I want to thank you for the invitation to become involved in the LCR MSCP. I hope our participation will benefit all of those concerned.

Our organization was founded in Brawley in 1980. The main purpose at that time was to mitigate the problems caused by the concrete lining of the Coachella branch of the All American Canal. The steep angle and slippery sides of the Canal prevented the indigenous wildlife, especially deer, from exiting after entering to drink. Our solution to the problem included, but was not limited to, the construction of artificial drinkers in the desert area. Since then our conservation efforts have broadened to include creation of upland game bird habitat for wild birds and also raising additional upland game birds for release in that habitat. We are also very involved in the reclamation efforts of the New and Alamo Rivers. As the lead entity we have been instrumental in the construction of two water reclamation projects in the New River channel.


