Course Topic: MID EAST POLITICS THROUGH FILM

USING FILM AND LITERATURE, THIS COURSE PROVIDES A NUANCED UNDERSTANDING OF THE POLITICAL, ECONOMIC, AND CULTURAL CHANGES THAT HAVE OCCURRED IN THE MODERN MIDDLE EAST AND NORTH AFRICA IN THE 20TH AND 21ST CENTURIES, INCLUDING SOME CONTEMPORARY CONFLICTS AND TRANSITIONS. WE WILL WATCH AND CRITICALLY ANALYZE FILMS (AS WELL AS A FEW GRAPHIC NOVELS, POEMS, AND SHORT STORIES) PRODUCED IN OR ABOUT THE MIDDLE EAST.

THE SPECIFIC TOPICS COVERED IN THE COURSE INCLUDE EUROPEAN COLONIALISM, RISE OF NATIONALISM AND THE CREATION OF MODERN STATES, WORLD WARS AND THE COLD WAR; THE PALESTINIAN-ISRAELI CONFLICT, THE POLITICS OF OIL AND U.S. POLICY IN THE REGION, THE RISE OF ISLAMIST MOVEMENTS, SOCIAL MOVEMENTS, INCLUDING FEMINIST ONES, AND THE 2011 ARAB UPRISINGS. WE WILL ALSO PAY ATTENTION TO SOME OF THE ONGOING CONFLICTS IN THE BROADER REGION.

THE COUNTRIES OF FOCUS INCLUDE TURKEY, IRAN, EGYPT, TUNISIA, IRAQ, SYRIA, ISRAEL/PALESTINE, SAUDI ARABIA AND OTHER GULF COUNTRIES.

SOME KNOWLEDGE OF MIDDLE EASTERN HISTORY OR RELATED COURSEWORK WILL HELP, BUT THESE ARE NOT REQUIRED. THE COURSE IS OPEN TO ALL STUDENTS WHO HAVE AN INTEREST IN THE REGION'S POLITICS AND CULTURE.

 Course Topic: MID EAST POLITICS THROUGH FILM  
 RESTRICTED COURSE. APPROVAL REQUIRED. CONTACT DEPARTMENT.  
 WHAT HAS BEEN THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN POLITICS, RELIGION AND GENDER IN THE MIDDLE EAST? DOES ISLAM OPPRESS WOMEN? WHAT HAS BEEN THE ROLE OF THE NATION-STATE IN THE 20TH AND 21ST CENTURIES IN CODIFYING GENDER RELATIONS? THE FIRST PART OF THE COURSE WILL BE CONCEPTUAL. WE WILL DISCUSS EDWARD SAID'S INFLUENTIAL CRITIQUE OF ORIENTALISM, AND ALSO THE MEANING OF USING GENDER AS AN ANALYTICAL CATEGORY IN UNDERSTANDING HISTORY AND SOCIETY.

IN THE SECOND PART OF THE COURSE WE WILL LEARN KEY ISLAMIC BELIEFS AND PRACTICES. THIS IS NOT A COURSE ON QURANIC EXEGESIS THOUGH OUR DISCUSSIONS WILL BEAR ON HOW ABRAHAMIC TRADITIONS WERE SHAPED WITHIN CONCRETELY PATRIARCHAL SOCIETIES. IN PARTICULAR, WE WILL DISCUSS LEILA AHMED'S (1992) ARGUMENT REGARDING WHETHER ISLAM PROMOTES EQUALITY BETWEEN MEN AND WOMEN.

IN THE THIRD PART, WE WILL FOCUS ON HOW NATIONALIST AND RELIGIOUS IDEAS, PRACTICES AND MOVEMENTS INTERACTED TO PRODUCE NEW, "MODERN" INTERPRETATIONS OF ISLAM IN THE 20TH AND 21ST CENTURIES, AND WHAT THESE INTERPRETATIONS HAVE MEANT FOR THE REGION'S DIFFERENT POLITICAL REGIMES IN GENERAL, AND THEIR GENDER POLITICS IN PARTICULAR. FOR THIS PART, WE WILL BE READING JAMES GELVIN'S THE MODERN MIDDLE EAST AS WELL AS ARTICLES ABOUT CONTEMPORARY POLITICS OF GENDER IN TURKEY, EGYPT, MOROCCO, IRAN, PAKISTAN, AFGHANISTAN AND SAUDI ARABIA.
