



River Sections Surveyed in 2011





Largemouth Bass Size Class Distribution




Imperial Division Backwaters


Flathead Catfish Size Class Distribution





Palo Verde Division (A-7 and A-10 Backwaters) Largemouth Bass Size Class Distribution




Razorback sucker stocking and recapture history, A7 and A10 backwaters




Flathead Catfish Size Class Distribution



Flathead Catfish Size-Class Distribution (2011)




Lake Havasu Size-Class Distribution, Largemouth Bass





Physical condition (relative weight) of largemouth bass, 150 mm or greater, 1986-2011 fall surveys at Lake Havasu

Average relative weight (W_r)




Lake Havasu Size-Class Distribution, Striped bass, electrofishing
