Step 1: Client and assigned producer discuss scope and purpose of video

Step 2: Producer creates budget

- Step 11: Client reviews version 2 to approve changes or requests further modification to changes
- Step 12: Producer makes final modifications to video, if required
- Step 13: Client reviews final version of video to give approval
- Step 14: Video is complete and ready for distribution
