Earn a health specialization certificate through free, online, self-paced classes from the Network of the National Library of Medicine.

What is CHIS?

CHIS stand for <u>Consumer Health Information Specialization</u>, a program by the Medical Library Association (MLA). CHIS is recognition for the accomplishment of acquiring new health information skills through training about providing health information services to consumers.

NNLM provides free, online training in support of CHIS, and can sponsor your CHIS application or renewal fee, making this specialization completely free to you.

Once you've completed 12 credits of training, <u>fill out this form</u> to get your CHIS application fee sponsored by NNLM. Any library staff member or library student in the U.S. interested in providing health information to the public is eligible for sponsorship. As of December 2020, NNLM has 75 sponsorships available.

Why Get a CHIS?

Library workers know the value of accurate information. Enhance and expand your skills with evidence-based knowledge and resources that will make you a confident, expert provider of health information to your community. CHIS shows employers, colleagues, and the public that you are committed to offering quality consumer health information services, and to staying current with consumer health information resources, technologies, and services.

You need 12 hours/credits to get a CHIS certificate.

To get CHIS, follow this suggested plan.

- First, create an nnlm.gov account and register for NNLM classes.
 - o Directions for creating NNLM account (PDF download)
- Second, take a class for Level 1 or Level 2
 - o You must already be certified in CHIS Level 1 in order to apply for Level 2.
- Once you have finished a class, claim CE for it on Medlib-ed.org.
 - o Directions for claiming CE from Medlib-ed (PDF download)
- Continue until you have gathered 12 credits
 - o <u>Track your progress on this grid (docx download)</u>
- When you have taken all 12 credits, request NNLM sponsorship of the CHIS application fee

- MLA Staff member will contact you regarding your CHIS Specialization within 6 weeks.
