Recent Major Accomplishments

The Northern Research Station will continue to implement a program that addresses a comprehensive scientific foundation, including the following strategic program directions: Sustaining Forests, Forest Disturbance Processes, Urban Natural Resources Stewardship, Providing Clean Air and Water and Natural Resources Inventory and Monitoring. Within this program direction NRS scientists have already achieved the following:

- Continued annual inventory of Rhode Island's forest resources through the Forest Inventory and Analysis Program.
- Summarized the results of the fifth forest inventory of the forests of Southern New England, defined as Connecticut, Massachusetts, and Rhode Island, conducted by the Forest Inventory and Analysis program. The summary included forest attributes, ownership, land use change, carbon, timber products, forest health, and statistics and quality assurance of data collection.
