ORDER

On April 6, 2011, the Board received from Robert G. Gerhart (purchaser) a timely-filed notice of appeal. 41 U.S.C. §§ 7101-7109 (as codified by Pub. L. No. 111-350, 124 Stat. 3677, 3825). The purchaser successfully competed in an auction held by the respondent, the General Services Administration, obtaining trailers. The purchaser did not pay for the items. The contracting officer issued a notice of termination for default, and assessed liquidated damages. The purchaser seeks to be relieved of the debt. The parties have resolved this dispute. By submission received on May 19, 2011, the parties ask that the matter be dismissed with prejudice.

The appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
