Pursuant to Section 2(b) of the Buy American Act (BAA), U.S.C. §10a(b), as amended by Public Law 110-28, this letter constitutes the BAA Report for the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2010. I am submitting this report on behalf of the OMB Director.

OMB's acquisition data is reported to the Federal Procurement Data System (FPDS), the government-wide federal procurement activity database, available at https://www.fpds.gov. OMB staff analyzed the information and extracted the following summary report from the standard FPDS BAA Place of Manufacture Report for FY 2010:

- 1. Obligations for goods manufactured outside of the United States, in Canada, were \$4,476.00;
- 2. Waivers of the BAA were neither necessary nor granted for acquisitions; and
- 3. Obligations for goods manufactured in the United States were \$607,895.92.
