

FVPSA-Funded Domestic Violence Services Network

In ACF's Family and Youth Services Bureau, the Family Violence Prevention and Services Program administers the Family Violence Prevention and Services Act (FVPSA), the primary federal funding stream dedicated to the support of emergency shelter and related assistance for victims of domestic violence and their children. Throughout the United States, the U.S. territories, and federally-recognized tribes, domestic and dating violence support services are provided free of charge, in a confidential and private manner, 365 days of the year.

Supportive services include:

- emergency shelter
- survivor advocacy
- counseling
- · case management
- · referrals

- legal advocacy
- · preventive health services
- culturally and linguistically appropriate services



A coordinated community response helps survivors and their children regain safety, stability, mental well-being, and self-sufficiency.

Nationwide nearly half of all residents in domestic violence shelters are children.



One thing that can build the resiliency of children exposed to violence is their bond with a caring adult. Supporting the mother-child bond through survivor advocacy is validated by research. FVPSA funding supports development of effective and innovative interventions for children and youth within the parent-child framework through Specialized Services to Abused Parents and their Children Demonstration Grants and by building and enhancing systems and programs' capacity to better respond to the needs of children and youth exposed to domestic violence through the Promising Futures Capacity Building Center.

Domestic Violence Services & **W W W** Supports for Sovereign Nations

Leadership and advocacy of sovereign nations has been a critical part of the FVPSA Program's beginning and continuation for the last 35 years. Annually, FVPSA funding reaches over 240 American Indian/Alaska Native (Al/AN) tribes and tribal organizations through formula (non-competitive) and discretionary (competitive) grants to assist tribes in efforts to increase public awareness and prevention of domestic violence and to provide immediate shelter and supportive services for survivors and their children.



StrongHearts Native Helpline, a collaborative project of the National Domestic Violence Hotline and the National Indigenous Women's Resource Center, is a confidential, anonymous helpline for Al/AN people affected by domestic and dating violence. StrongHearts exists to restore power to Native Americans impacted by domestic and

dating violence by weaving together a braid of safety, sovereignty, and support through the provision of culturally-appropriate services. Callers can connect at no cost, one-on-one, with knowledgeable and compassionate Al/AN advocates. After hour calls are answered by The Hotline.

Callers to StrongHearts report needing: peer support, legal advocacy, shelter, domestic violence support groups, and emergency financial aid.

FVPSA-funded tribes, tribal organizations, and other domestic violence service providers can receive culturally-specific training and technical assistance from these resource centers.
