





Rates of Female Adults and Adolescents Living with Diagnosed HIV Infection Year-end 2017—United States and 6 Dependent Areas







Diagnoses of HIV Infection and Population among Female Adults and Adolescents, by Race/Ethnicity, 2018—United States








Diagnoses of HIV Infection among Female Adults and Adolescents by Region and Race/Ethnicity, 2018—United States




