


The Education Population Goal - By 2030, at least 60% of Texans ages 25-34 will have a certificate or degree.

- By 2030, Metroplex population in Age 25-34 will be 1.258.373.









The Completion Goal - By 2030, at least <u>550,000</u> students in that year will complete a certificate or above from a higher education institution in Texas.







- By 2030, Metroplex Population will reach 4,143,506.

- By 2030, UNT Dallas is expected to contribute 1052 compare to 567 in FY2016.












The Marketable Skills Goal - By 2030, all graduates will have completed programs with identified marketable skills.
