ORDER

Career Systems Development Corp. / Del-Jen, Inc., Joint Venture (CSD/DJI) appealed a decision by a Department of Labor contracting officer demanding that the contractor pay \$944,774 to the department. The decision asserted that the department had overpaid the contractor that amount as a result of misapplication of indirect cost rates by a CSD/DJI subcontractor on a particular contract.

CSD/DJI has now filed a motion to dismiss the case. In the motion, the contractor states that the decision which is the subject of the appeal has been withdrawn by the department.

The motion is granted. The case is **DISMISSED**.
