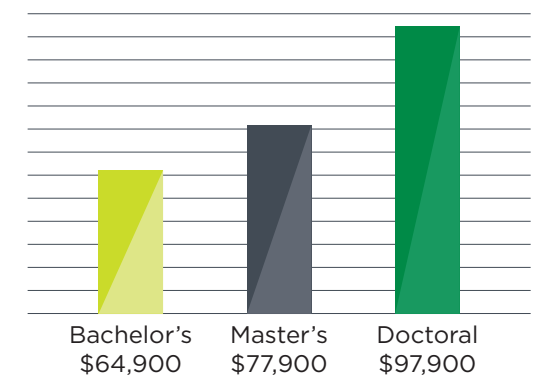

*UNT reviews graduate program applications holistically. We consider all parts of the application and supporting documentation to determine admission. Contact your department directly for specific requirements.

TWO-PART APPLICATION PROCESS

The UNT graduate application is a **concurrent two-part process**. All graduate applicants must complete the Toulouse Graduate School admission requirements, but most programs have additional requirements.

- 1 Apply to the Toulouse Graduate School** at applytexas.org and pay the application fee. Send official transcripts from all colleges attended to the graduate school office.
- 2 Apply to your department** and submit all supporting application materials.

Complete the graduate school application by the following dates. Check with your departmental advisor for specific deadlines and details.**

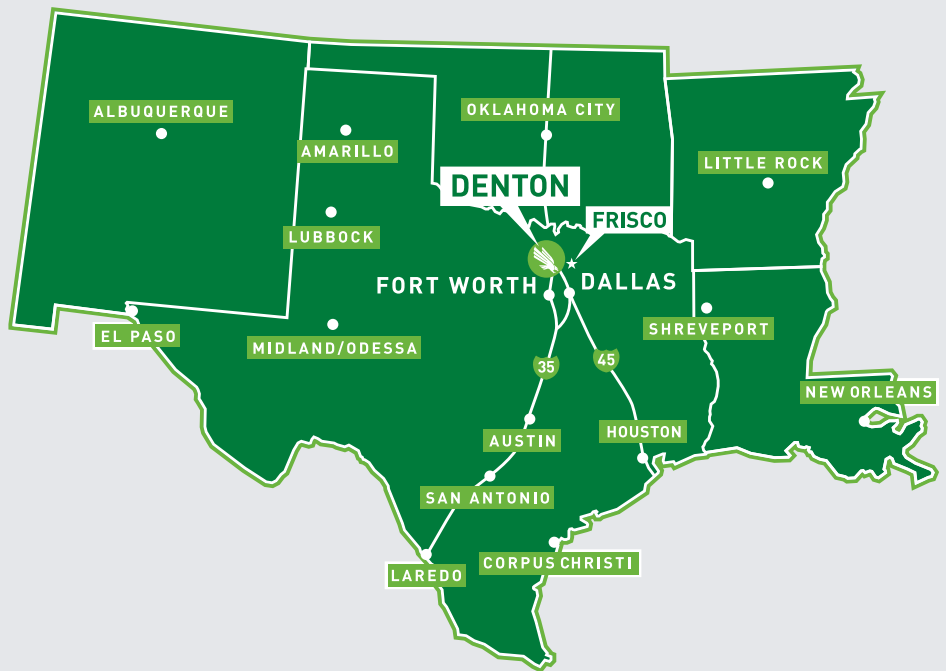
