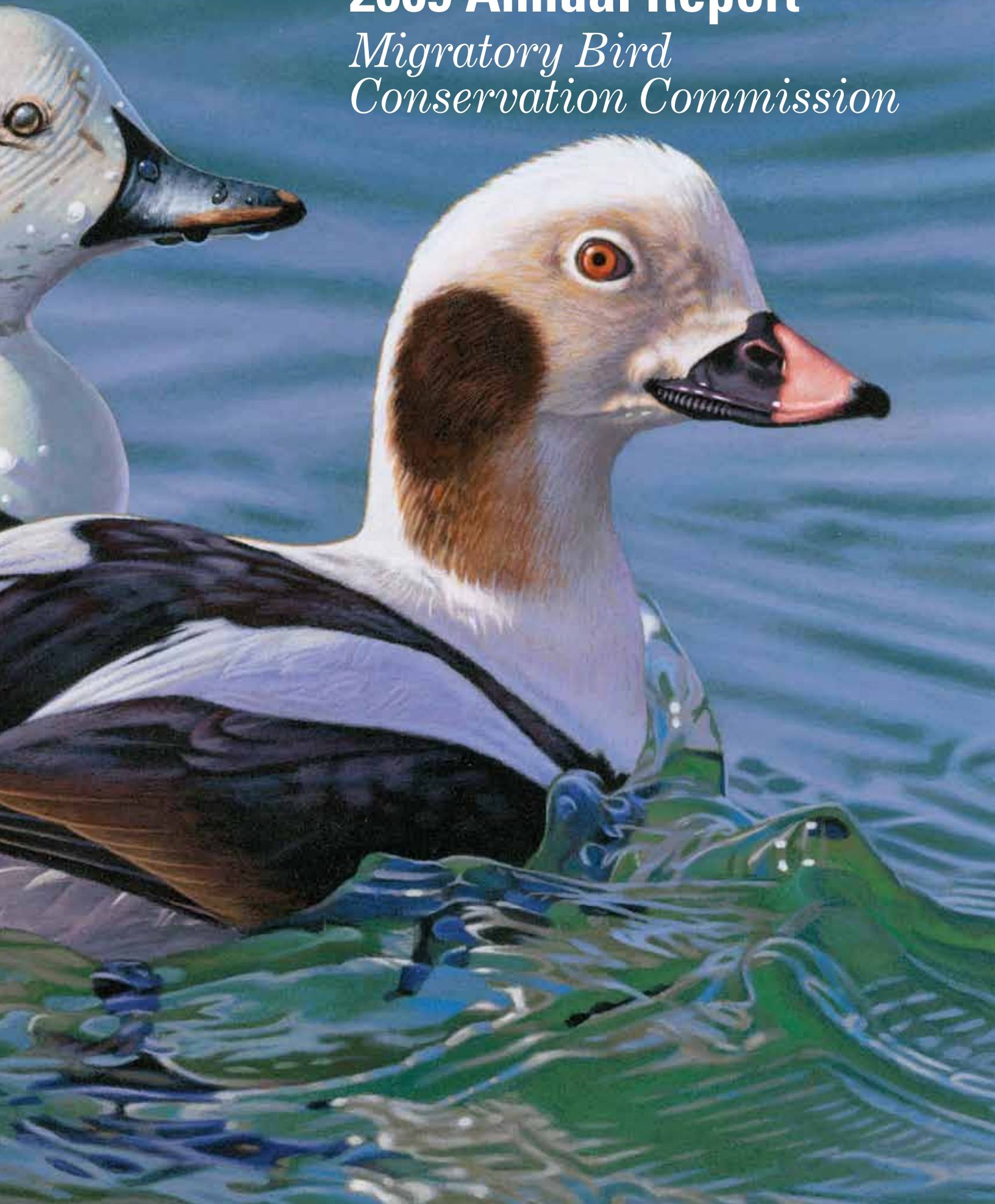

The Service's Legacy of Conserving Migratory Waterfowl Habitat

For over 75 years, the Federal Duck Stamp Program and Migratory Bird Conservation Program have helped secure key habitats to sustain migratory bird populations. These habitats protect wetlands, help dissipate storm runoff, purify water supplies, and store flood water. As we look forward to the future conservation of these critical resources, we can find inspiration in these programs' extraordinary history of success.

At the turn of the 20th century, overeager hunters and the commercial demand for meat and feathers had decimated waterfowl populations. At the same time, periodic droughts caused wetlands and other valuable waterfowl habitat to disappear. In the late 1920s, conservationists, hunters, and government officials worked together to create the Migratory Bird Conservation Act, which Congress passed in 1929. This landmark legislation authorized the Federal government to acquire and permanently protect wetlands for waterfowl. It also created the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission—composed of Federal and State officials—to consider and approve proposals for land acquisition.

Although the Act gave the government authority to create migratory bird refuges, it did not provide a permanent source of acquisition funding. This problem was addressed in the 1930s when President Franklin D. Roosevelt appointed Jay N. "Ding" Darling, a nationally known wildlife conservationist and political cartoonist, to serve as the Chief of the Bureau of Biological Survey. Darling was instrumental in the creation of a stamp, to be purchased by all waterfowl hunters, that would generate funds to pay for the acquisition of waterfowl habitat. In 1934, Congress passed the Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act, which required all hunters older than 16 to purchase and possess a Federal Duck Stamp while hunting waterfowl. Revenues from Duck Stamp sales are

now deposited in the Migratory Bird Conservation Fund. The fund also includes import duties collected on arms and ammunition, receipts from permits for rights-of-way across refuge lands, and any appropriations from the Wetlands Loan Act, which Congress authorized in 1961 as an advance of funds against future revenues from sale of Duck Stamps.

Since 1934, the Service has spent more than \$1 billion from the Migratory Bird Conservation Fund to permanently protect more than five million acres of important waterfowl habitat—including nearly three million acres of waterfowl production areas in the U.S. Prairie Pothole Region. In 2009 alone, the Service used more than \$50 million in funds from the MBCF to purchase or lease over 12,000 acres of waterfowl habitat at migratory bird refuges and almost 30,000 acres in the Prairie Pothole Region.

Today, as in the past, the Federal Duck Stamp Program and Migratory Bird Conservation Program depend on the support of people who understand and connect with our natural world—people who understand the importance of our wildlife resources and take action. What can you do? Buy a Federal Duck Stamp. Tell people how important Federal Duck Stamps are to ensuring healthy populations of all migratory birds and other wildlife. The Migratory Bird Conservation Commission

Section 2 of the Migratory Bird Conservation Act of February 18, 1929, established the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission. The Section reads as follows:

SECTION 2, AS AMENDED. A Commission to be known as the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission, consisting of the Secretary of the Interior, as Chairman; the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency; the Secretary of Agriculture; two Members of the Senate, to be selected by the President of the Senate; and two Members of the House of Representatives, to be selected by the Speaker, is created and authorized to consider and pass upon any area of land, water, or land and water that may be recommended by the Secretary of the Interior for purchase or rental under this Act, and to fix the price or prices at which such area may be purchased or rented; and no purchase or rental shall be made of any such area until it has been duly approved for purchase or rental by said Commission.

Any Member of the House of Representatives, who is a member of Congress, if reelected to the succeeding Congress, may serve on the Commission notwithstanding the expiration of a Congress. Any vacancy on the Commission shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment. The ranking officer of the branch or department of a State to which is committed the administration of its game laws, or his authorized representative, shall be a member ex officio of said Commission for the purpose of considering and voting on all questions relating to the acquisition, under said sections, of areas in his State. For purposes of said sections, the purchase or rental of any area of land, water, or land and water includes the purchase or rental of any interest in any such area of land, water, or land and water.

Additional Act

In 1989, the Commission acquired the additional responsibility of approving project funding under the North American Wetlands Conservation Act. This Act provides Federal funding to encourage partnerships to protect, enhance, restore, and manage wetlands and other habitats for migratory birds and other fish and wildlife. The North American Wetlands Conservation Council, which was created by the legislation, submits project recommendations to the Commission for funding approval.

The Migratory Bird Conservation Fund

The Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act of March 18, 1934 (Duck Stamp Act), as amended, created the Migratory Bird Conservation Fund (MBCF) to provide the Department of the Interior with monies to acquire migratory bird habitat.

There are three major sources of funds deposited into the MBCF account. The most well-known source is the revenue received from the sale of Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamps, commonly known as Duck Stamps, as provided for under the Duck Stamp Act. The other two major sources include appropriations authorized by the Wetlands Loan Act of October 4, 1961, as amended, and import duties collected on arms and ammunition, as provided for under the Emergency Wetlands Resources Act of 1986.

The MBCF finances two Service land acquisition programs that the Division of Realty administers. The first program acquires waterfowl habitat in major migratory bird conservation areas under the authority of the Migratory Bird Conservation Act of 1929. The second program acquires small natural wetlands, grasslands, and interests, known as Waterfowl Production Areas, under the authority of the Duck Stamp Act. Waterfowl Production Areas are located primarily in the Prairie Pothole Region of the upper Midwest of the United States.

A total of \$50,973,098 was available for obligation from the MBCF during fiscal year 2009. Disbursements for all MBCF land acquisition functions during the fiscal year totaled \$50,750,537. This includes \$23,973,719 for the acquisition of land and interests in land totaling 21,182 acres at national wildlife refuges, and \$24,853,071 for land and interests in land totaling 29,942 acres at Waterfowl Production Areas.

On June 10, 2009, the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved the 18,500-acre Bond Swamp National Wildlife Refuge boundary and granted price approval for the fee title acquisition of 256 acres.

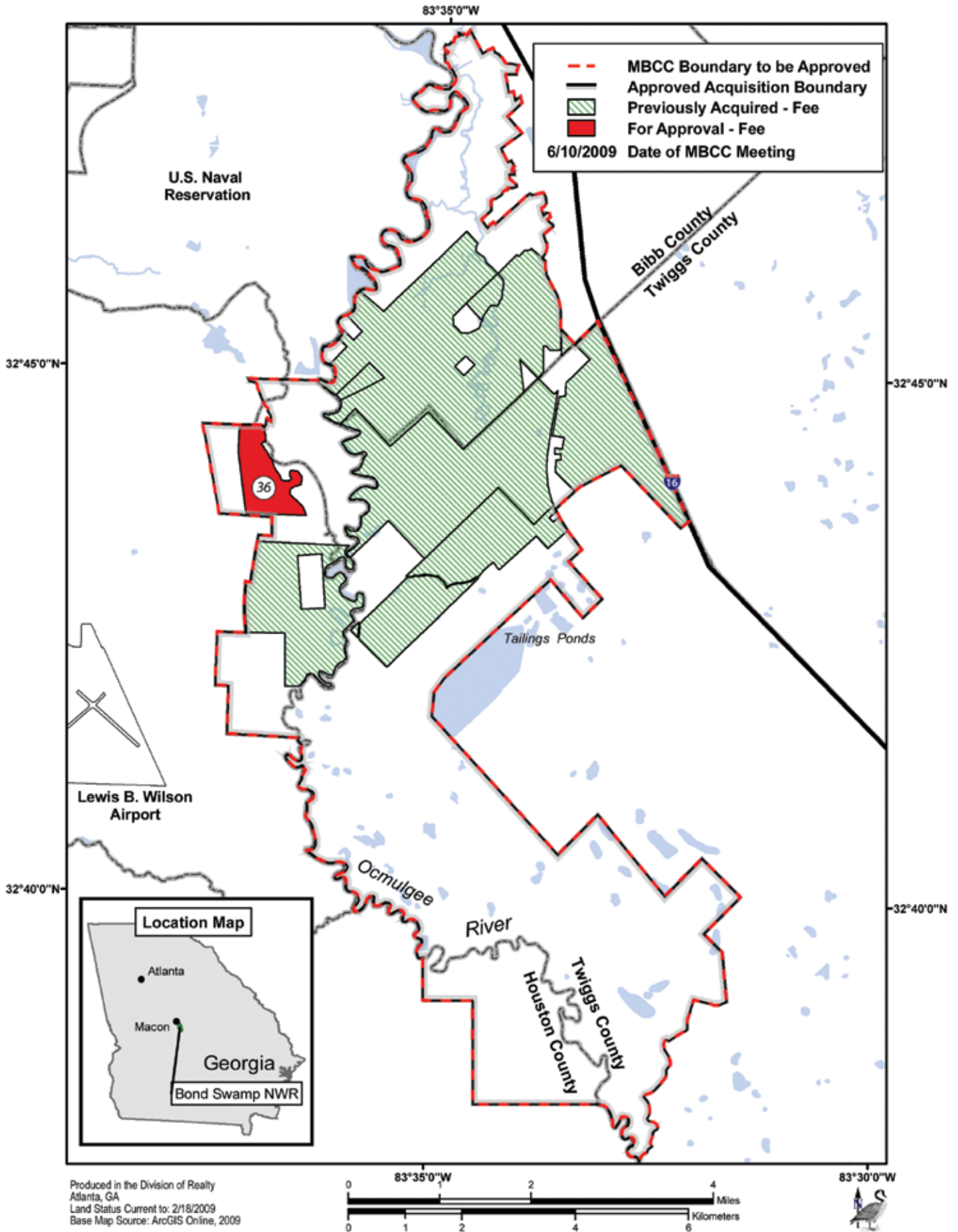
Bond Swamp NWR is located to the west of the Ocmulgee River in central Georgia. The Refuge and the surrounding lands form one of the largest remaining blocks of forested wetlands in Georgia. The area includes the shallow habitats of the Brickyards, the Ocmulgee/Altamaha River corridor, and the mature bottomland hardwoods along the river. The corridor is one of the most heavily used waterfowl

flyways through Georgia and an important wintering area for the mallard, American black duck, blue-winged teal, gadwall, American wigeon, ring-necked duck, lesser scaup, canvasback, and redhead.

The 256-acre tract approved for acquisition consists of wetlands and associated uplands along the Tobesofkee Creek and the Ocmulgee River floodplain. The Service will manage the tract for American black duck, mallard, and other wintering waterfowl. When compatible with refuge objectives, the Service will permit recreational uses, including hunting, fishing, bird watching, nature photography, wildlife observation, and other wildlife-oriented recreation.

New Area Boundary Approval

Tulare Basin Wildlife Management Area

Location: *Kern and Tulare Counties,
California*

On September 9, 2009, the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved the 22,000-acre Tulare Basin Wildlife Management Area boundary and granted price approval for the perpetual conservation easement acquisition of 1,042 acres.

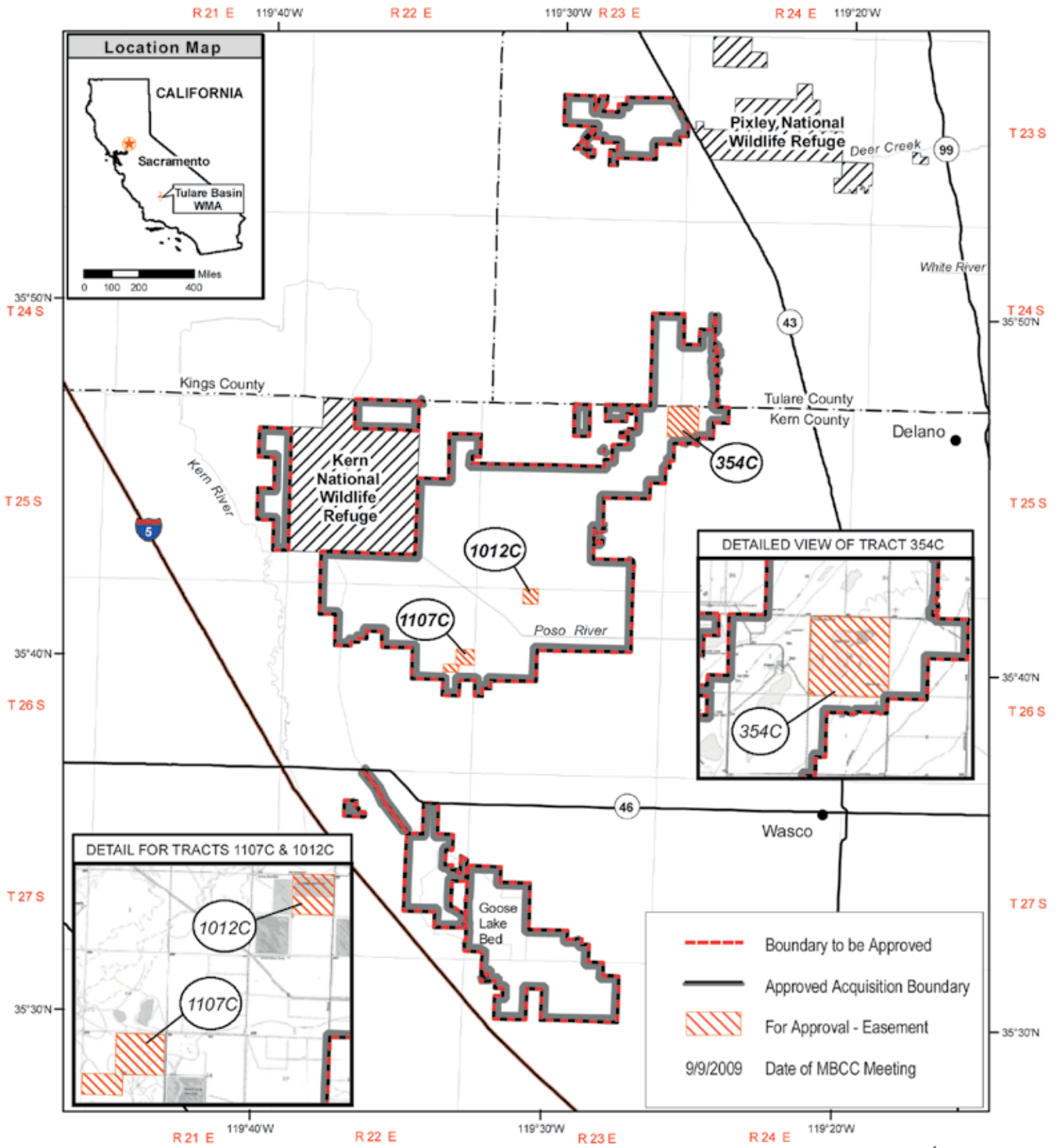
Tulare Basin WMA is located 35 miles northwest of Bakersfield in the southern San Joaquin Valley of California. It supports the last remnant of wetland and wildlife habitat in a dramatically altered Tulare Lake watershed. The Tulare Basin wetlands host annual waterfowl concentrations in excess of 100,000 birds, including significant numbers of northern pintail, northern shoveler, green-winged teal,

and cinnamon teal. The wetlands also support regionally significant numbers of shorebirds, wading birds, raptors, and migratory songbirds. Historically, the associated upland habitats in the Basin supported threatened and endangered species such as the San Joaquin kit fox, Tipton kangaroo rat, and blunt-nosed leopard lizard.

The 1,042-acre tract approved for acquisition consists of wetlands and associated uplands along the Tulare Basin. Protecting the tract will halt the gradual erosion of habitat available to support Central Valley and Pacific Flyway waterfowl populations. The current uses, recreational hunting and wildlife habitat, will likely continue. The fee owners will continue water applications and annual inundation of the wetland areas.

Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge

Location: *Dorchester County, Maryland*

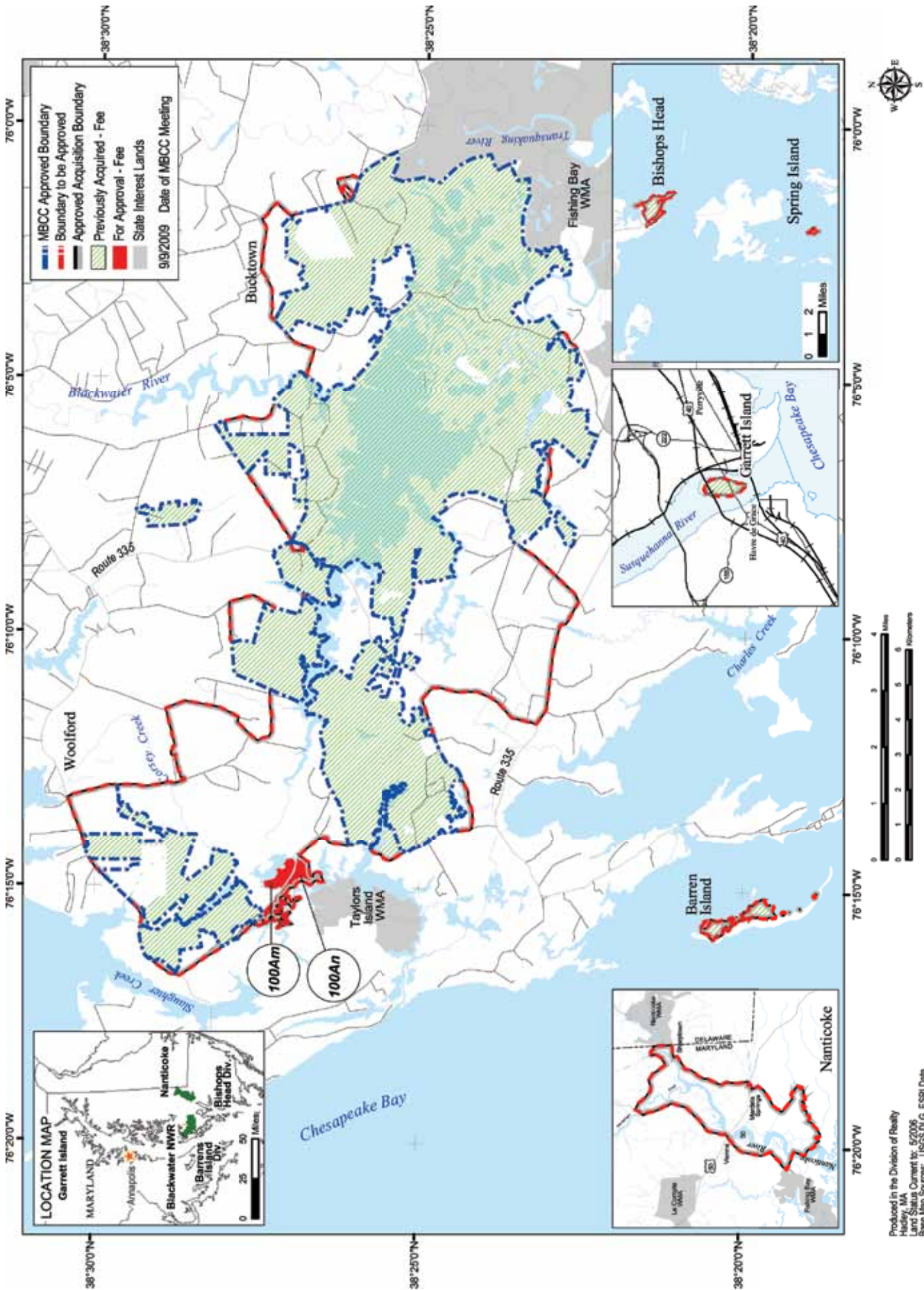
On September 9, 2009, the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission granted boundary approval for 15,545 acres at the Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge, and price approval for the fee title acquisition of 823 acres.

Blackwater NWR is located approximately 14 miles south of Cambridge, Maryland, in South Central Dorchester County. The Refuge and its adjacent marshes and waters are one of the Chesapeake Bay's most important and productive estuarine assets. Diverse aquatic and emergent plant communities provide optimum habitat for large concentrations of waterfowl.

The 832-acre parcel approved for acquisition abuts the western part of the Refuge and is located approximately 1 mile southeast of Smithville, on Parsons Creek Neck along Smithville Road. The parcel consists of brackish marsh interspersed with tidal creeks, ponds, wetland forest, and cutover timberland in various stages of regrowth. The Service will manage the tract to preserve foraging, nesting, and resting habitat for endangered Delmarva fox squirrels, bald eagles, osprey, American black ducks and wood ducks, marsh and water birds, shorebirds, and neotropical migrant songbirds.

Bombay Hook National Wildlife Refuge

Location: *Kent County, Delaware*

On September 9, 2009, the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission granted boundary approval for 542 acres at the Bombay Hook National Wildlife Refuge, and price approval for the fee title acquisition of 273 acres from The Nature Conservancy.

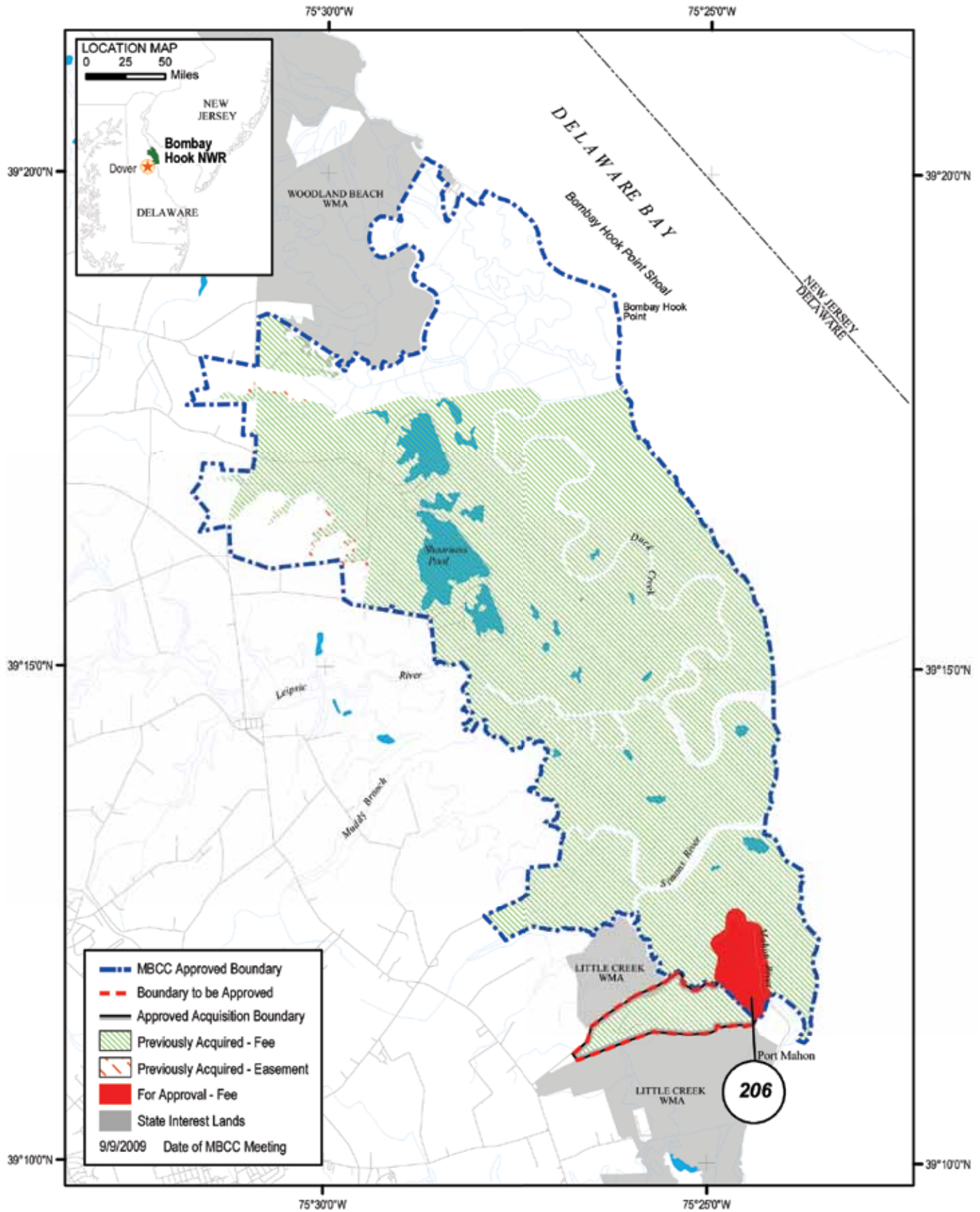
Bombay Hook NWR is located in Kent County, Delaware. The Refuge's extensive marshes are an important breeding ground for the American black duck, mallard, and wood duck. The marshes also support significant numbers of waterfowl during the fall and winter months, including

80 percent of the Atlantic flyway's snow goose population and the largest concentration of northern shoveler, American widgeon, and gadwall in the State.

The 273-acre tract approved for acquisition consists entirely of coastal salt marsh and is one of the few remaining inholdings within the current Refuge boundary. The Service will manage the tract to promote and enhance habitat for waterfowl, wading birds, and other high-priority migratory birds. The Service will offer compatible fishing, wildlife observation and photography, environmental education, and interpretation.

Great Dismal Swamp National Wildlife Refuge

Location: *Cities of Suffolk and Chesapeake, Virginia, and Camden, Gates, and Pasquotank Counties, North Carolina*

On March 11, 2009, the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission granted boundary approval for 36 acres at the Great Dismal Swamp National Wildlife Refuge, and price approval for the fee title acquisition of 51 acres.

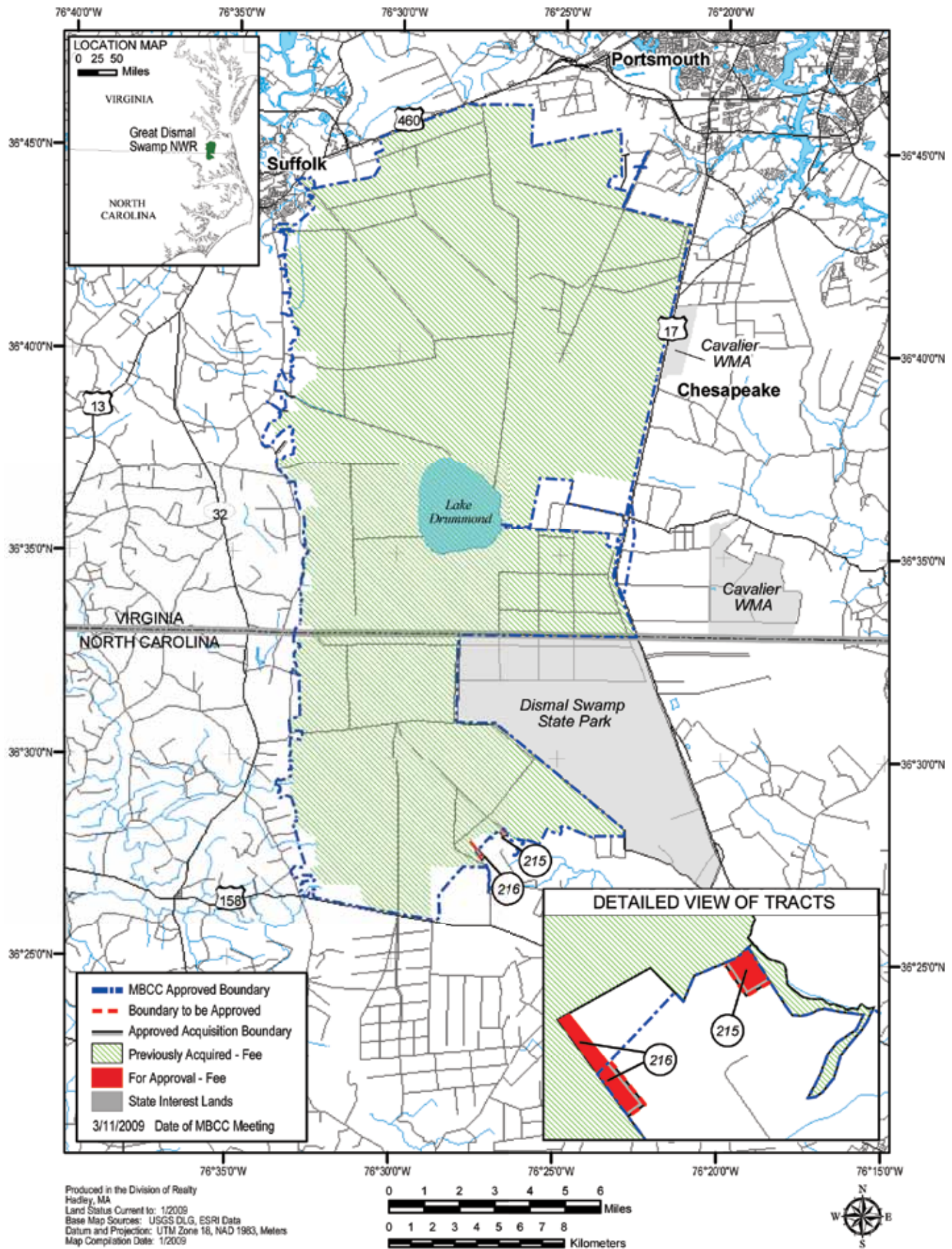
Great Dismal Swamp NWR is located in the Mid-Atlantic coastal plain along the Virginia and North Carolina State line, southwest of Norfolk, Virginia. The Refuge consists of large areas of forested wetlands, swamp, and marsh that provide important nesting,

feeding, and resting habitat for migratory waterfowl, including the American black duck, wood duck, mallard, and Canada goose, as well as neotropical land birds.

The 51 acres approved for acquisition include native forested wetlands and remnant marsh and a mixed hardwood/conifer swamp. Much of the timber was harvested in the mid 1990s to early 2000s and is now in various stages of mixed forest regrowth. The Service will restore the native forested wetlands and manage the area for waterfowl, migratory birds, and other wildlife.

On June 10, 2009, the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission granted boundary approval for 4,283 acres at the Red River National Wildlife Refuge, and price approval for the fee title acquisition of 4,399 acres.

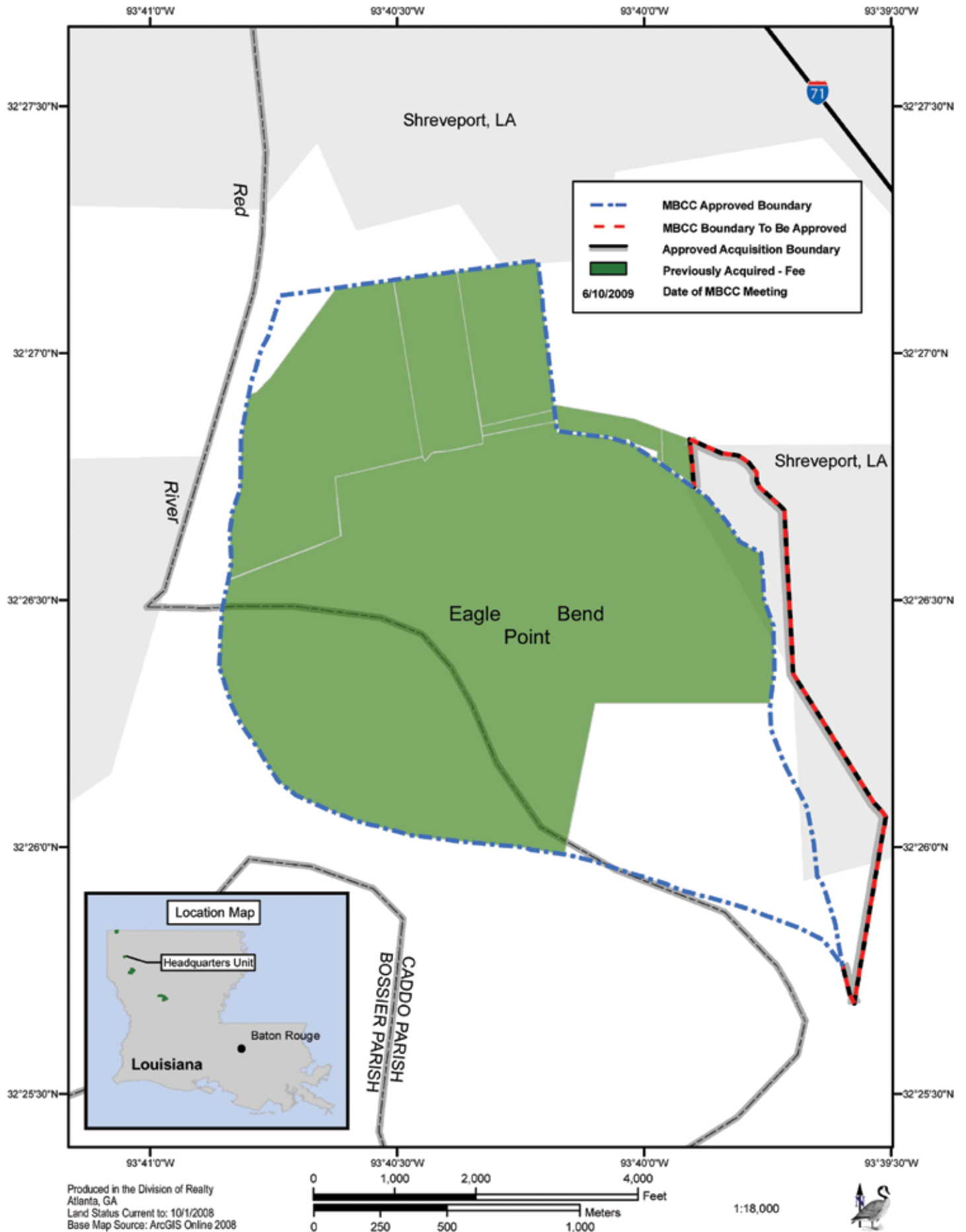
Red River NWR is located in the Red River Valley between Alexandria, Louisiana, and the Arkansas-Louisiana State line. The Red River Valley is part of a major continental migration corridor for migratory birds traveling

through the flyway from as far north as the Arctic Circle and as far south as South America. The Refuge provides wintering habitat for wood ducks, mallards, northern pintails, gadwall, and American wigeon.

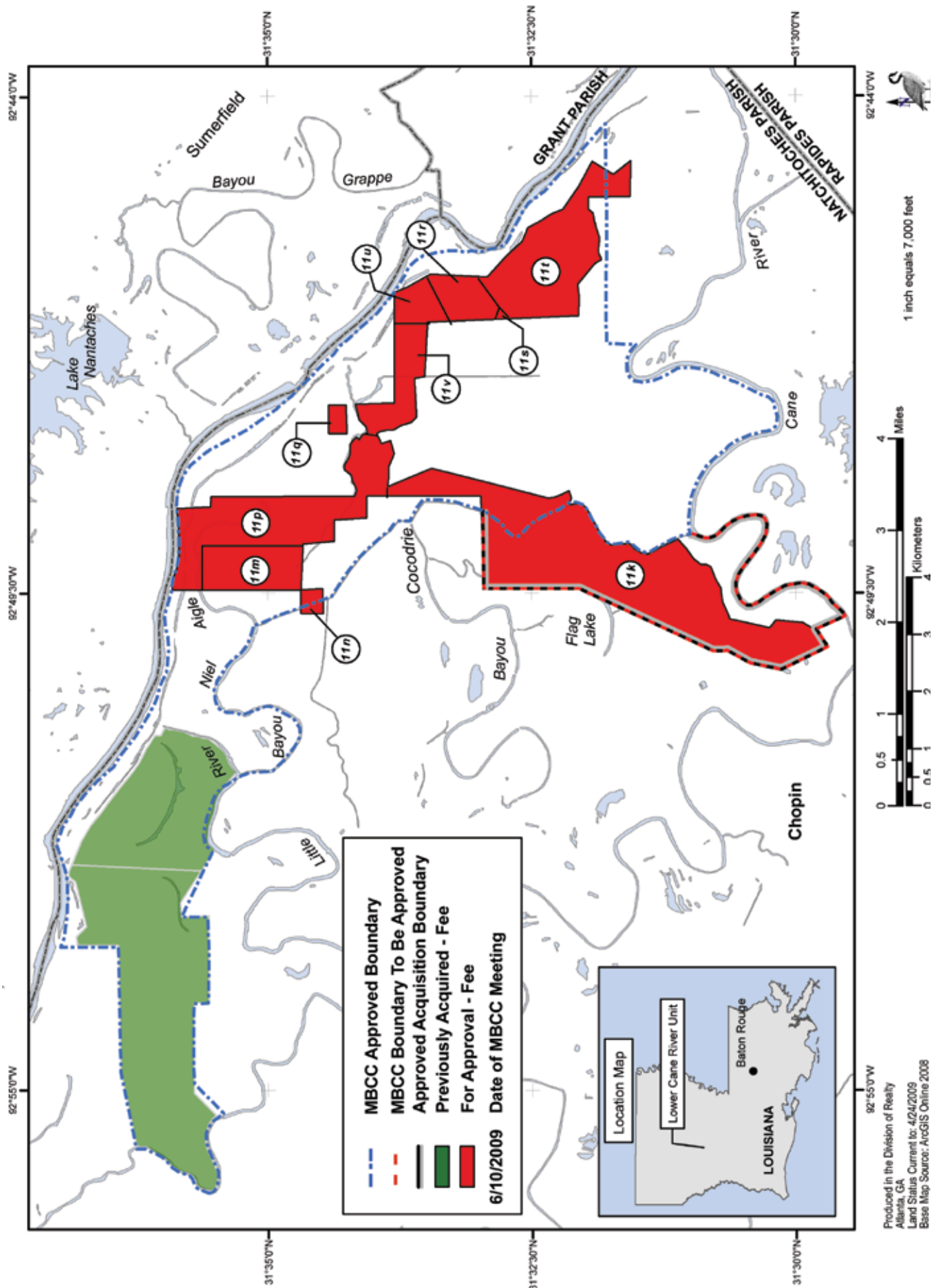
The 4,399 acres approved for acquisition consist of recently reforested bottomland hardwood forest in the Lower Cane River Unit of the Refuge. The parcel provides nesting, breeding, and wintering habitat for migratory birds and other wildlife. The Service plans to restore the former agricultural lands to habitat for waterfowl and other wildlife.



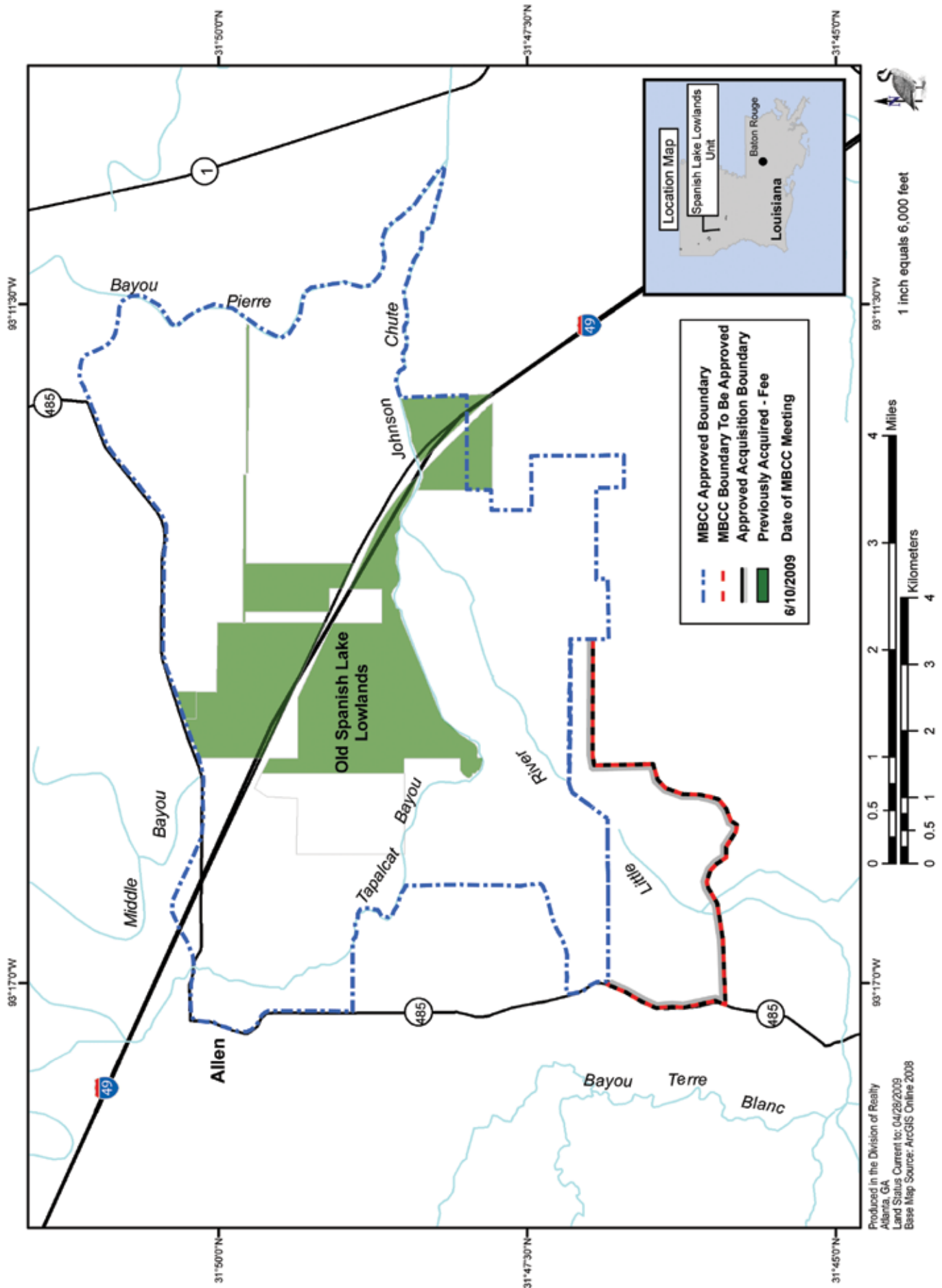
Boundary Addition Approval *Red River National Wildlife Refuge / Headquarters Unit*

San Bernard National Wildlife Refuge

Location: *Brazoria and Matagorda
Counties, Texas*

On March 11, 2009, the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission granted boundary and price approval for the fee title acquisition of 1,454 acres at the Austin's Woods Unit of the San Bernard National Wildlife Refuge.

The Austin's Woods Unit is located 50 miles south of Houston, Texas. It consists of a productive and valuable wetland complex providing habitat for migrating, wintering, and resident waterfowl, wading birds, neotropical

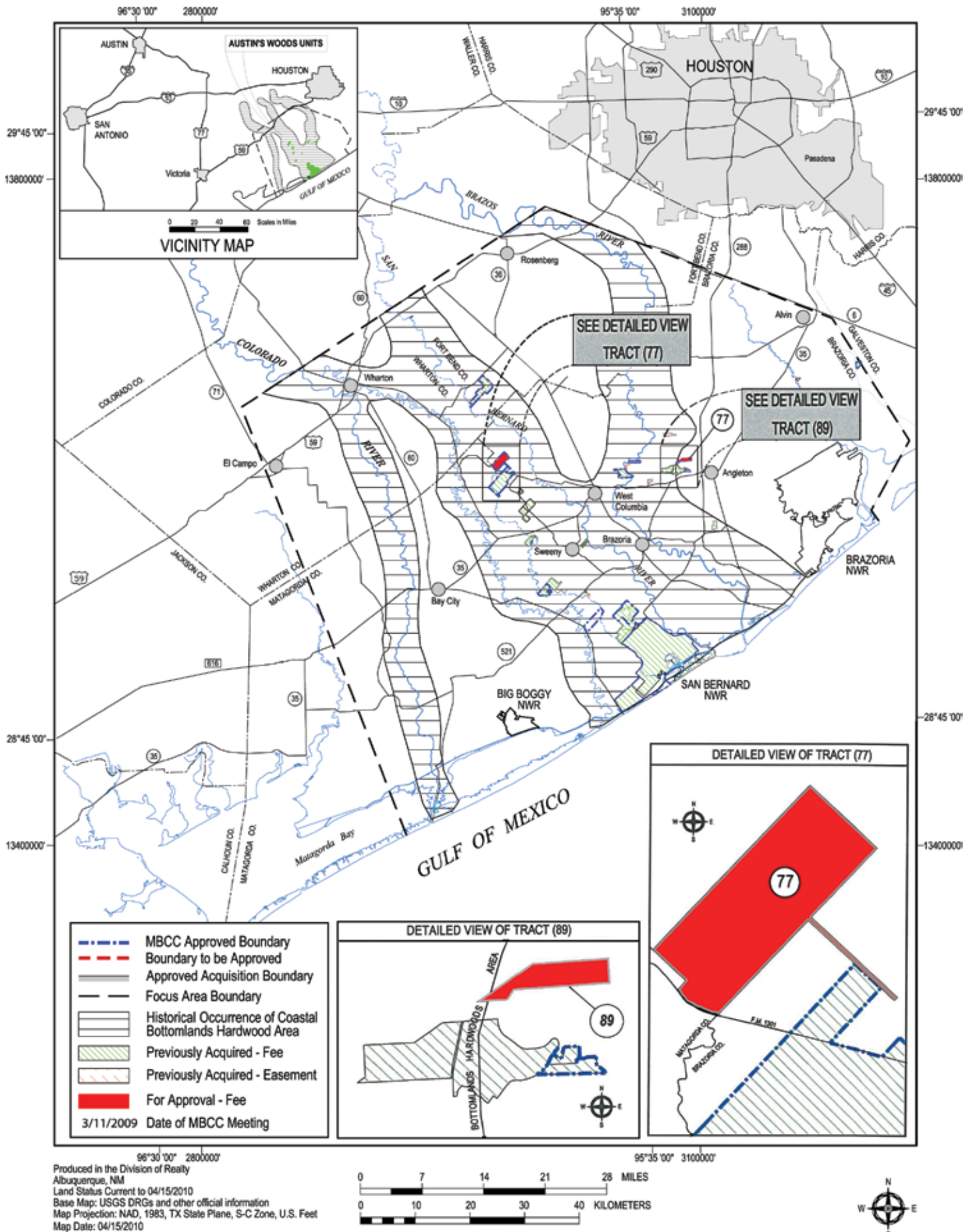
migratory birds, and other wetland-dependent wildlife species. Thousands of waterfowl winter in the area, including mottled ducks, mallards, pintails, gadwalls, American wigeons, northern shovelers, blue- and green-winged teal, black-bellied whistling ducks, and ruddy ducks.

The 1,454 acres approved for acquisition consist of bottomland hardwood wetland forest and grasslands. The Service will manage the lands as habitat for waterfowl, wading birds, neotropical migrants, and other wildlife.

Silvio O. Conte National Fish and Wildlife Refuge

Location: *Coos County,
New Hampshire*

On March 11, 2009, the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission granted boundary approval for 14 acres at the Pondicherry Division of the Silvio O. Conte National Fish and Wildlife Refuge. On September 9, 2009, the Commission granted boundary approval for an additional 188 acres at the Pondicherry Division. The Commission granted price approval for the fee title acquisitions of 61 acres and 80 acres in March and September, respectively.

The Pondicherry Division is located 80 miles north of Concord, New Hampshire. The Service identified the Division as one of 65 Special Focus Areas important to migratory birds in the Connecticut River watershed. It

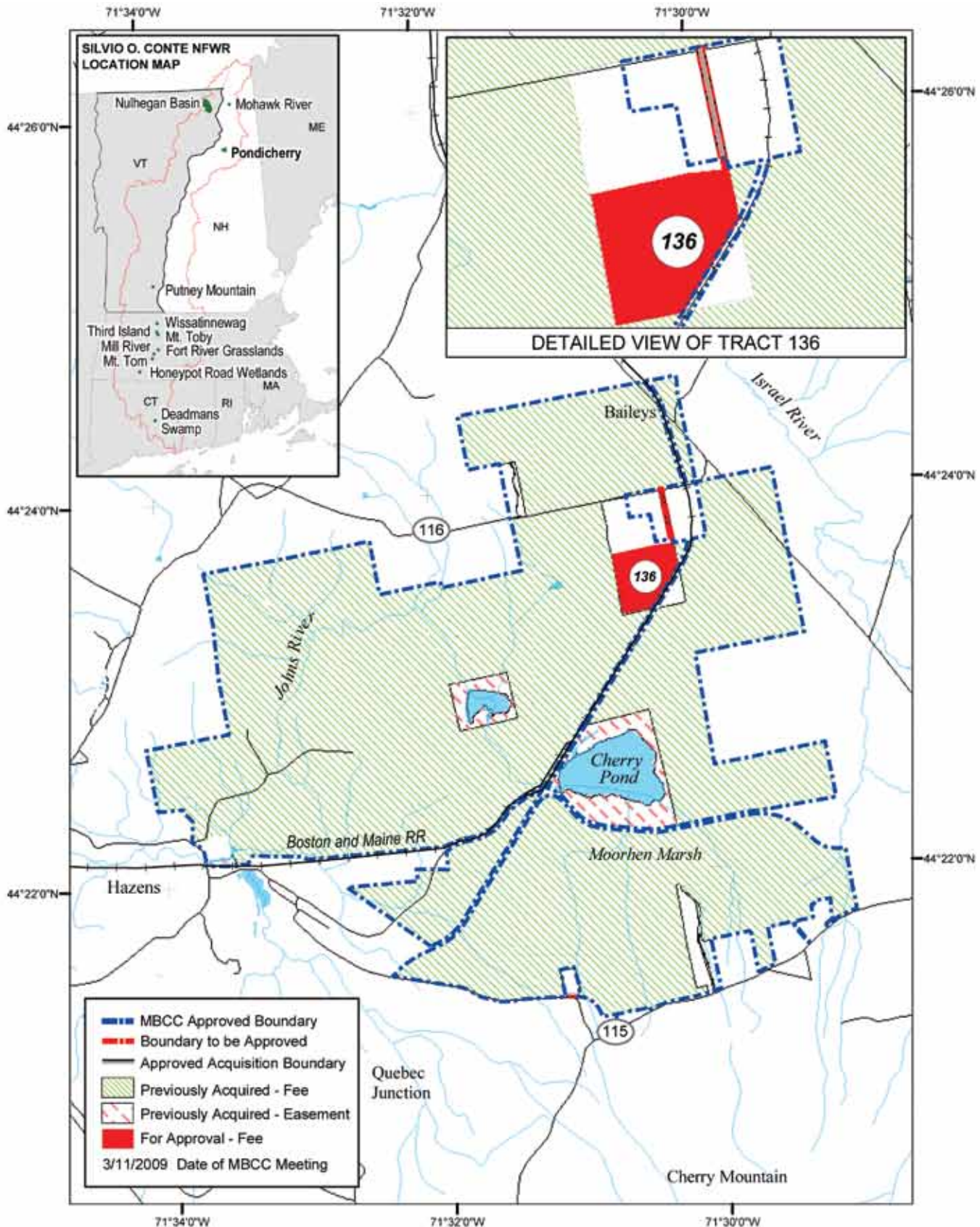
forms a basin that includes four ponds, the John's River, forested and emergent wetlands, bogs, spruce-fir forests, and northern mixed hardwood forest. This northern forest wetland complex provides habitat for the American black duck, wood duck, mallard, hooded merganser, blue-winged teal, and ring-necked duck.

The 141 acres approved for acquisition include additions in separate areas along the northeast and southeast perimeter of the Refuge. The tracts consist of several important wetlands and a stand of white cedar. The Service will manage the tracts for American black ducks and other waterfowl species. The Service will also offer compatible hunting, fishing, wildlife observation, photography, environmental education, and interpretation.

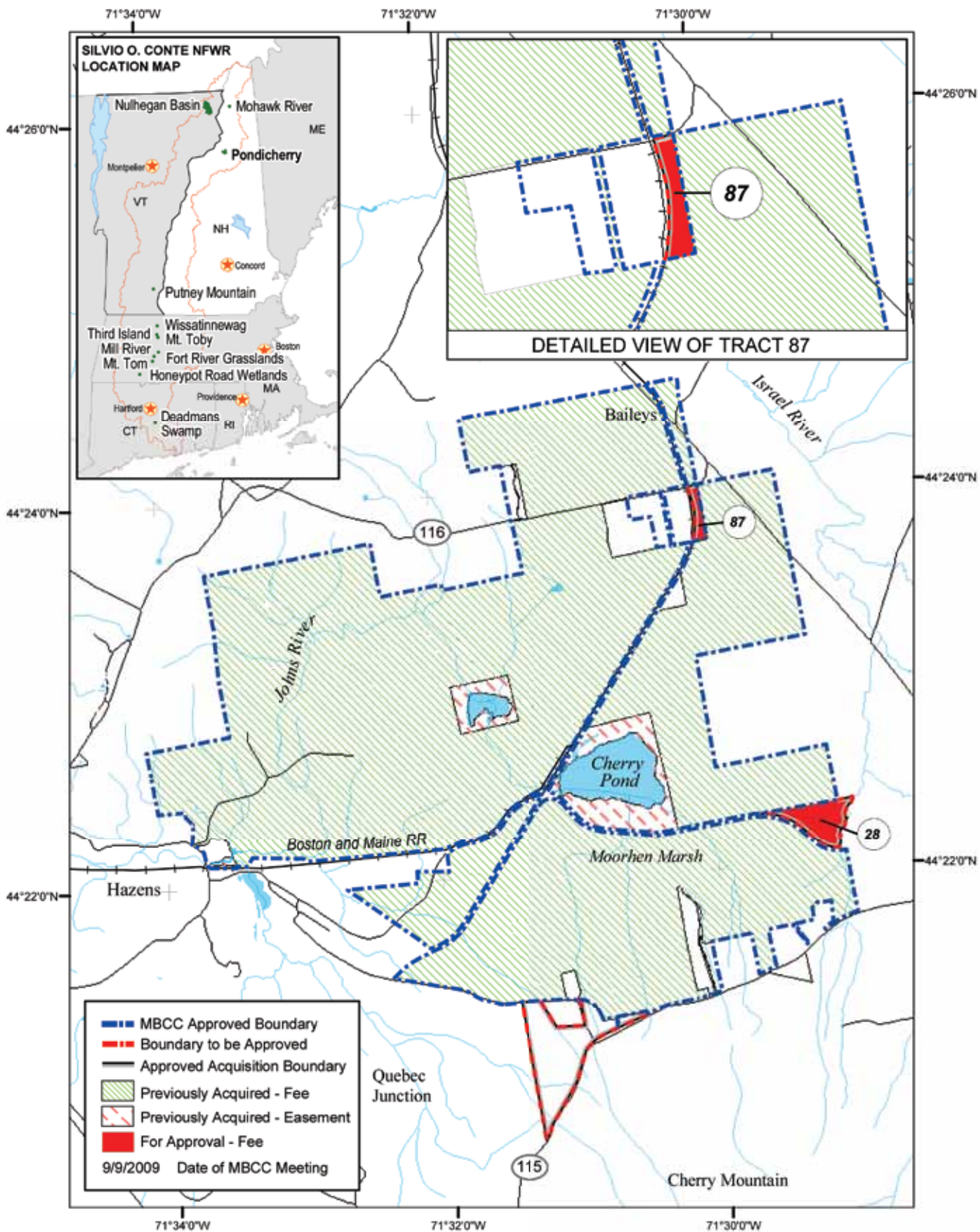

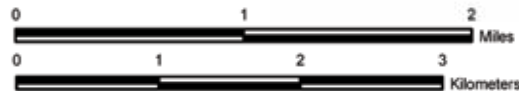

Umbagog National Wildlife Refuge

Location: *Coos County, New Hampshire; Oxford County, Maine*

On June 10, 2009, the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission granted boundary approval for 47,807 acres at Umbagog National Wildlife Refuge, and price approval for the fee title acquisition of 2,450 acres from the Trust for Public Land.

Umbagog NWR is located on the northern New Hampshire/Maine border, 75 miles northwest of Portland, Maine, and 30 miles north of Berlin, New Hampshire. The Refuge project area includes one of the largest freshwater wetland complexes in New England. The extensive palustrine, lacustrine, and riverine wetlands surrounding the lake and its tributaries are some of the finest wildlife habitat in the States of New Hampshire and Maine. The forested wetlands provide breeding and nesting habitat for the American black duck, wood duck, common goldeneye, and common and hooded merganser. Ring-necked duck,

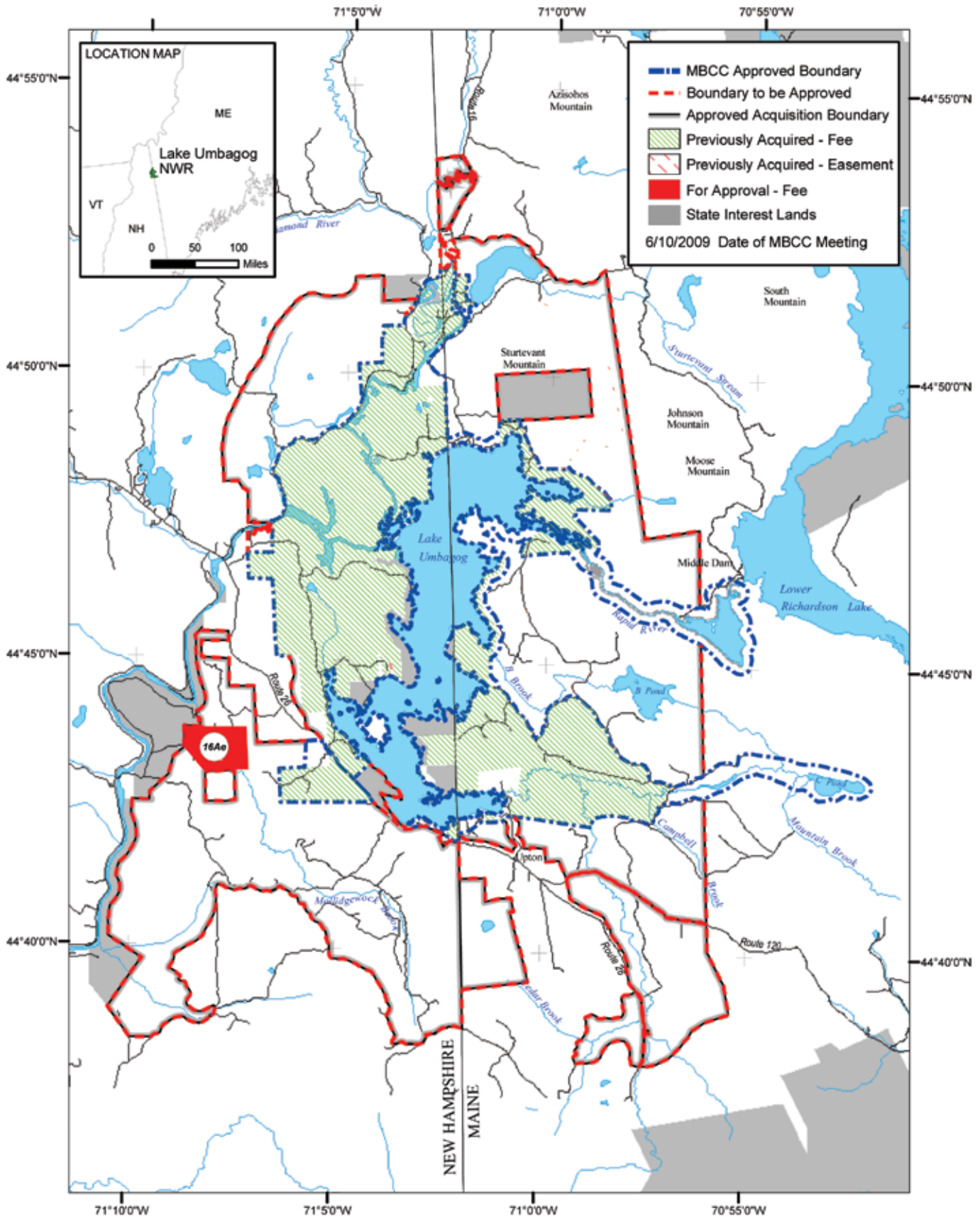
blue- and green-winged teal, and mallard nest on the Refuge which also serves as a staging area during migration for scaup, scoter, Canada goose, and other waterfowl species.

The 47,807-acre expansion area primarily includes large timber management tracts with the remainder being privately owned forest and recreational lands. The area includes forested, shrub, and bog-like wetlands dominated by spruce, fir, and alder; several beaver ponds with associated marsh and wet meadow, and adjacent cut-over forestland in various stages of regrowth. The expansion area and the acquisition of the 2,450-acre parcel of land will give the Service opportunities to restore and manage additional wetland and forestland and create a significant connection to a surrounding network of conservation lands. The Service plans to offer wildlife-dependent recreational uses including hunting, fishing, wildlife observation, and photography.

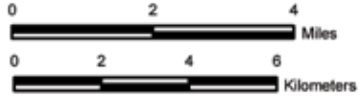

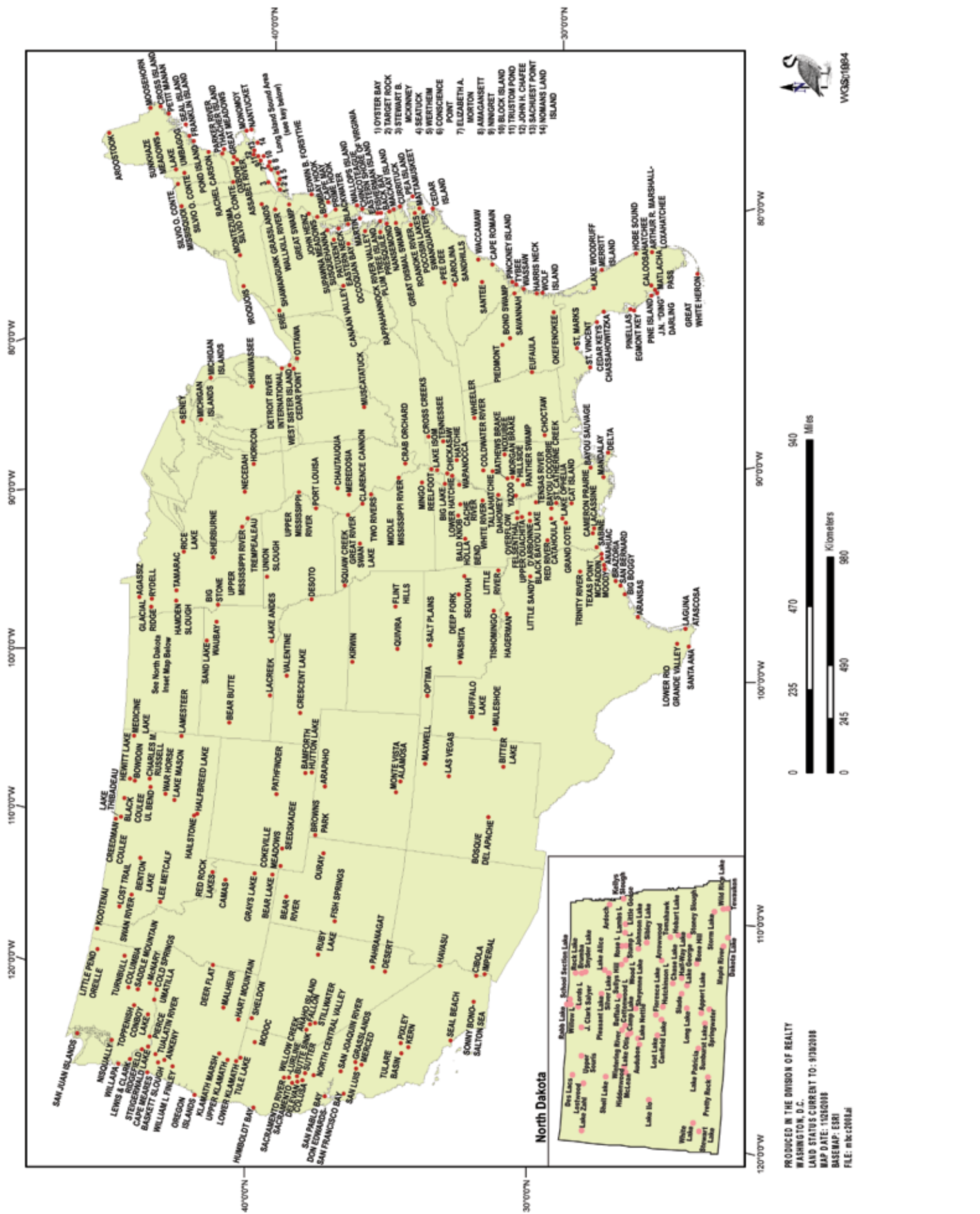

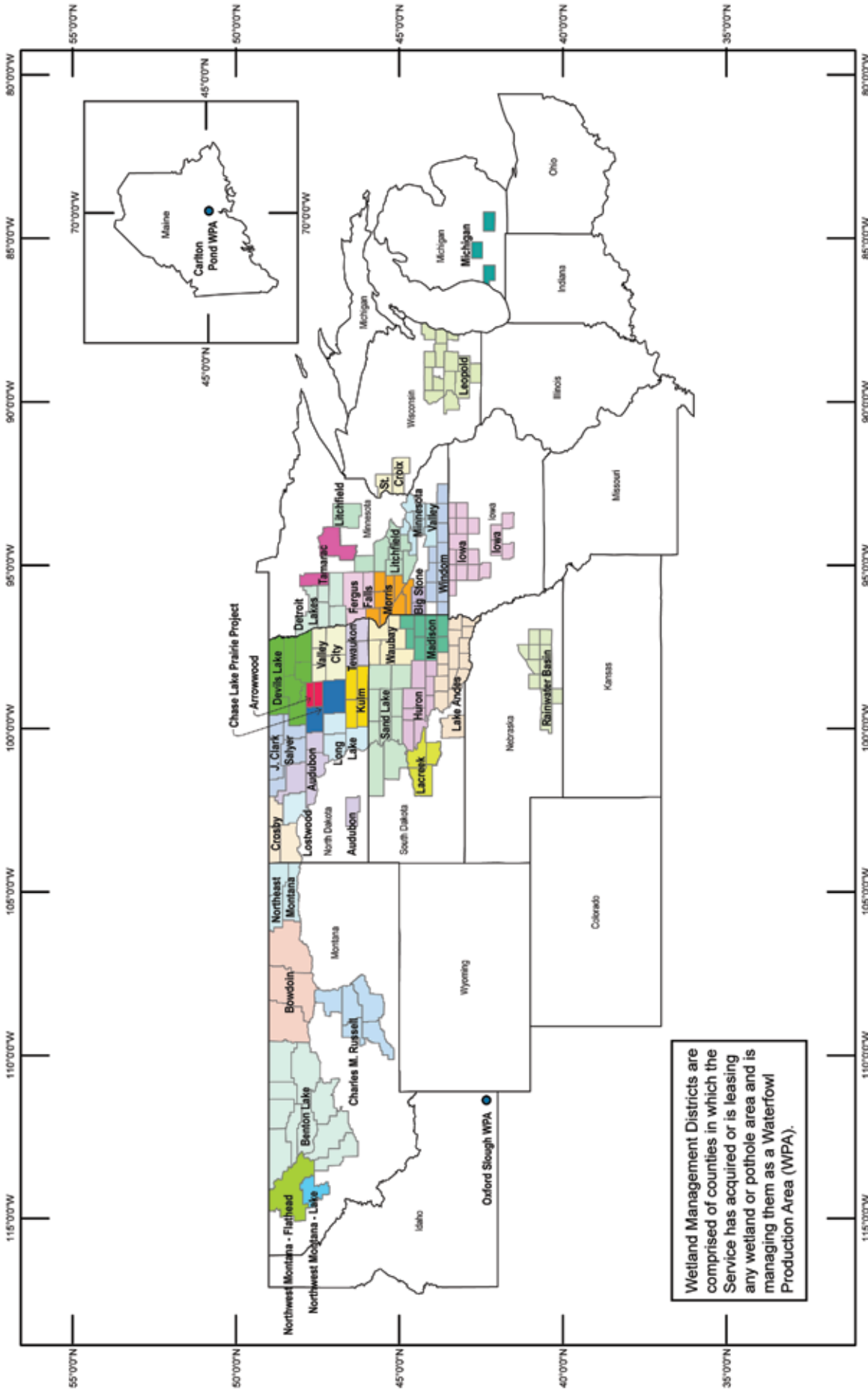

Summary of MBCC Approvals for Fiscal Year 2009

The Migratory Bird Conservation Commission approved 67 wetland conservation project proposals for funding in Fiscal Year 2009 under the North American Wetlands Conservation Act. A total of \$79,655,605 from the North American Wetlands Conservation Fund, together with \$311,466,836 in partner funds, are supporting 53 projects in the United States, 5 in Canada, and 9 in Mexico.
