Technique Requirements for Clarinet*

Level I

Major scales and arpeggios Chromatic scale – E –G 3 octaves, A-flat-E-flat 2 octaves

Level II

Minor scales in three forms and arpeggios Major scales in thirds through 3 sharps and 3 flats Chromatic pattern I (Clarinet Handbook)

Level III

Major and minor scales (three forms) extended with arpeggios Completed major scales in thirds Chromatic pattern II and III

Level IV

All major and minor scales (three forms) extended with arpeggios memorized Minor scales in thirds (Baermann III minimum) Diminished seventh arpeggios

Level V

Major and minor arpeggios broken forms Diminished seventh arpeggios memorized Major-minor seventh arpeggios (Clarinet Handbook)

Level VI

Whole tone scales and arpeggios Seventh arpeggio patterns

Level VII

Whole tones scales and arpeggios memorized Fourths and tritones Seventh arpeggio patterns (Clarinet Handbook) memorized

*All technique must be performed in standard articulations (i.e. all slurred, all articulated, 2 slurred + two articulated etc) and assigned tempos . All technical exercises can be found in Klose, Baermann, Langenus, Jeanjean, etc as assigned.

BM, BA, MM, DMA and PhD concentrations in clarinet must demonstrate a minimum proficiency through Level VI.

BM, MM, and DMA must demonstrate proficiency through Level VII
