Databases on toxicology, hazardous chemicals, environmental health, and toxic releases

ChemiDplus[®] Online dictionary of chemical substances cited in the NLM databases and other Internet resources

ChemiDplus Advanced Includes chemical structure, toxicity, and physical property searching

Chemical Carcinogenesis Research Information System (CCRIS) Scientifically evaluated database of chemicals with carcinogenicity, mutagenicity, tumor promotion, and tumor inhibition test results

Hazardous Substances Data Bank (HSDB®) Comprehensive, peer-reviewed toxicological and environmental data for chemicals, including specific information of drugs and supplements

Developmental and Reproductive Toxicology (DART®)

Bibliographic database with references to teratology, developmental and reproductive toxicology literature

LactMed (Drugs and Lactation Database) Database of drugs and other chemicals to which breastfeeding mothers may be exposed

TOXLINE[®] Bibliographic database of toxicological references

AIDSinfo®

Information about Food Drug Administration approved and investigational HIV/AIDS related drugs.

ClinicalTrials.gov

Searchable database providing information about current ongoing clinical research studies on drugs and treatments.

Chemical Hazards Emergency Medical Management (CHEMM)

Web-based resource that enables first responders and other healthcare providers and planners to plan for, respond to, recover from, and mitigate the effects of mass-casualty incidents involving accidental or terrorist chemical releases. CHEMM is downloadable in advance so that it is available if the Internet is not accessible.

ChemSpell

Web Service Application Programming Interface (API) providing chemical name spell checking and chemical name synonym look-up. Contains more than 1.3 million chemical names related to organic, inorganic, pharmaceutical, toxicological, and environmental health topics.

DailyMed®

Information about marketed drugs, including FDA labels (package inserts).

Dietary Supplements Labels Database

Information about label ingredients, manufacturers, and structure and function claims for more than 6,000 selected brands of dietary supplements. dietarysupplements.nlm.nih.gov/dietary

Drug Information Portal

Information on more than 17,000 drugs from the time that they are in clinical trials, through their FDA approval, and then on to the marketplace. Coverage includes drugs with official generic name status and drugs such as USAN (United States Adopted Name) or INN (International Nonproprietary Name) and limited information on many drugs manufactured outside the U.S.

Enables rapid identification of unknown solid-dosage medications based on physical characteristics and high-resolution images.

Information on the biological activities of small molecules. PubChem includes substance information, compound structures, and BioActivity data in three primary databases: PubChem Substance, PubChem Compound, and PubChem BioAssay.
