

BA IN SPANISH WITH ALL LEVEL TEACHER'S CERTIFICATION DEGREE IN THREE ACADEMIC MAP

2018-2019 CATALOG YEAR

Students who earn a Bachelor of Arts in Spanish with an All Level Teacher's Certification will be certified to teach Spanish for grade levels EC-12. The degree will require students to complete a minimum of 36 semester hours in Spanish, including 21 hours of advanced Spanish, 3 hours of foreign language teaching methods, and 3 hours of phonetics and pronunciation or linguistics structures in Spanish.

An All Level Spanish certification student also earns 21 hours of Secondary Education courses. Admission to the College of Education Teacher Education program is required prior to enrollment in most education courses. To apply, student must have earned at least 60 credit hours with a 2.75 GPA. Contact the College of Education Student Advising Office for admission requirements and application.
