Upon certifying results, the Election Board found that there was an error on the Honors College ballot that allowed students to vote for President and Vice President candidates. Because all students are eligible to vote on their college ballot, as well as the Honors College ballot, there is the potential that 104 students' votes were counted twice (1 for their respective college; 1 for the Honors College). The Election Board felt it was in the best interest of the student body to count the Honors College votes, even if it meant 1 student voted twice for President and Vice President in order to ensure no student's vote was not counted. Because votes are anonymous, we cannot check for duplication. This decision would not have changed the outcome of this election.
