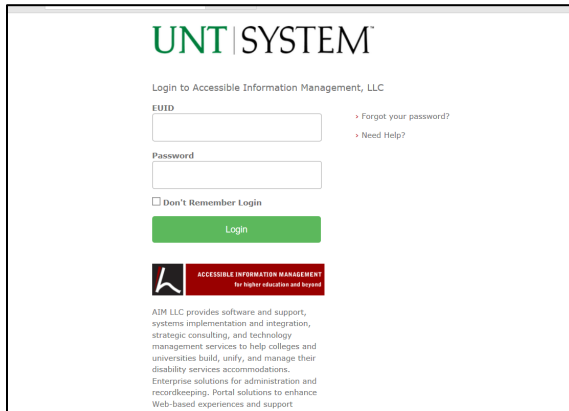


HOW DO I ACCESS AIM – NEW STUDENTS
