The schedule for this highly individualized program includes: daily private lessons, daily solo master classes, rehearsal and performance with highly skilled accompanists, and maximum practice time. In addition, repertoire, programming and career advancement will be discussed.

The five days include technical training, solo classes, orchestral studies, video recording, Texas All-State workshop, jazz classes with Lynn Seaton, and 10 students will have a chance to win a free set of strings from D'Addario.
