Fight Song

"Fight, North Texas" was written in 1939 by alumnus Francis Stroup (1909-2010) after 'Fessor Floyd Graham announced a marching song contest at a Saturday Night Stage Show. Stroup, a 1929 graduate who composed songs throughout his life, won the contest. He retired as a professor of physical education from Northern Illinois University, where he also wrote the fight song. As a North Texas student, he lettered in basketball and was an accomplished swimmer and diver. He was inducted into the UNT Athletics Hall of Fame in 1987. Stroup helped rewrite the lyrics to our fight song when our name changed to the University of North Texas. Today, we sing:

Fight, North Texas

Let's give a cheer for U of NT, cheer for the Green and White.

Victory's in store, but whate'er the score,
Our team will ever fight. Fight! Fight! Fight!
Shoulder to shoulder we march along, striving for victory,
Playing the game for the honor and fame and glory of UNT.
U - N - T Eagles. UNT Eagles. Fight! Fight! Fight!


