Fifth Year as Director; 21st at NT → UTA '93

Director of Track & Field Carl Sheffield enters his fifth season at the helm at North Texas and 21st year overall.

In 2015-16, the men's team placed fifth and the women's sixth at the 2016 C-USA Outdoor Track and Field championships. The women's team was led by graduate student Chastity Stewart, who took home two first-place finishes in the 100 and 400-meter hurdles, and was a part of the second-place finish in the women's 4x100-

meter relay. The men's squad came away with 15 top-10 finishes, including a first-place finish by Kevone Kennedy in the discus, and a second-place finish by Jordan Faughtenberry in the pole vault.

Eight track and field athletes qualified for NCAA West Preliminaries in Mona Landry, Jazmine Martin, Collin Heard, Nadiyah El-Amin, Bryce McAndrew, Siara Obasuyi, Chastity Stewart, and Eddie Wilcox. Connor Bey and Susie Kemper were named to the C-USA All-Academic team and both earned CoSIDA Academic All-District awards. Stewart qualified for NCAA nationals in two events (100 and 400-meter hurdles), finishing 22nd in both events in Eugene, Ore.

In 2015, Sheffield helped coach nine student-athletes qualify for the NCAA West Preliminaries during the outdoor season. Senior Shahaf Bereni qualified in the high jump and finished in the top 25 with a jump of 1.73 meters.

At the 2015 Conference USA Outdoor Championships, Sheffield helped the men's team finish sixth with three podium finishes and 14 top-8 finalists. On the women's side, two student-athletes came in the top-3 and 10 finished in the top eight.

During the indoor season, the men's team finished fifth and the women's team came in fourth thanks to three individual wins from Troy Taylor (3000 meter run), Shahaf Bereni (High Jump) and Susie Kemper (1 mile).

Under Sheffield, the Mean Green has continued to see success at the national level. North Texas has sent at least one athlete to the NCAA Championships in nine out of the last 11 years.

At the helm of the prestigious track and field program at North Texas, Sheffield has led the Mean Green to two conference championships and two runner-up titles in the last five years. The women's outdoor program won back-to-back titles in 2012 and 2013, while the women's indoor team picked up second-place honors in 2012 and 2013. The 2012 outdoor title was the best finish for the women since winning the championship in 2003.

Sheffield also guided the men's team to the most individual outdoor champions, five in 2012, since 2008 when North Texas had six individual outdoor champions.

Individually, Sheffield has been recognized for his team's success. He was named the Sun Belt Conference Outdoor Coach of the Year in 2012 and 2013. He was also named the indoor coach of the year in 2012.

In 2014, Sheffield coached both Clinton Collins and Chastity Stewart to the NCAA Championship with Collins earning All-American honors with a 15th-place finish in the semifinal round of the men's 400. Both Collins and Stewart were also individual champions at the 2014 Conference USA Conference Championship.

Sheffield guided 12 athletes to qualify for the NCAA West Preliminaries in 2014. At NCAA West Prelims, the 4X400M Relay team of Connor Bey, Clinton Collins, Collin Heard and Anthony Hamilton placed 18th, and freshman Elisha Peters placed 25th in the women's high jump.

In 2013, track and field sent a combined three athletes to the NCAA Finals. It was the first time that three Mean Green athletes participating in individual events went to the NCAA Championships since 1983.

Shahaf Bareni's sixth-place finish at the NCAA West Prelims ensured her a spot at the NCAA Championships. Bareni placed seventh at the championships with a record-breaking jump of 1.83 meters, one of the top finishes in school history.

Steven White finished his career with a third-place finish in the men's 400-meter hurdles in a school record 49.32 at the NCAA Championships White's third-place finish is the best for North Texas by an individual or relay team since Bill Schmidt finished second in the men's javelin at the championships in 1970.

In 2012, White was named an USTFCA Second-Team All-American after finishing 14th in the NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships in the 400-meter hurdles. White also participated in the U.S. Olympic Trials.

Sheffield spent 12 years coaching as a Mean Green track & field assistant coach from 1996 to 2007 before departing for an opportunity to be the performance coach at the Michael Johnson Training Center in McKinney, Texas.

Under Sheffield's guidance as the sprints and hurdles coach at North Texas, his athletes established or tied over 20 school records and earned more than 70 all-conference awards from 1996-2007. The Mean Green won four team championships with Sheffield on staff, two each on the men's and women's sides.

He brings enhanced credentials through his work at the Michael Johnson Training Center where he focused on improving the ability of his athletes to integrate linear speed concepts through biomechanics, motor control and performance analysis.

Sheffield began his coaching career as a volunteer assistant at LSU in 1988. The Tigers went on to win a string of 11 consecutive NCAA Indoor and Outdoor Championships. He also coached national-caliber athletes with Nike-sponsored teams in Texas and along the Atlantic coast before his first stint at North Texas.

A native of Dallas, Sheffield was one of the top-five hurdlers in the state while attending Skyline High School and attended UTA on scholarship as a high hurdler.

After earning his bachelor's degree from UTA in 1993, Sheffield earned his Master of Science from North Texas in exercise physiology in 1996. In addition to his coaching duties, he served as an adjunct instructor for North Texas from 2005-07 for the Department of Kinesiology.

Carl and his wife, Tara, have two sons, Julian and Aiden.

David Burnett

Assistant Coach

First Year → UTSA '06

Burnett enters his first season with North Texas as an assistant coach.

Burnett comes to North Texas after spending the last five seasons as the top assistant at Division II power Western Washington.

Burnett was the 2014 USTFCCCA West Region Assistant Coach of the Year, leading the Vikings to five top 25 NCAA team finishes.

Burnett has helped produced five Great Northwest Athletic Conference championships at Western Washington (two men's indoor, three men's outdoor) and has coached 10 student-athletes achieve All-America honors. He also coached 27 GNAC champions and five USTFCCCA academic All-America honorees.

Before Western Washington, Burnett spent five seasons (2006-11) as an assistant coach at UTSA, earning Southland Conference Assistant Coach of the Year honors all five seasons. During UTSA tenure, the Roadrunners won seven conference team track championships (five indoor and two outdoor). He coached 18 Midwest Regional all-stars, 20 league champions and 12 school record setters.

Among athletes coached were sprinter Teddy Williams (currently plays special teams with NFL's Carolina Panthers), a four-time All-America who reached semifinals in 100 meters at 2008 U.S. Olympic Trials, and William Vesse, a four-time SLC champion in the 110 hurdles, who finished fourth in the 2008 Nigerian Olympic Trials.

In 2009, the UTSA Athletic Department created the David Burnett Roadrunner Pride Award to honor hard working student-athlete showing dedication and school pride. As a former UTSA student-athlete, Burnett earned the inaugural Southland Conference Steve McCarty Citizenship Award as the top overall student athlete in the conference, helping the Roadrunners to its first league indoor title. Twice a team captain, he was a 10-time all-conference performer, winning the 400 at the league indoor meet in 2005 and ranking 11th nationally in the 100 in 2002.

Burnett was twice a Midwest Regional qualifier, a four-time member of the SLC Commissioners Honor Roll, a NCAA Inspiration Award nominee and a semifinalist for the John Wooden Golden Cup Inspiration Award.

Burnett earned a bachelor's degree at UTSA in 2006, majoring in kinesiology. He also began work on a master's degree while coaching for the Roadrunners. Burnett has earned the USA weightlifting sports performance certification, USA Track and Field level 1 certification and the USTFCCCA advanced strength and conditioning specialist certification.

Burnett, whose family is from Jamaica, attended Carroll High School in Corpus Christi, Texas. There he was a three-sport star, being named the South Texas Athlete of the Year as a senior, twice earning all-state honors in track and receiving All-America recognition in soccer.

Burnett is married to the former Jessica Gertz. She was a track athlete at Concordia University, St. Paul and Minnesota State University, Mankato. They recently welcomed their first child, Ezekiel, in August 2016.



Derek Mackel

Assistant Coach

Seventh Year → New Mexico '06

Derek Mackel begins his sixth season as an assistant track & field coach at North Texas.

Mackel works primarily with the pole vaulters, long jumpers, triple jumpers, high jumpers and multi-event athletes.

During his six seasons at North Texas, Mackel has coached one All-American in Shahaf Bareni, 26 all-conference student-athletes, 21 NCAA Preliminary participants and has seen seven school records broken.

In 2016, three of Mackel's athletes advanced to the NCAA Preliminary round in senior Eddie Wilcox (HJ), senior Mona Landry (LJ, 4x100) and Jazmine Martin (TJ). Wilcox became the C-USA indoor high jump champion, clearing 2.17 meters. In outdoors, Wilcox matched his career high at 2.17 meters to set the North Texas outdoor high jump record. In pole vault, Mackel coached Gabe McAdams and Jordan Faughtenberry to podium finishes at the C-USA outdoor championships.

In 2015, Mackel helped coach three student-athletes who qualified for the NCAA West Prelims in Mona Landry (100 meter dash, long jump), Shahaf Bereni (high jump) and Jazmine Martin (triple jump).

Mackel was a part of Bereni's first-place finish in the high jump at the C-USA Indoor Championship and a third-place finish at the C-USA Outdoor Championship. He also coached eight top-5 finishes and three podium finishes in Derek Richard (pole vault) and Eddie Wilcox (high jump).

Mackel's guidance of the 2014 jump squad sent three athletes to the NCAA preliminary round. Mona Landry earned third-team all-conference honors in the C-USA Outdoor Championship and two other student-athletes earned all-conference status.

During 2013, junior Shahaf Bareni advanced to the NCAA Championship final and became the second jumper from North Texas to earn All-American honors with a seventh-place showing at 1.83 meters (6'0"), a school record.

Chelsea Hermes broke the school record in the heptathlon at the 2013 Sun Belt Outdoor Conference Championships, and Bareni broke the SBC Championships record for the second consecutive year in the high jump.

In his second season at North Texas, Mackel's athletes brought down two records at the 2012 Sun Belt Outdoor Conference Championship when Bareni won the women's high jump, qualifying her to the NCAA West Prelims, and Hermes claimed the No. 1 spot in North Texas history during the heptathlon.

The 2012 campaign saw big improvements from the women's pole vaulters as Sarah Vann took home all-conference honors during both the indoor and outdoor championships. All together, the jumps group would string 42 points up for the team score en route to being crowned team champions.

In his first season at North Texas, Mackel worked with the throwers and jumpers. He quickly made an impact as one school record fell, two vaulters qualified for the NCAA West Preliminary Round and a long jumper would earn a silver medal at the Jr. Pan-Am Championships.

In his time at New Mexico, Mackel coached pole vaulter Kyle Walker to a secondplace finish, All-Mountain West Conference honors and a spot in the NCAA West Preliminary Round with a vault of 5.35m (17'4").

Mackel also worked with Sandy Fortner, the Mountain West Conference Heptathlon Champion (5723) and a qualifier to the NCAA Outdoor Championships in the heptathlon. Fortner was named the Mountain West Female Athlete of the Year in 2010. Mackel mentored pole vaulter Robert Caldwell who would go on to earn All-American honors at the 2008 NCAA outdoor championship with a sixth-place finish.

Mackel, the 2006 NCAA Midwest Regional pole vault champion, also set the Midwest Regional record in that event at 5.51m (18' 1") and was one of the great success stories in UNM track & field history. He began as an unrecruited walk-on in 2002, with a best vault of under 12' out of high school. As a Lobo, Mackel improved by more than six feet during his collegiate career, earning six letters, three All-MWC conference honors and was named MWC Athlete of the Week and Midwest Region Male Athlete of the Year.

He is a 2006 graduate of the University of New Mexico, receiving his bachelor's degree in university studies and received a master's degree in exercise science from the University of New Mexico in 2010.





Stefanie Slekis

Assistant Coach

Fourth Year ▶ Syracuse '10

Stefanie Slekis is in her fourth year as the North Texas cross country coach and the assistant coach for track and field in 2016-17.

In her first four years as the cross country coach, Slekis has led the Mean Green cross-

country programs to a conference championship, three third-place finishes and a runner-up finish in 2013.

A combined 27 North Texas runners received all-conference individual honors and eight were named all-region in the last three years under Slekis. Slekis was named the 2014 C-USA Coach of the Year after the men's team won its first Conference USA Championship.

In 2016, Slekis helped senior distance runner Bryce McAndrew qualify for the NCAA West preliminaries in the 1500-meter run. McAndrew also set a school record in the 5,000-meter run at the Bryan Clay Invitational in 2016. Senior Susie Kemper was named to the C-USA All-Academic team and earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honoree.

In cross country, the men's team finished fourth at the C-USA championships and the women's team placed sixth. Five North Texas runners made all-conference with sophomore Susannah Lynch coming in fourth to lead the way. James Coleman (16th), Florian Lussy (18th), Mike Lowe (19th), and Christina Moralez (19th) also earned all-conference honors.

The men's team finished the season ranked ninth in the NCAA South Central Region, and the women's team finished 12th. Freshman Florian Lussy earned all-region after coming in 15th place and Lynch was all-region finishing in 23rd place. Coleman and Lynch were named to the C-USA all-academic team.

The men's cross country team received votes in the top 25 national rankings for the first time in school history in 2015. The men's team finished third at the C-USA championships and finished the season ranked seventh in the NCAA South Central region. Bryce McAndrew finished 17th to earn all-region status at the 2015 NCAA South Central Regional Championships.

At the 2014 NCAA South Central Regional Championships, the men and women's teams continued to surpass their previous rankings, placing within the top 10 for the second year in a row, with the men's team finishing fourth and the women's team placing eighth. Troy Taylor placed eighth in the men's 10K race, allowing him to compete in the NCAA Cross-Country National Championships.

The Mean Green distance men recorded a win, four podium finishes and seven top-eight finalists at the 2015 C-USA indoor track championships, while the women's team grabbed a win, three podium finishes and two top-eight finalists.

At the 2015 C-USA outdoor track championships, Troy Taylor earned all-conference honors placing third at the 1500 meter run, while 10 additional athletes scored team points in their events with top eight finishes.

In the 2014 indoor and outdoor track and field seasons, Slekis led the distance program to seven school records, including the men's indoor distance medley relay, indoor 5000m, and indoor 800m and the women's indoor 5000m, mile, and outdoor women's 3000m Steeplechase and 10,000m.

The Mean Green distance men recorded six top-eight finishes at the 2014 C-USA Indoor Championships, while the women's side grabbed two runner-up finishes and an additional top-six finish. At the 2014 C-USA Outdoor Championships three athletes earned all-conference honors, placing in the top three in their

Troy Taylor and Charlotte Wilson went on to represent Mean Green distance at the 2014 NCAA Outdoor Track and Field West Preliminary Round of the National Championship. Taylor competed in the men's 1500m while Wilson competed in the women's 3000m steeplechase. Wilson also recorded the fifth fastest women's



Brendon Kelso

Assistant Coach

Third Year ▶ Hardin-Simmons '12

Brendon Kelso is in his third year as an assistant track & field coach at North Texas after serving two years as a volunteer assistant coach. Kelso works primarily with the throwers.

In 2016, Kelso helped the Mean Green

throwers to two school records. Senior Ngozi Nweke broke the weight throw mark with a throw of 17.70 meters at the Houston Indoor Invite. Nweke also threw the second-best discus mark in school history at 49.15 meters at the John Jacobs Invite during the outdoor season.

Sophomore Kevone Kennedy became a conference champion in the men's discus. Senior Riley Donovan had a breakout season finishing top-10 in three events (discus, hammer throw, shot put) at the Conference USA championships. Donovan's personal best hammer throw mark of 56.42 was second best in school history. During the indoor season, Donovan finished fourth in the weight throw at the C-USA championships.

Senior Victoria Clark improved her school record in the hammer throw at 55.52 meters, earning second at the C-USA championships. Kelso guided freshman javelin thrower Javier Lopez to a seventh place finish in conference and his personal best throw of 60.26 meters was third best in school history.

During the 2015 season, Kelso guided the Mean Green throwers to two school records. The first of which occurred during indoor competition when Deja McKnight launched a throw of 17.27 meters (56'8") in the weight throw at the New Mexico Classic to solidify the furthest throw in North Texas history.

McKnight also posted the No. 3 throw in the shot put at North Texas with a toss of 14.69m (48' 2.5"), which was good for third place at the Conference USA Championships.

The second school record fell during the outdoor season when Victoria Clark unleashed a massive hammer throw measuring 55.14 meters (180' 11").

In 2014, Kelso helped coach Tom Kalisky to qualify to NCAA West National Championships Preliminary Rounds in the javelin throw with a monster throw of 64.02 meters (210'), the second-furthest throw in school history with a new rules javelin

In his first year at North Texas, Kelso helped coach Deja McKnight to a secondplace finish at the Indoor Sun Belt Conference Championships. McKnight, Victoria Clark and Ngozi Nweke claimed three of the eight scoring places in the shot put, adding 17 points to the women's team score tying the 200 meter dash for the most points scored in a single event and paved the way for the women's team to win the 2013 Women's Sun Belt Conference Outdoor Track & Field Championship.

In that same year, Aaron Sirles broke the school record in the hammer throw and took third place in the shot put at both the Indoor and Outdoor Sun Belt Conference Championships. Sirles capped his senior year with a personal best discus throw, qualifying him for the NCAA West Prelims.

Kelso also helped coach Charleston Lewis to break the school record in the 35lb weight throw. Solidifying a fourth-place finish in men's weight throw during the Sun Belt Conference Championships, John Garrish threw a personal best and school record of 18.56 meters (60' 10.75"), surpassing Lewis' mark set earlier that season. Garrish also set the current school record in the hammer throw with a launch of 58.34 meters (191' 5"), surpassing Sirles' mark set earlier that year.

As a student-athlete at Hardin-Simmons University, Kelso competed in the 2009 DIII National Championships in the javelin throw and holds the school record in the event. He was a four-time American Southwest Conference Champion in multiple throwing events, including the javelin, shot put, and discus and was once named American Southwest Conference Championships Outstanding Field athlete and twice won the Conference Championships High Point Award.
