Instruction Sheet

The law governing the Federal Student Aid programs is based on the premise that your family is the first source of your support as a student and the law provides several criteria that decide if you are considered independent of your parents for aid eligibility. If you are considered a dependent of your parents, information on the income and assets of your parents must be included on the FAFSA.

Please review the following circumstances to determine which one applies to your family situation:

A) Is there a case of abuse, abandonment and/or neglect in your relationship with your biological mother and father? If so, you may be eligible to pursue a dependency override. If the dependency override is approved, your dependent status will be overridden. Once your FAFSA is processed and finalized, you will be considered for any other Federal, State and/or Institutional financial aid [i.e. grants (including Federal Pell Grant), work-study and student loans]. **Please contact our office for further information on the dependency override process.**

B) Do your parents refuse to complete the FAFSA? Do your parents not provide you with any means of financial support (including paying educational costs, room and/or board, medical or auto insurance, claiming student on taxes, paying other expenses on the student's behalf and/or other cash and non-cash support)? If so, the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008 (HEOA) granted students whose parents refuse to provide support eligibility to receive Direct unsubsidized loans only up to their dependent loan limit. You would NOT be eligible for any other Federal, State and/or Institutional financial aid [i.e. grants (including Federal Pell Grant), work-study or need based student loans]. Please have your parent complete the attached form and return it to our office.

C) If your family situation does not meet either of the requirements listed above, you will be required to provide parental information on your FAFSA. You will need to access your FAFSA at <u>http://www.fafsa.gov</u> and make any necessary corrections to submit required parental information.
