ORDER

ACADEMI Training Center, Inc. appealed the decision of a Department of State contracting officer which denied a claim for the refund of millions of dollars in deductions taken by the department under a contract for personal protective services.

The parties have settled the case, and the department has paid the contractor the amount it agreed to pay in settlement. The contractor has asked the Board to dismiss the case with prejudice.

Accordingly, the case is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
