the third quarter. Earlier on the drive, the pair hooked up on a 48-yard pass to put the Mean Green inside the Army 10.
- * Lawrence is averaging 4.5 catches per game, which is seventh in Conference USA, and is averaging 61.0 yards per game, also ranking seventh in the conference.
- * He caught just one pass for 16 yards as a true freshman last year.

Bussey Closing Strong

Sophomore wide receiver Rico Bussey, Jr. (Lawton, Oklahoma) has been a key component of the Mean Green's success this season, especially of late. Bussey has 18 catches for 283 yards and three touchdowns in his last four games after catching a careerhigh-tying seven passes for 85 yards in the win last week over Army West Point.

Though he did not catch a touchdown last week, Bussey has five touchdown receptions

in his last seven games.

* Bussey, Jr. has 32 catches for 433 yards and five touchdowns on the season.

Block That Kick!

North Texas is tied for the lead in FBS with four blocked punts this season, tied with Utah State, Arizona State, Virginia Tech and Northern Illinois.

* Redshirt sophomore safety Taylor Robinson (Keller) and senior defensive back Dee Baulkman (Bainbridge, Georgia) each have blocked two punts apiece.

Excellent Ejiya

Redshirt junior linebacker E.J. Ejiya (Blaine, Minnesota) has a team-high 4.5 sacks on the season and leads the team with 81 total tackles and a team-high 7.5 tackles for loss.

- * Ejiya posted eight stops in the win over Army West Point last week.
- * Ejiya has had double-digit tackles three times this season.
- * Ejiya's 4.5 sacks are tied for eighth in Conference USA.

McClain Leads Mean Green Defense

A preseason All-Conference USA selection for the second consecutive year, senior safety Kishawn McClain (Rosenberg, Texas) garnered second team All-Conference honors in 2016 in Conference USA. For the second straight season, McClain led the team in tackles with 91 (67 solo).

- * McClain recorded a team-high-tying 10 tackles, last week in the win over Army West Point and has a total of 79 stops (4.5 for loss), a forced fumble, an interception and two pass break-ups in 2017.
- * McClain has 319 career tackles for the Mean Green. He is six tackles shy of Lance White (1983-86) for seventh on the program's alltime tackles list.
- * McClain had double-digit tackles four different times in 2016 and has done it three thus far in 2017.

Muhammad Keeps Making Stops

Sophomore safety Khairi Muhammad (Dallas) is third on the team in tackles with 75 total tackles (41 solo) with a sack, three

tackles for loss, a forced and recovered fumble and a pass break-up.

Show Me A Smile(y)

Senior receiver Turner Smiley (Frisco) had a breakout game on senior night, posting three catches for 123 yards and two touchdowns last week in the win over Army West Point.

- * Smiley caught a 45-yard touchdown in the first quarter and a 68-yard score in the fourth quarter last week. The 68-yarder was the longest reception of Smiley's career.
- * Of his 21 catches, seven have gone for 20 or more yards. Smiley has 411 yards receiving with three touchdowns and is averaging a team-high 19.6 yards per catch.

Smith Steps Up

Redshirt freshman Nic Smith (Arlington) carried seven times last week against Army West Point in the win for 35 yards and a touchdown, carrying some of the load after Jeffery Wilson went down with an injury in the third quarter.

Smith has totaled seven touchdowns during his freshman campaign, five of which have come on the ground. He has carried 92 times for 437 yards this season.

Law Firm of Jackson, Chumley and Rutherford

Redshirt junior Quinetin Jackson (Granite City, Illinois), redshirt sophomore Caleb Chumley (Longview, Texas) and redshirt junior O'Keeron Rutherford all recorded catches in North Texas' win over Army West Point last week.

Jackson and Rutherford each made their fourth catches of the season and Chumley hauled in his sixth in a game where 10 different Mean Green receivers caught passes.

Johnson's Big Return

Freshman Evan Johnson (Loranger, Louisiana), who has been a versatile component of North Texas' success this season, had the longest kick return of his career last week in the win over Army West Point, 63 yards. That set up the fourth North Texas touchdown late in the second quarter.

* Johnson leads the team in kick returns, averaging 20.4 yards per return.

Forever (Rod) Young

Junior defensive lineman Roderick Young (Spring, Texas) posted a career-high-tying seven tackles in the win over Army West Point last week.

* Young now has 40 tackles on the season, 5.5 for loss, 2.0 sacks and seven quarterback hurries in 11 starts.

Garner(ing) Respect

Redshirt junior linebacker Brandon Garner (Mansfield, Texas) posted a season-high 10 tackles last week in the win over Army West Point. He also played on several units, including all most on special teams in addition to starting at linebacker.

* Garner now has 54 tackles (5.5 for loss), a sack and three pass break-ups in 2017 in 11 appearances.

Hambone's Career Day

Sophomore defensive end LaDarius Hamilton posted a career-high eight tackles in the win over Army West Point last week. His previous career high of six was set two weeks ago in the win over UTEP.

* Hamilton has 32 tackles in 2017 to go along with 3.0 tackles for loss, five quarterback hurries, an interception and a fumble recovery.

Starting Fast At Home Was Key

After knocking off Army West Point last week at Apogee Stadium, North Texas won all six of its home games in 2017 and a lot of that can be attributed to their quick starts. The Mean Green scored on their first two possessions in five of six home games. In four of those games the Mean Green scored on back-to-back touchdown drives to open the game.

* The only home game where the Mean Green didn't score on their first possession was on 11/11 against UTEP.

Quick-Strike Offense

North Texas can score, and it can score quickly. The Mean Green have 22 touchdown drives this season of two minutes or less.

* North Texas had four such touchdown drives last week in the win over Army West Point. Sophomore quarterback Mason Fine (Locust Grove, Oklahoma) connected with senior receiver Turner Smiley (Frisco) for a pair of scores, first, a 45-yard touchdown in the first quarter on a three-play, 76-yard drive in 1:21 and a 68-yard scoring strike in the fourth quarter on a three-play 71-yard drive in 52 seconds. Fine hit redshirt sophomore receiver Jalen Guyton (Allen) for a 10-yard score in the second quarter, finishing a five-play, 42-yard drive in 1:47. Senior running back Jeffery Wilson (Elkhart, Texas) scored on a seven-yard run to cap a two-play, seven-yard drive in 1:20 in the fourth quarter.

Cardiac Kids

Following the 52-49 win against Army West Point last week, the Mean Green are 5-0 in 2017 in games decided by seven points or less. They were 2-1 in such games last season, the only loss coming in the bowl against Army. North Texas knocked off this week's opponent, Rice, 42-35 in double overtime in Houston last year.

Win The Third Quarter

The Mean Green were outscored by Army West Point 8-7 in the third quarter in last week's win, but North Texas was still able to find a way to win. The Mean Green have been outscored in third quarters in seven of their first 11 games. They have been outscored 98-82 in third stanzas this season.

Fourth Quarter Team

North Texas has outscored its opponents 119-79 in fourth quarters this season, despite being outscored 21-17 last week in the win over Army West Point.

Conference Success

With its sixth conference win coming two weeks ago against UTEP, the Mean Green have their most conference wins since the 2013 season, when they also won six, finishing 6-2 in Conference USA on their way to a Heart of Dallas Bowl victory.

* North Texas is looking for its first sevenwin conference season since 2004, when the Mean Green were 7-0 in Sun Belt play.

Red Zone Success

North Texas has scored on 90.9 percent of its red zone chances this season (40-of-44) with 33 touchdowns. Its red zone scoring percentage ranks 20th in the nation.

Littrell's Second Year Boost

Prior to his arrival in Denton Littrell was an offensive coordinator in three stops throughout his career. Each time his offense hit year two, there was an uptick in total offense and points per game.

- * Through 11 games of year two in Denton, Littrell's team is averaging 38.2 points per game (15th nationally) and they hung 59 on Lamar in the season-opener, the most points scored under Littrell. The Mean Green have topped 40 points on six occasions this season after doing so twice in 2016 and have scored 50 or more points twice in 2017.
- * The Mean Green also posted a school-record 668 yards of total offense (436 on the ground) in week one and are averaging 477.4 yards of total offense per game (16th-best in the nation and best in Conference USA).
- * When Littrell took over as co-offensive coordinator at Arizona, the Wildcats ranked 53rd nationally in scoring at 28.2 points per game, 24th in total offense (439.4 per game) and ninth in passing yardage (307.7 per game). Year two saw the Arizona offense score 2.6 points per game more (30.8), and the team improved to the third-best team in the country in terms of passing yardage (370.8 yards per game), as well as a 37-spot improvement in total offense (465.2).
- * At Indiana in 2012, the Hoosier offense finished 51st in scoring offense (30.8 points per game), 17th in passing offense (311.2) and 34th in total offense (442.0). The Hoosiers then spiked all the way up to 16th nationally in scoring (38.4 points per game), increasing their output by 7.6 points each game. The passing yards per game actually decreased in 2013, however the total offensive output increased by 66.5 yards per game, and finished ninth nationally.
- * At North Carolina the Tar Heels ranked 36th nationally in scoring offense at 33.2 points per game in 2014, while posting 429.8 yards per game of total offense (45th best in the country) and 278.4 yards per game in passing offense (27th in the nation). In 2016, the Heels improve immensely in one of the program's most successful seasons in its history. North Carolina went 11-1 before Littrell's was hired by the Mean Green on the day of the ACC Championship game. An 8.9 points per game jump (41.2 through 12 games) saw the Heels rank 11th in the country at that time. A 65.9 yards per game increase in total offense saw North Carolina leap 29 spots in the national rankings to 16th. Like his second-year squad in Bloomington,

Littrell's offense saw a more balanced attack, achieving that total offensive bump with a slightly decreased production in passing yardage per game.

Tough Sledding

There are six teams that reached bowl games a year ago on the Mean Green's 2017 schedule; Iowa, Southern Miss, UT San Antonio, Old Dominion, Louisiana Tech and Army.

- * After winning 52-49 over Army last week, the Mean Green are 5-1 against such opponents (lost to Iowa on Sept. 16, also beat Southern Miss on Sept. 30, UTSA on Oct. 14, Old Dominion on Oct. 28 and at La Tech on Nov. 4).
- * Seven teams on North Texas' schedule are already bowl eligible, (two more are one win from bowl eligibility). Against teams with at least six wins in 2017, the Mean Green are 4-3.
- * Florida Atlantic is one of those bowleligible teams that defeated North Texas, and the Mean Green will have an opportunity to avenge that October defeat in the Dynacraft Conference USA Championship Game on Dec. 2 back in Boca Raton.

Halftime Leads (Usually) Equal Success

North Texas is 9-1 under head coach Seth Littrell in games where they lead at halftime after winning last week over Army West Point. North Texas held a 28-20 halftime lead over the Black Knights and are 5-1 when leading at the half in 2017.

- * The only loss came after failing to hold on to a 14-10 lead at Iowa on Sept. 16.
- * Conversely, they are 4-10 when trailing at the break. The four wins in Littrell's tenure when trailing at the half came on Nov. 4 at Louisiana Tech (trailed 17-10), on Oct. 14 against UT San Antonio (trailed 17-16), on Sept. 30 with a win at Southern Miss (trailed 21-17) and against this week's opponent, Rice, in 2016 (trailed 17-14).

Home Cooking

North Texas is 9-3 at home during the Seth Littrell era after a 52-49 win over Army West Point last week. North Texas finished 6-0 at Apogee Stadium in 2017.

* The Mean Green have won each of their last seven home games, dating back to last

season, when North Texas beat Southern Miss on Nov. 19, 2016.

* It marked the first undefeated season at home since 2003 and first 6-0 season at home since 1966.

What's The Rush?

North Texas added three more touchdowns on the ground last week in the win over Army West Point, giving the Mean Green 26 in 2017. They scored 24 that way in 2016.

- * The 26 rushing touchdowns on the ground are the fifth-most in a single season in Mean Green history.
- * North Texas has the second-most rushing touchdowns in Conference USA.
- * Prior to Littrell's arrival, the Mean Green reached the end zone only seven times that way in 2015.

#LetItFly

North Texas is second in Conference USA in passing yards per game, at 293.8. (Western Kentucky leads the way at 331.7 yards per game). North Texas has the 19th-ranked passing offense in the country.

- * The Mean Green also lead the conference in passing efficiency, at 149.6.
- * North Texas has thrown 27 passing touchdowns, which leads C-USA.
- * The Mean Green are averaging 8.16 yards per pass through 11 games in 2017, which leads C-USA, compared to 6.0 yards per pass in 2016.

O-Line Improvement

North Texas has allowed just 20 sacks in its first 11 games (1.82 per game). Last season, North Texas surrendered 43 (3.31 per game).

Third Down Improvement

North Texas struggled in the early stages of 2017 on third downs on both sides of the ball. They have been much-improved offensively lately and continued that trend last week, converting on 7-of-11 tries against Army West Point in a win.

- * Offensively, North Texas is 70-for-151 (46.4 percent) on third downs. That is the best in Conference USA and 13th-best nationally.
- * After three weeks of the season, North

Texas was ranked 119th in third down conversions (28.1%) and since then has gone 61-for-119 (51.3%) to climb 106 spots in the national rankings.

* Defensively, opponents have converted 78-of-174 third downs (44.8 percent), which ranks 12th in C-USA.

Turnover Margin

The Mean Green are minus-seven in 2017 in turnover differential after turning it over once last week in the win over Army West Point. Last season North Texas was plus-one.

Harrell Moves Upstairs

Offensive coordinator Graham Harrell transitioned from an on-field position in 2016 up into the press box for his second year in charge of the Mean Green offense.

What's In A (Nick) Name?

Four defensive players in Denton have some pretty interesting nicknames. Redshirt junior defensive tackle Ulaiasi Tauaalo (Keller, Texas) is affectionately known as Toala Bear, sophomore defensive lineman LaDarius Hamilton (Corrigan, Texas) goes by Hambone, senior linebacker Joshua Wheeler (Grand Prairie, Texas) is nicknamed Earl and freshman safety Tyreke Davis (Denton) is known by his teammates simply, as Denton.

Seth Littrell

Head Coach

Second Year → Oklahoma '01

The University of North Texas named Seth Littrell as its 19th head football coach, University President Neal Smatresk announced on December 5, 2015.

Littrell, 39, led the Mean Green to the second-best turnaround in the Football Bowl Subdivision in 2016, his first season at the helm. North Texas improved its win total by four games, finishing 5-8 on the season with a

Zaxby's Heart of Dallas Bowl appearance. Littrell helped lead the Mean Green to a 9.6 points per game jump in scoring offense from it's output in 2016, which ranked 11th-best in the nation, and the 2016 defense allowed 8.7 points per game fewer than it did in 2015, which was the 13th-best turnaround in the country.

One of the brightest offensive minds in college football, Littrell came to North Texas after serving as the assistant head coach for offense and tight ends at North Carolina. At the time of his hire, the Muskogee, Oklahoma, native was the youngest coach in Conference USA and fifth-youngest in the nation.

North Carolina scored over 30 points nine times in 2015, topped the 40-point mark seven times and scored over 50 points in four games, which is a school record. Through 12 games, UNC averaged 41.2 points a game, which was 11th in the nation.

Under the guidance of Littrell, quarterback Marquise Williams set a new school record for career touchdowns (90) and total offense at North Carolina.

In 2015 with Littrell, the UNC offense averaged 7.46 yards per play, which was second in the nation, and ran the ball for 6.0 yards a carry, which ranked third in the country. UNC was one of just 11 schools in the nation averaging more than 200 yards rushing (229.7) and 250 yards passing (266.0). UNC rushed for over 200 yards eight times and had over 500 yards of total offense in four games in 2015, including 704 yards in a 66-31 win over Duke.

In his first season in Chapel Hill in 2014, Littrell helped Carolina establish several school records, including most passing yards, most passing touchdowns and most first downs. Williams was a second-team all-conference pick after leading the Tar Heels to a bowl game in his first year as the starter, and set several individual school records, including most rushing yards and rushing touchdowns by a quarterback. Carolina gained more than 5,000 yards in Littrell's first season as the play-caller and averaged 429.8 yards per contest.

Littrell came to Chapel Hill from Indiana where he guided one of the most prolific offenses in the country. Indiana finished ninth in the nation in total offense in 2013, averaging 508.5 yards per game. The Hoosiers were 17th in passing offense (306.7 avg.) and 30th in rushing offense (201.8). Indiana was one of only three teams to average more than 300 yards passing and 200 yards rushing

Under Littrell's guidance in 2013, Indiana set single-season records with 6,102 total yards, (508.5 ypg), 461 points, (38.4 ppg), 36 passing touchdowns, 62 total touchdowns and 300 first downs. Tight end Ted Bolser thrived in his system, setting IU career records for receptions, receiving yards and touchdowns by a tight end. Bolser and wide receiver Cody Latimer were selected in the 2014 NFL Draft. Latimer was taken in the second round (56th overall) by the Denver Broncos, while Bolser went in the seventh round to Washington.

In Littrell's first season as Indiana's offensive coordinator in 2012, the Hoosiers led the Big Ten and ranked 17th nationally in passing offense (311.2). They finished second in the conference in total offense (442.0) and fourth in scoring offense (30.8).

Prior to his stint at Indiana, Littrell coached three seasons at Arizona, where his 2011 offense ranked third nationally in passing offense (370.8) and 15th in total offense (465.2).

Three of his Arizona players were selected in the NFL draft: tight end Rob Gronkowski (New England - 2010 second round), quarterback Nick Foles (Philadelphia - 2012 third round) and wide receiver Juron Criner (Oakland - 2012 fifth round).

Prior to Arizona, Littrell served four years as running backs coach at Texas Tech (2005-08) under Mike Leach. The 2008 Red Raiders rushed for 119 yards per game, the highest total in the Leach era. Running back Shannon Woods earned All-Big 12 Conference honors in 2006 after averaging 6.1 yards per carry and snagging 75 receptions, totaling a top 15 national figure of 139 all-purpose yards per game.

Littrell began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Kansas from 2002-04. The Jayhawks played in the 2003 Tangerine Bowl.

Littrell has coached in eight bowl games, played in two and was team captain on Oklahoma's 2000 national championship team. He was a four-year letterwinner at Oklahoma where he rushed for 231 yards and seven touchdowns in 1999 and finished his career with 11 rushing scores.

The Muskogee, Oklahoma, native graduated from Oklahoma with a degree in communications in 2001. Littrell and his wife, Becca, have a son, Tripp, and a daughter, Elle.
