I. Background

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) is committed to using cutting-edge technologies and scientific talent to make America safer. The DHS Science and Technology (S&T) Directorate is tasked with researching and organizing the scientific, engineering, and technological resources of the United States and leveraging these existing resources into technological tools to help protect the homeland.

This Statement of Work (SOW) describes the scope of contractor support needed by DHS S&T Explosives Division (EXD) to effectively carry out its mission. EXD would like to open a competition using the Eagle Contract for the provision of systems engineering and strategic program support.

II. Scope of Work

EXD executes the transition of large-scale or pilot systems to the field through a rapid, efficient, and disciplined project management/systems engineering process. EXD continuously confirms the technology needed by the end-user in assessing threats, vulnerabilities, and countermeasures to these threats. EXD's mission is to achieve a scaleable, seamless progression of product development so that state, local, and federal homeland security customers are well-equipped with the tools and technologies that protect our nation and preserve our freedom. To achieve its mission, EXD applies rigorous product realization processes to products, ultimately serving its customers in the following ways:

- > Testing and Integration. Rapidly test and integrate developmental projects.
- Pilot Development. Effectively launch and transition pilot systems to end-user environments.
- Production Readiness. Craft production and lifecycle support methods for new and improved equipment deployment to the field.
- Improve Mission Success. Continuously validate its desired user capabilities throughout the development cycle by assessing threats, vulnerabilities, and countermeasures to ensure users achieve outcomes that improve their mission success.

Support Requirements

Specifically, contractor support is needed to assist with the implementation of the following objectives:

- Applying systems engineering principles to existing EXD Programs to assist in the development of comprehensive system design solutions that balance cost, schedule, performance, risk, program analysis and evaluation as well as acquisition management support while ensuring the accurate tracking of technical information needed for informed decision making.

Critical Documentation and Processes for Transitioning Programs and Products. Technology Road mapping. Concept of Operations Development. Development of Reports and Other Documents.

IV. Deliverables

The Contractor shall provide all deliverables directly to the DHS S&T Contracting Officer's Technical Representative (COTR) with a copy of the transmittal letter to the Contracting Officer. All deliverables become the property of DHS and may not be further disseminated without prior written approval from DHS.

Additionally, a Monthly Program Status Report in a commercial format (to be approved by the COTR) is required. The Contractor shall deliver this report by the 15th calendar day of each contract month. This report will include:

- A description of the actual work performed by contractor.
- Metrics pertaining to financial, schedule, scope information, risk information, and performance assessment information of all work performed hereunder.
- Actual costs for the reporting month and cumulative costs for the contract to date.
- Budgeted costs for the reporting month and contract to date based on the work performed, and
- Estimated costs by month for the remainder of the performance period of the contract.

V. Other Contract Details

All travel and other direct costs associated with the execution of the tasks indicated in this SOW will be reimbursed in accordance with the limits set forth in the Federal Travel Regulations, provided the performer provides appropriate supporting documentation.
