STEP TWO: UNOFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT

STEP THREE: ONE FACULTY RECOMMENDATION

- Find the form on our School of Education website
- Find a faculty member who is willing to recommend you

STEP FOUR: ONE WORK REFERENCE

- Find the form on our School of Education website
- Find a supervisor who is willing to recommend you

STEP FIVE: WRITING PROMPT

- After your interview session, you will be asked to write a reflection of the experience
- You will have 30 minutes to complete the task
- If you are applying to the Bilingual Education program, your writing sample will be written in Spanish

STEP SIX: READING, WRITING, MATH (BASIC SKILLS TEST)

- ACT or SAT is acceptable
- THEA, Accuplacer, or TSI are required
- You simply need to highlight this on your unofficial transcripts

STEP SEVEN: MATH AND SCIENCE COURSES

- You must have taken two Math courses (C or better)
- You must have taken two Science courses (C or better)

STEP EIGHT: OVERALL G.P.A.

- Your Overall G.P.A. must be 2.75 or higher
- You can find your GPA in your degree audit or unofficial transcript
