Data for 2010-2015 (all states) and 2016 for states/areas not individually surveyed on the EIA-914 (Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Federal Offshore Pacific, Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, Nevada, New York, South Dakota, Tennessee, and Virginia) are from EIA estimates published in the Petroleum Supply Annual and Petroleum Supply Monthly reports, based on crude oil production data from state government agencies and the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement (and predecessor agencies), and first purchase data reported on Form EIA-182, *Domestic Crude Oil First Purchase Report*.
