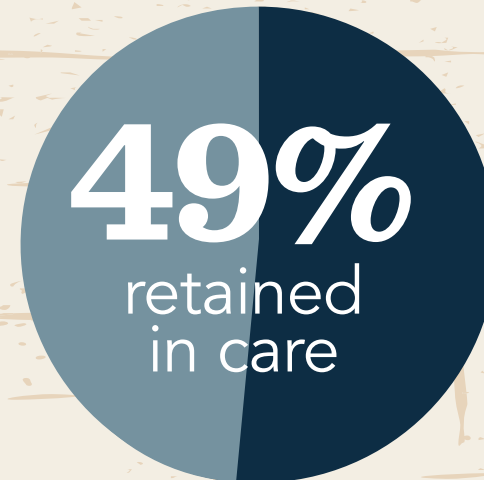
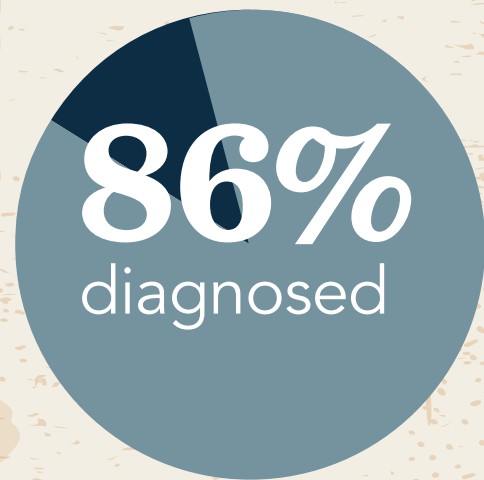


HIV *in the* United States
