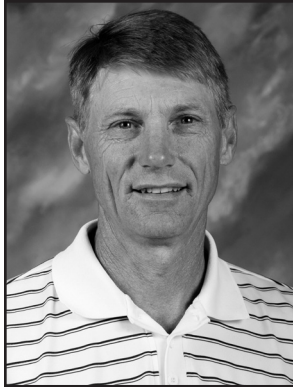

Rick Watkins

Director of Track & Field

19th Year ▶ Abilene Christian

The North Texas track & field program was going through a number of monumental changes when Rick Watkins was named head coach in February of 1997. The program was re-classifying into the ranks of NCAA Division I-A, was moving from the Southland Conference to the Big West Conference and the two teams were being combined into one squad.

Watkins succeeded his mentor, Ken Garland, who had coached Watkins at Denton High School, and under whom he had served as an assistant for three seasons. The program had been successful in the sport of cross-country under Garland, winning seven Southland Conference Cross-Country Championships, but was missing success as a team in track & field.

Watkins inherited a track & field program that had not won a conference track & field championship in 26 years, whose highest finish in the previous eight years in the Southland conference was fifth and that had not had an individual qualify for the NCAA Track & Field Championships for 13 years.

With Watkins at the helm, North Texas has made a steady climb back onto the national landscape, and has become entrenched as one of the top teams in its new conference, the Sun Belt.

Since entering the Sun Belt in 2000, North Texas men's and women's track & field and cross-Country has produced a team finishing either first or second in the Conference standings nine out of 10 years in at least one of those sports. North Texas has won five Sun Belt Conference Championships and had 11 runner-up finishes.

On a national level, North Texas has been represented at the NCAA Championships 10 out of the last 12 years, and the last six years in a row.

At the 2010 NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships, the North Texas women's 4 X 100 Relay team [Missy Barnes, Brittani Simmons, Brittany Blaylock and Alysha Adams] finished 11th, while Adams was also 16th in the 100 meter hurdles at the National Meet.

Watkins has been named Sun Belt Conference Coach of the year four times, and was named the 2002 Men's South Central Regional Coach of the year by the US Track & Field Coaches Association.

During his tenure at North Texas, the Mean Green has produced 434 all-conference performers, with 108 athletes winning individual conference titles. North Texas athletes have also broken 104 school records under Watkins.

The 2010 season started off on the right foot for the Mean Green under Watkins as the men's team finished higher than it ever has, second, in the Sun Belt Conference indoor meet. Overall, there were 22 All-Sun Belt Conference athletes in the indoor season for North Texas, which advanced Keyth Talley to the NCAA Indoor Championship in the 55 meter dash.

When the team moved outdoors, the focus shifted to the women's side as Adams claimed three conference titles (six on the year) and advanced to the NCAA Outdoor Championships individually in the 100-meter hurdles as well as part of the 4x100 meter relay [Missy Barnes, Brittani Simmons and Brittany Blaylock].

Expanding on another productive year on the national stage, Watkins also led freshman hurdler Steven White to a second Place finish at the USA Junior Championships and a spot on the US Junior team which competed at the IAAF World Championships in Canada.

In 2009 Watkins helped coach 44 all-conference athletes and saw the men's 4X400 relay team advance to the NCAA national meet, along with pole vaulter Jordan Where. Talley also became the first athlete in school history to medal at the Pan Am Junior Championships by winning gold in the 4X100-relay and second in the 200-meter dash at Port of Spain, Trinidad and Tobago.

In 2008, Watkins helped coach Ciara Smith (400-meters) and Toby Edwards (high jump) to the NCAA national meet. Smith and Edwards advancing to the NCAA Championship marked the first time since 1983 that North Texas had multiple athletes in different events competing for a national title.

Edwards broke the school record with a jump of 7' 1/2" and became the first high jumper in school history to make the NCAA Championship. Smith was the school record holder in the 400-meter dash clocking in with a time of 53.41 and became the first ever North Texas athlete to earn a trip to the NCAA Championships in the 400-meter dash.

Watkins mentored his second All-American performer in 2006. Freshman Brandi Stanfield competed at the indoor and outdoor NCAA Championships. She earned indoor all-America honors after an 11th place finish in the triple jump. Other accolades included winning the Sun Belt indoor triple jump title, being named the conference's Indoor Field Athlete of the Year as well as the Freshman of the Year in both seasons.

In 2005, North Texas sent 21 student-athletes to the NCAA Midwest Regional Championships in Norman, Okla., the most in the program's history. The Mean Green followed that accomplishment by

sending 19 athletes to regionals in 2006.

In 2000, the North Texas men's cross-country team and the track team won the Sun Belt Conference Championships, marking the first time since 1933 that North Texas had won double titles in the same calendar year.

Placing the Mean Green back on the national map has been a priority since Watkins took the helm. In 1999, cross-country star Paul Ndachi became the first North Texas athlete in 13 years to qualify for the NCAA Cross-Country Championships.

Earlier that spring, the Men's 4 X 100 relay became the school's first NCAA Track and Field qualifiers in 11 years, after breaking the Big West conference record on its way to the conference title. In 1998, the Women's 4 X 400 Relay advanced to the USA Indoor Championships for the first time ever. Since that time,



North Texas has produced 91 NCAA regional or national-qualifying marks.

Watkins has served as the meet director for several high-caliber events, including the 1999 and 2000 USA Track and Field Jr. National Championships, the NCAA South Central Regional Cross-Country Championships from 1997-2000, and several Conference Championship events in the Big West and Sun Belt Conferences.

Watkins also heads up the UIL Class 4A Region II Championships every spring, in which the top athletes from the Dallas-Fort Worth area compete to qualify for the Texas High School State Championships.

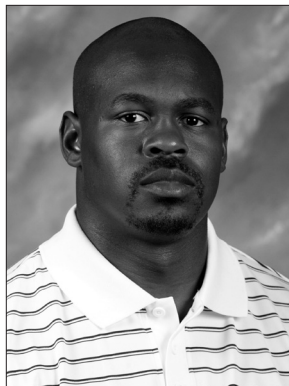
During his collegiate days, Watkins helped lead Abilene Christian to three NAIA and NCAA Division II National Championships, where he was an All-American high jumper and also competed as a decathlete.

As a post-collegian, Watkins finished third at the United States Track and Field Federation Indoor Championships and fifth Outdoors. He was a 1984 Olympic Trials qualifier in the High Jump, and twice represented the United States in the International Friendship Games in Taipei, Taiwan.

Watkins was an assistant track coach at North Texas for three years, also serving as the facilities coordinator for the athletic department. Prior to coming to North Texas, Watkins served as the plan review coordinator for the prestigious Las Colinas real estate development in Irving, Texas, where he was responsible for reviewing and approving all construction plans in the 12,000 acre mixed-use real estate development.

Watkins received his bachelor's degree from Abilene Christian University in industrial technology ('84) and his master's degree in public administration ('95) from the University of North Texas.

He and his wife, Carol have been married 23 years, and have two children, Kacie (20), and Cody (17).



Sammy Dabbs

Assistant Coach

Third Year ▶ North Texas

Sammy Dabbs is entering his third full season as an assistant coach at North Texas and his ninth year working in college athletics. He is responsible for recruiting and coaching the men and women sprints and hurdles for the Mean Green.

Dabbs has a background in performance training as well as strength and conditioning. His philosophy is based with overall development of the person rather than just the specific event. He believes in teaching the basic fundamentals of athletics and applies those principles to the track.

Dabbs' goal is to build the sprints and hurdles program to be the best in the Sun Belt Conference and to compete at the national level. In his three seasons at North Texas, the sprints and hurdles have produced 43 NCAA Regional Marks, eight NCAA Provisional Marks, six NCAA Qualifiers, 23 school records, two overall Sun Belt Conference records, nine All-Midwest Regional performers, 22 Sun Belt Conference Champions, 54 All-Sun Belt performers, four Sun Belt Conference freshman of the year awards and three junior national team qualifiers.

In three seasons, the women hurdlers have dominated the sprint hurdles in the Sun Belt. They won both the indoor and outdoor conference titles. Lauren Wiggins set the Sun Belt Conference Championships records in both the 55H (7.72) and 100H (13.40). In 2008, Wiggins ran the fastest time ever run in Sun Belt history for the 55H.

The 2010 season brought the emergence of sprinter/hurdler Alysha Adams to the forefront for Dabbs. Adams claimed six different conference championships (three indoor and three outdoor) and brought home the Most Outstanding Track Performer award for the Sun Belt Conference Outdoor Championships.

Dabbs would go on to lead Adams to a 17th place finish in the 100 hurdles as well as an 11th place finish as a member of the 4x100 relay [Missy Barnes, Brittany Blaylock and Brittani Simmons] at the NCAA Outdoor Championships. Adams also competed in the USA Championships and advanced to the semi-finals.

The 2010 indoor season also saw sophomore Keyth Talley claim three conference titles and advance to the NCAA Indoor Championships in the 60-meter dash. Talley broke the SBC Indoor Championship record in the 55 and 200-meter dash. He was named the most outstanding track performer.

Also in 2009, the foursome of Talley, Ryan Varner, Byron Washington, and CJ Fowler, finished second at the NCAA Midwest Regional meet in the 4x100 Relay. That is the highest finish of any event at a regional championship in North Texas history. At the NCAA Championships, the same foursome ran the second-fastest time in school history and finished 11th (39.59).

In his first season, the sprints and hurdles group had numerous program firsts at the Midwest Regional meet. The men's 4x100 relay made the Midwest Regional finals for the first time, and the men's 4x400 relay returned to score points after not qualifying the previous two seasons. The women's program scored points in four different events. Ciara Smith and the 4x400 Relay both placed fifth and set school records in recording the program's highest finish in a relay or individual event at the regional meet.

Dabbs studied kinesiology at North Texas and currently holds the 60 hurdles school record. He began coaching in the fall of 2002, just months after his fourth-place finish at the 2002 Outdoor Sun Belt Conference Championships.

In the summer on 2009, Dabbs was selected to participate in the USATF Emerging Elite Coaching Clinic held at the Olympic Training Center in Chula Vista, Calif. The goal of the clinic was to enrich the talent pool of coaches in the United States.

As a youth athlete, Dabbs was a member of the Dallas Gold Track Club where he was coached by Rayford Ross and Mike Hart. He had the opportunity to work as a Performance Training Specialist under Lance Walker, currently of the Michael Johnson Performance Training Center. Carl Sheffield, also of the Michael Johnson Performance Training Center, was his college coach and coaching mentor.

Sam Burroughs

Assistant Coach

First Year ▶ Buffalo

Sam Burroughs begins his first year as an assistant track & field coach at North Texas, primarily responsible for the middle and long

distance running events.

Burroughs has spent the last two years in the same position at Abilene Christian University, where he collected two Lone Star Conference Championships, a South Central Regional Championship and a fourth-place finish at the NCAA Division II championship meet in men's cross country.

He was named the 2008 South Central Regional Coach of the Year by the United States Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches' Association as well as the Lone Star Conference Men's Coach of the Year in 2008 and '09.

In 2010, Burroughs coached Amos Sang to first place finishes in both the 5,000 and 10,000 meter runs at the NCAA Division II Championships as well as leading Sang and Cleophas Tanui to first and second place finishes, respectively, in the 10,000 meter run at the prestigious Penn Relays in 2009.

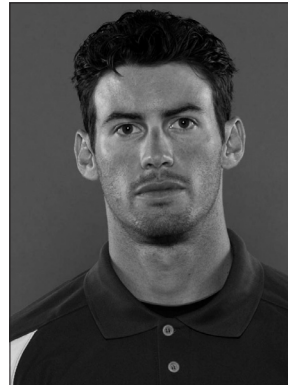
Before joining the ACU staff, Burroughs was the assistant cross country coach and an assistant track and field coach at Iona College (N.Y.) for three seasons.

Burroughs helped lead the Gaels to unprecedented success from 2005-07 as he was part of a program that posted three straight top-four finishes at the NCAA Division I national cross country championship meet.

While at Iona, Burroughs helped coach the Gaels to three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) titles and helped the women's program to its third straight MAAC title.

In track and field, Burroughs coached 13 individual qualifiers for the NCAA Division I indoor and outdoor track and field championships, including three in the 5000 meters and 10,000 meters at the 2008 outdoor championship meet. He coached 13 All-America athletes at Iona and saw 31 male athletes and 25 female athletes claim individual MAAC championships.

Burroughs, who earned his bachelor's degree in exercise physiology in 2000 from the University of Buffalo, competed as a top member of the school's distance teams. Burroughs remained at Buffalo for graduate work, earning his Master of Science in human performance in 2002.



Derek Mackel

Assistant Coach

First Year ▶ New Mexico

Derek Mackel begins his first season as an assistant track & field coach at North Texas after a three-year stint in a similar capacity

at the University of New Mexico. Mackel will work with the pole vaulters and throwers as well as assist head coach Rick Watkins with the multi-events and other field events.

At New Mexico in 2010, Mackel coached pole vaulter Kyle Walker to All-Mountain West Conference honors and a spot in the NCAA West Preliminary Round in the pole vault (17'4"). Mackel, also worked with Sandy Fortner, the Mountain West Conference Heptathlon Champion (5723), a qualifier to the NCAA Outdoor Championships in the Heptathlon. Fortner was named the Mountain West Female Athlete of the Year in 2010. Mackel also coached three women's vaulters in 2010: Kelly Fortner (12'9"), Lauren Jaramillio (12'1") and Amber Menke (12'1"), as well as numerous others.

In 2008, Mackel mentored pole vaulter Robert Caldwell into the 18' club (18'1), and to a 6th place finish at the NCAA Outdoor Championships. Mackel also coached the throwing events at New Mexico and mentored several walk-ons to personal bests in 1 year, including Briana Paxton (158'10 Discus, 45'0" Shot) and Sarah Smartwood (160'10" Hammer).

Mackel, the 2006 NCAA Midwest Regional pole vault champion, also set the Midwest Regional record in that event (18' 1") and was one of the great success stories in UNM track & field history. He began as an unrecruited walk-on in 2002, with a best vault of under 12' in high school. He improved by more than six feet during his collegiate career to become one of the nation's premier vaulters.

He is a 2006 graduate of the University of New Mexico, receiving his bachelor's degree in university studies and received an master's degree in exercise science from the University of New Mexico in 2010.
