# **The Position**

Lead tutors are model students who effectively facilitate a variety of tutoring services in the Learning Center, including one-on-one tutoring, walk-in tutoring, and online tutoring. Lead tutors also act as ambassadors for the Learning Center, facilitating a variety of workshops and presentations, visiting classes, and advertising the department's programs. When required, lead tutors also assist in the development and training of the Learning Center's volunteer tutors.

### Requirements

- Possess a GPA of 3.0 or higher in a graduate-level program
- Earned a grade of "A" in the courses in which a tutor facilitates OR demonstrated experience/equivalency in graduate-level statistics
- Ability to communicate well through both oral and written forms of communication
- Knowledge of technical computer skills, with preferred knowledge in Microsoft Office
- Knowledge of technical statistics programs, including SPSS, Excel, and R
- Availability to attend the weekly LT meetings
- Availability to work 15 hours each week
- Tutoring experience is preferred
