Recent Major Accomplishments

The Northern Research Station will continue to implement a program that addresses a comprehensive scientific foundation, including the following strategic program directions: Sustaining Forests, Forest Disturbance Processes, Urban Natural Resources Stewardship, Providing Clean Air and Water and Natural Resources Inventory and Monitoring. Within this program direction the scientists in New Hampshire have achieved the following:

- Determined how U.S. ecoregions are affected by high levels of nitrogen in acid deposition of air pollution, which has been problematic in New England forests and waters.
- Determined that paper birch growing on low calcium soils experienced greater dieback and growth reductions following the 1998 ice storm, suggesting an additional impact of acid rain-induced calcium depletion on forest health and productivity.
- Supported the Hubbard Brook
 Research Foundation's environmental
 literacy program for educators, which
 uses data sets and real life examples
 from the Forest Service's Hubbard
 Brook Experimental Forest.
- Helped 39 students attend a summer program focused on research projects.
