
# Division of Student Affairs Staff Awarded for Service to UNT



It's time to start submitting nominations for the **Division of Student** Affairs Awards. You can read about all the awards we are offering this year here.


You can submit your nominations through the <u>nomination form</u>, and the deadline for nominations is April 4 at 5 p.m.

#### **Official Tartan**

The university's official tartan design was created by alumna Casey Heidt ('15) when she was a College of Visual Arts and Design student, as a lasting way to show green pride during UNT's 125th anniversary celebrations and for years to come.



Heidt's innovative tartan pattern represents a double-layered map, one of campus with the Hurley Administration Building in the center, and the other of Denton with the downtown square — the location of the first classes — in the center. The thick white lines and thin black lines represent streets. In 2014, UNT's official tartan was accepted by the <a href="Scottish Register of Tartans">Scottish Register of Tartans</a> and is featured on shirts, scarves, ties and other merchandise with local retailers. Proceeds will go to support student scholarships.
