Please note the following clarifications are hereby made to the aforementioned RFP.

**ANSWERS to QUESTIONS**

1) In order for an upgraded control system to drive content to the Art Wall display, a new Daktronics display processor must be purchased to interface with the existing Data Distributor. The Data Distributor on its own cannot accept a video feed directly as can a VIP-4060, or a feed from any other potential vendor's product. Please advise if we should include this VIP-4060 in our base proposal.

**If a new VIP 4060 is required to run the art wall please include that in your response.**

2) For non-Daktronics proposals, usage of the Daktronics Scoring and Timing Interface (DSTI) computer is not valid. The DSTI software that runs on the DSTI computer outputs data in a proprietary Daktronics format that other vendors are not authorized to use. Each other vendor will need to include their own scoring/data interface appropriate for their respective control systems. If a data feed is required for game-in-progress data from the Daktronics All Sport, a Daktronics All Sport CG can be used to provide an RS-232 feed. If UNT does not have an available All Sport CG for use at football, Daktronics can provide a quote to UNT or to individual vendors.

**Respondent should include necessary equipment to interface with DSTI Computer. If the proposed solution requires the use of a Daktronics All Sport CG, that cost should be included in the response.**

3) Can you specify a required amount of training required?

**Please indicate the amount of training, and cost if applicable, the solution will require for staff to become familiar and comfortable using solution.**

4) Can you specify the amount of potential events supports required?

**Event support for first football game-currently scheduled for 9/5/20**

5) Can you provide the pricing schedule that is requested in section 5? Referencing the equipment list on page 15 is a start, however there is not an exact one for one replacement for new equipment based on the current equipment list.

**We are not looking for a 1 to 1 list of replacement parts but an itemized list of costs and a brief description of how each part of the proposed solution will integrate/replace how the current system works. The component list was provided for additional information to assist respondents in proposing a solution.**

6) Can you provide more details on the spare parts package that is requested?

**Spare cables or other useful tools/parts for minimal maintenance or repair should the need arise.**

7) Would you like the standard one year parts and labor service plan included in the base price?

**Yes. If subsequent years pricing is available, respondents may include that pricing separately.**
