04.012 UNT Tobacco Free Workplace Policy	Administration

Policy Statement. As a recipient of funds from the Cancer Prevention and Research Institute of Texas, the University of North Texas adopts this policy to provide for the health and safety of students, faculty, and staff by establishing a tobacco-free environment in certain academic and administrative facilities.

Application of Policy. Total University

Definitions:

“Tobacco products:” means all forms of tobacco products, including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, pipes, water pipes (hookah), bidis, kreteks, electronic cigarettes, smokeless tobacco, snuff and chewing tobacco.

Procedures and Responsibilities.

Policy.

The use of all tobacco products is prohibited by all employees and visitors in the Life Sciences complex as well as the sidewalks, parking lots, walkways, and attached parking structures immediately adjacent.
