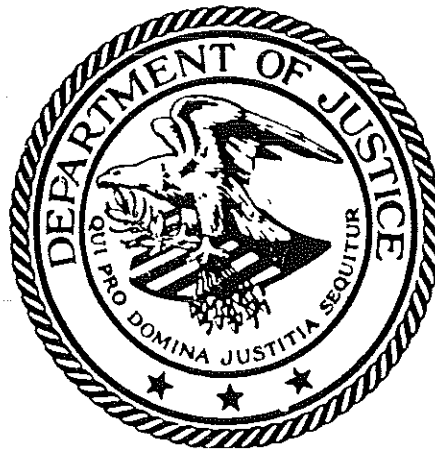

DURING FISCAL YEAR 1961

CRIMINAL CASES

FILED - During fiscal year 1961, the 30,791 criminal cases filed represented a small increase of .6 of 1 per cent from the number filed in the previous year. While the number of cases filed (exclusive of Rule 20 Transfers) has not changed significantly in the last six fiscal years, the 7 types of violations shown below which comprised 40.3 per cent of the total cases filed in fiscal year 1956, amounted to 51.4 per cent of the total in fiscal year 1961.

It will be noted that Embezzlement, Narcotics, National Stolen Property Act and Postal Laws with increases of 30% or more since 1956 aggregated 36.9 per cent of the total cases filed in fiscal year 1961 as against 26.4 per cent in fiscal year 1956.

Increases took place in 51 districts ranging from 119 in Northern Texas to 1 in Colorado while decreases ranging from 274 in Southern Florida to 2 in Middle Alabama occurred in 38 districts, Rhode Island with 44 cases and Wyoming with 118 cases had the same number as in fiscal year 1960.

**TERMINATED** - Cases terminated dropped slightly from 30,462 in the previous year to 30,309 in fiscal year 1961, a decrease of 1 per cent. Of the 30,309 cases closed 22,507 (having 27,553 defendants) were closed after guilty pleas; 2,370 (involving 3,190 defendants) were found guilty after trial and 709 (with 1,355 defendants) not guilty.

**PENDING** - The number of cases pending as of the close of year rose to 8,319 a 6.2 per cent increase over the 7,837\* pending as of June 30, 1960. 6,726 of the cases were in a triable status while 1,593 were in a fugitive or other status beyond the control of United States Attorneys.

#### GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS

Grand Jury Proceedings comprised of 14,565 indictments and 535 No True Bills amounted to 15,100 a rise of 3.1 per cent from the 14,646 such proceedings in fiscal year 1960.

#### CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS

**RECEIVED** - Complaints received in United States Attorneys' Offices increased to 108,194 (1.1 per cent more than 106,994 complaints received in fiscal year 1960) 16,422 National Motor Vehicle Theft Act complaints

comprised 15.2 per cent of the total. Selective Service and National Stolen Property complaints were the next highest with 9,778 and 9,297 respectively. 45,619 complaints or 42.2 per cent of the total were received in 14 districts having 2,000 or more complaints. Southern California with 6,678 had the most complaints. Southern Florida with 4,045 and Northern California with 3,989 were the next highest.

CLOSED - 76,994 complaints were closed during fiscal year 1961 without reaching court dockets. Of this number 69,480 with 88,376 defendants were closed by declination of prosecution.

PENDING - For the first time in the three fiscal years United States Attorneys closed the fiscal year with more than 10,000 complaints pending in their offices. The 10,255 complaints pending as of June 30, 1961 was 829 or 8.8 per cent more than the number pending as of June 30, 1960.

#### CIVIL SUITS

FILED - For the first time in four years, civil suits filed dropped below 24,000. The 23,877 filed in fiscal year 1961 represented a decrease of 2.1 per cent from the preceding year. A total of 41 districts had increases; two had the same number and 48 had decreases. Southern Florida with 277 had the largest increase. Negotiable instrument cases with 3,922 decreased by 821 and Veterans' cases with 2,872 decreased by 466 and Tax cases with 6,080 were up from the previous year by 662.

TERMINATED - With 48 districts showing decreases, civil suits terminated dropped from 23,457 in fiscal year 1960 to 22,271 in fiscal year 1961, a drop of 1,186 or 5.1 per cent. Decreases ranged from 407 in Minnesota to 1 in Arizona. Increases ranged from 12 in Northern Ohio to 150 in Southern Florida.

PENDING - The backlog of civil pending cases increased by 8.4 per cent to 20,740 and is the first time since fiscal year 1955 that the Civil Case-load exceeded 20,000 as of June 30. 12,207 or 58.9 per cent were in 22 districts with caseloads ranging from 312 in Western New York to 1,115 in Eastern New York. Except for Tax Lien cases which rose from 3,034 to 3,721, the major types of civil cases showed changes of less than 200 cases each from the June 30, 1960 figures. Tax cases (3,093 to 3,269) Contract actions (2,041 to 2,209) and Lands actions (3,385 to 3,454) showed increases while Veterans' cases with 1,455 decreased slightly from 1,507.

#### CIVIL MATTERS

RECEIVED - Civil matters received by United States Attorneys' offices amounted to 32,888 which was reached in fiscal year 1958. Negotiable instrument matters with 7,001 and Veterans' matters with 4,723 comprised 21.3 and 14.4 per cent of the total respectively.

TERMINATED - Civil matters terminated without reaching court dockets amounted to 7,980 a decrease of 1,329 from the previous fiscal year.

PENDING - 12,931 civil matters were pending as of June 30, 1961 as compared to 11,643 as of June 30, 1960. This is an increase of 1,288 or 11.1 per cent.

#### COLLECTIONS

Collections for fiscal year 1961 increased by 5.7 per cent to \$34,837,720. This is the fourth highest total collected in any fiscal year and is the sixth time in the history of the Department that collections have exceeded 30,000,000 during a fiscal year. It is noteworthy that this has happened five times in the last six fiscal years. The \$34,837,720 collected represents a return of \$2.46 for each dollar of the \$14,172,600

appropriated for United States Attorneys' offices for the year ending June 30, 1961.

#### SAVINGS

\$41,352,191 was saved in 1,134 of the 22,271 civil suits terminated in which the government as defendant was sued for a total of \$55,355,283. This is \$963,358 or 2.3 per cent less than the \$42,315,549 saved in fiscal year 1960.

#### PERSONNEL

During the year, an average of 1,551 employees were employed in United States Attorneys' offices; 278 employees were appointed and 406 separated, a net loss of 128 employees, and 1,472 employees were on the rolls as of June 30, 1961. Cases handled per Assistant United States Attorney increased from 130 in fiscal year 1960 to 144 in the current fiscal year while cases terminated rose from 86 to 93.

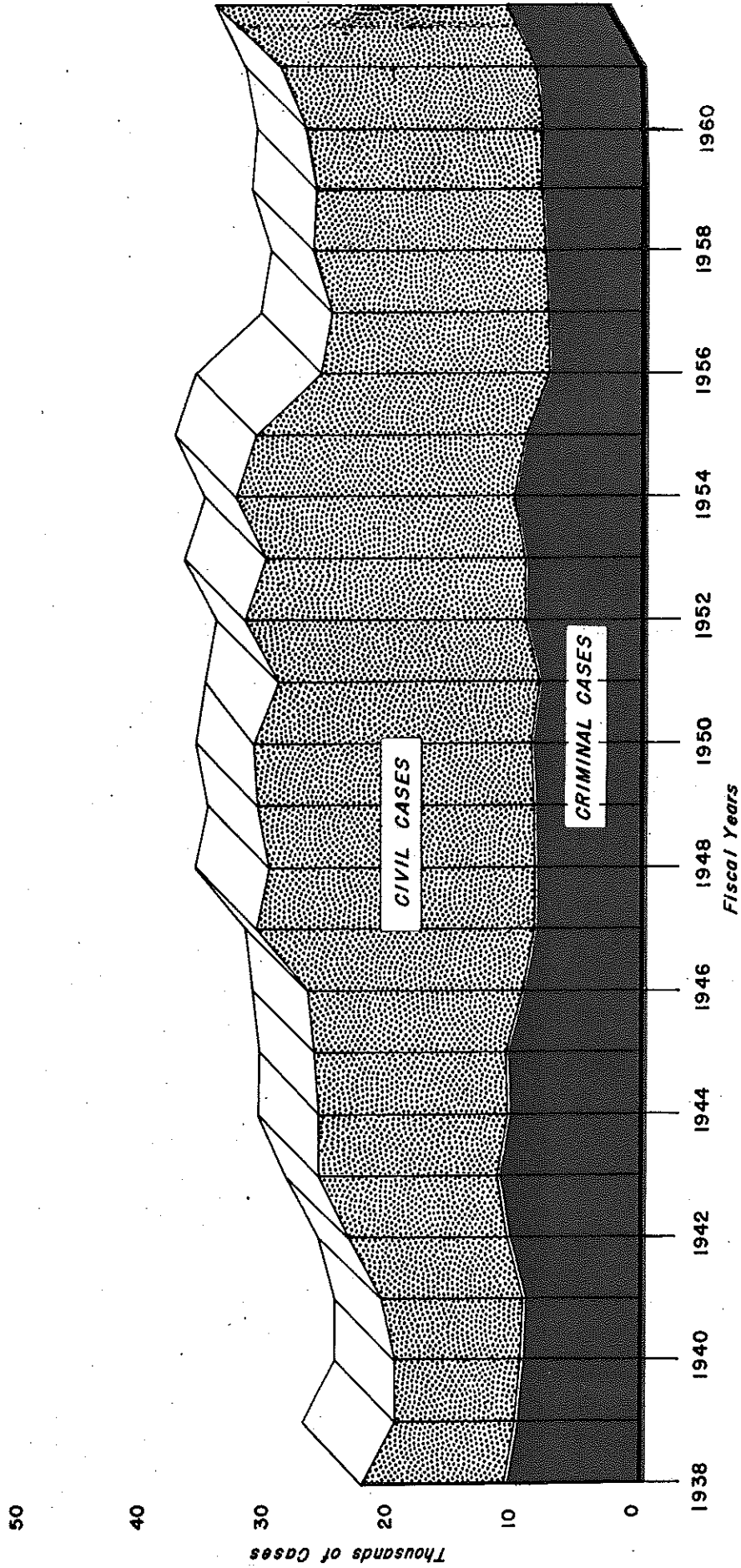
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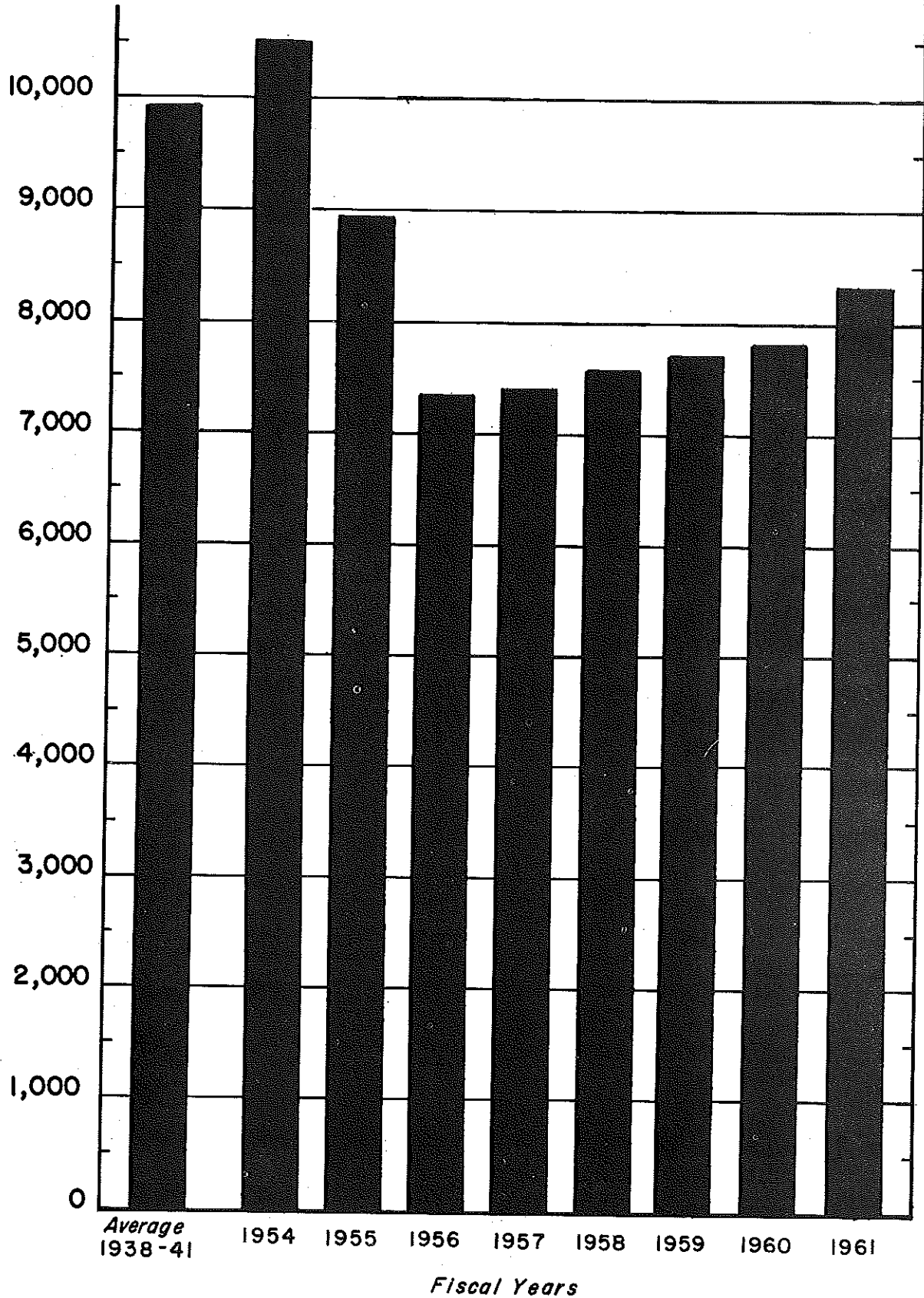


CHART NO. I

# CHART NO. 2 CRIMINAL CASES PENDING

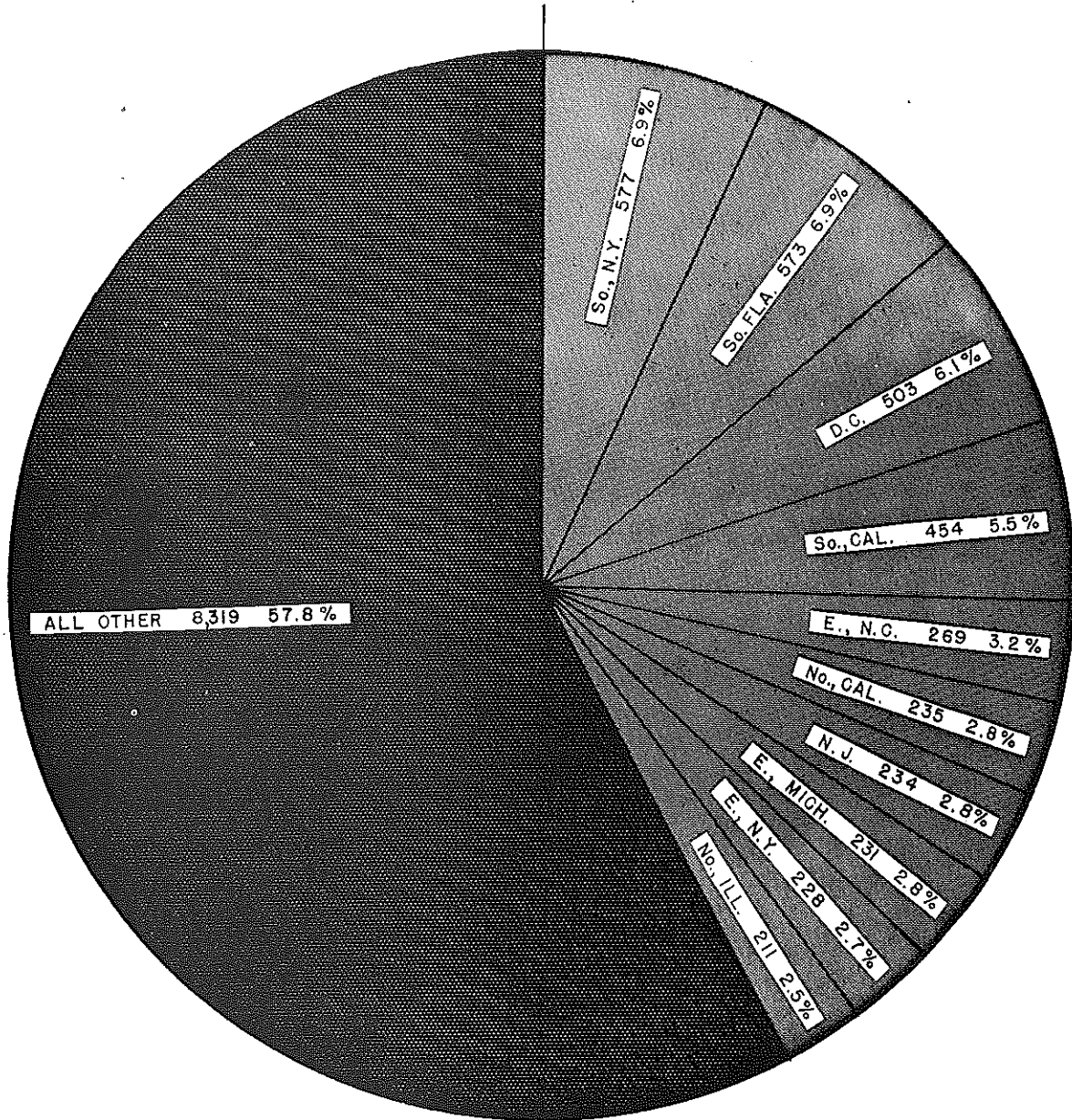

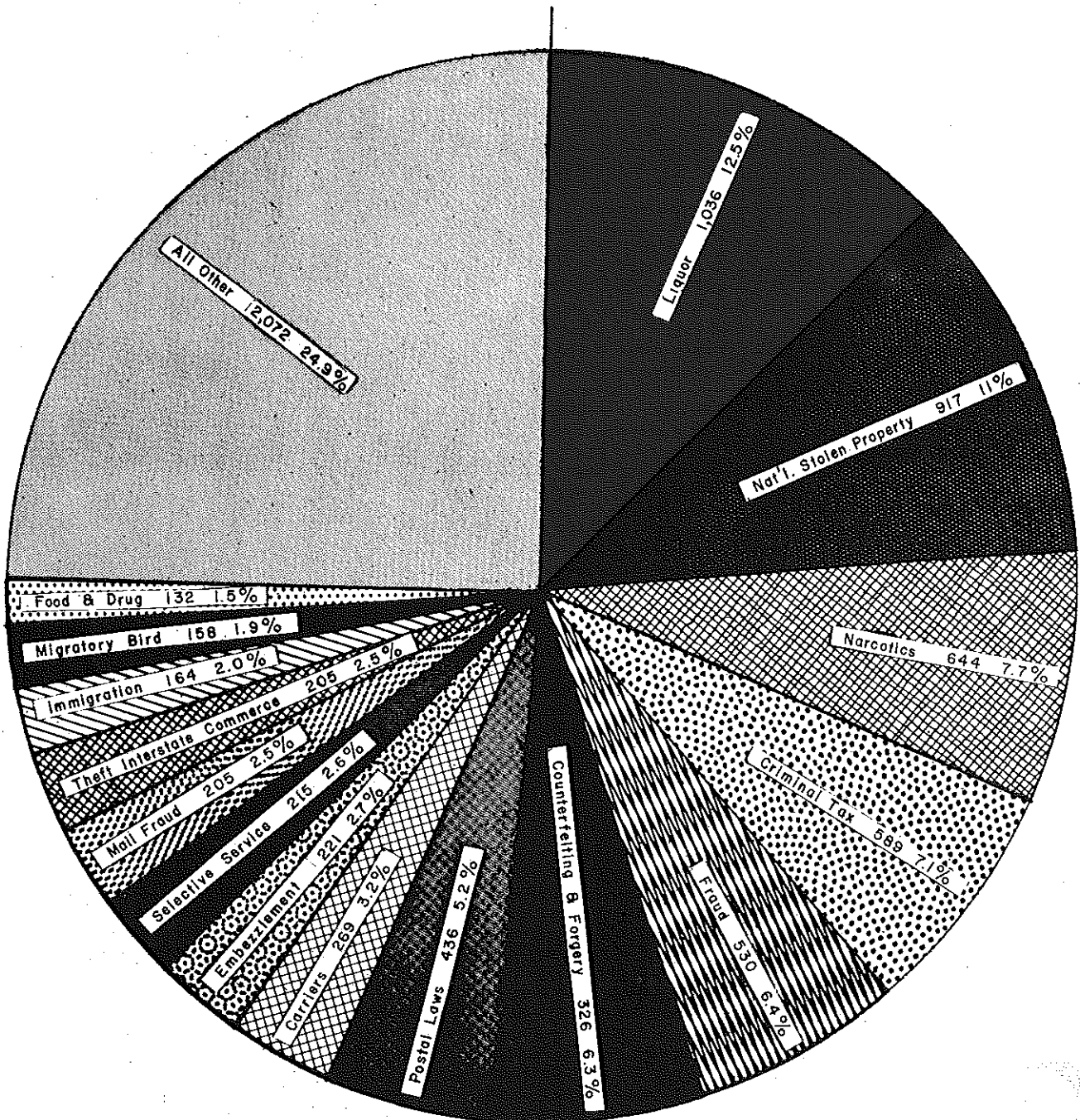

AGE OF CRIMINAL CASES PENDING AS OF JUNE 30, 1961

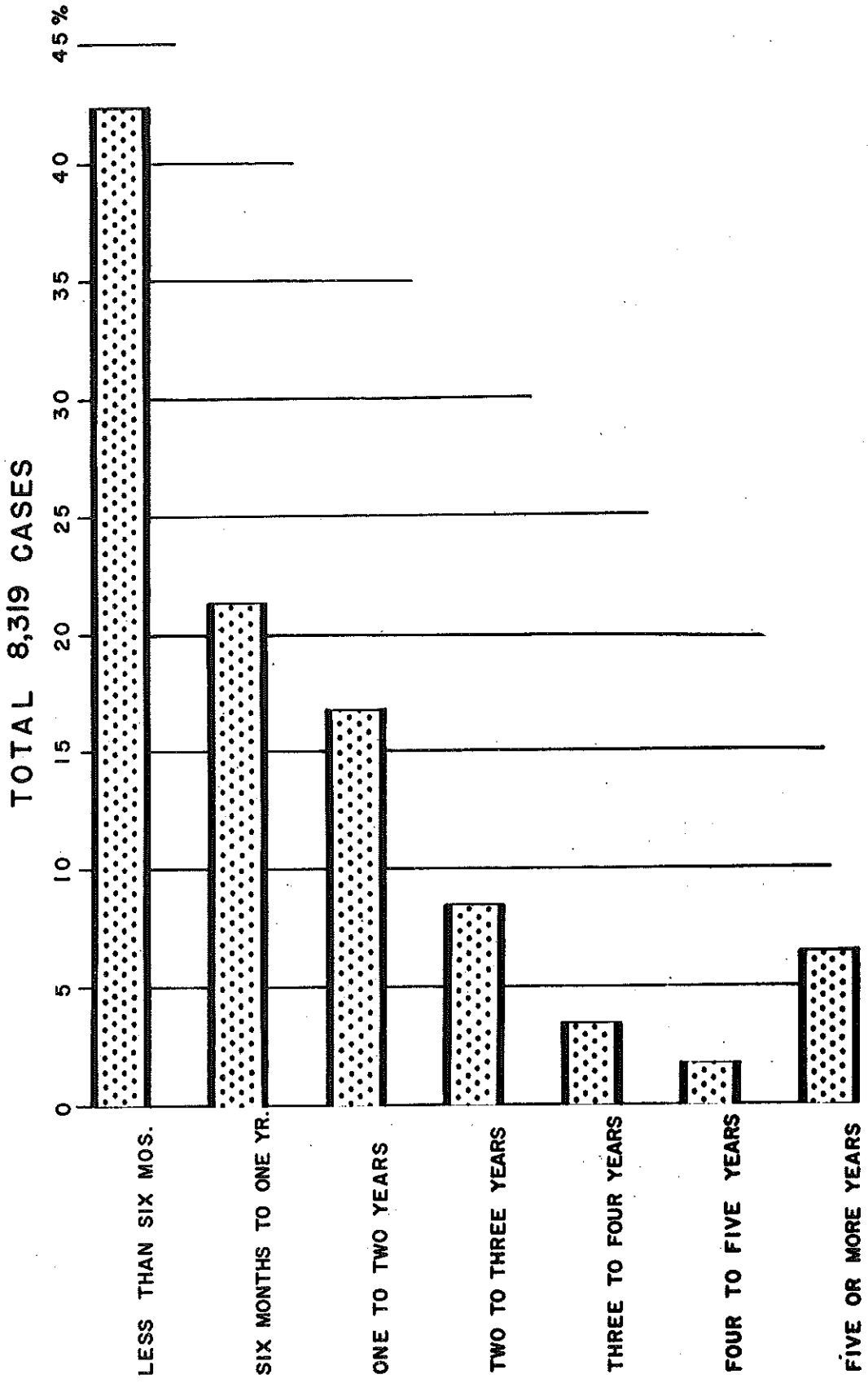

CRIMINAL CASES FILED

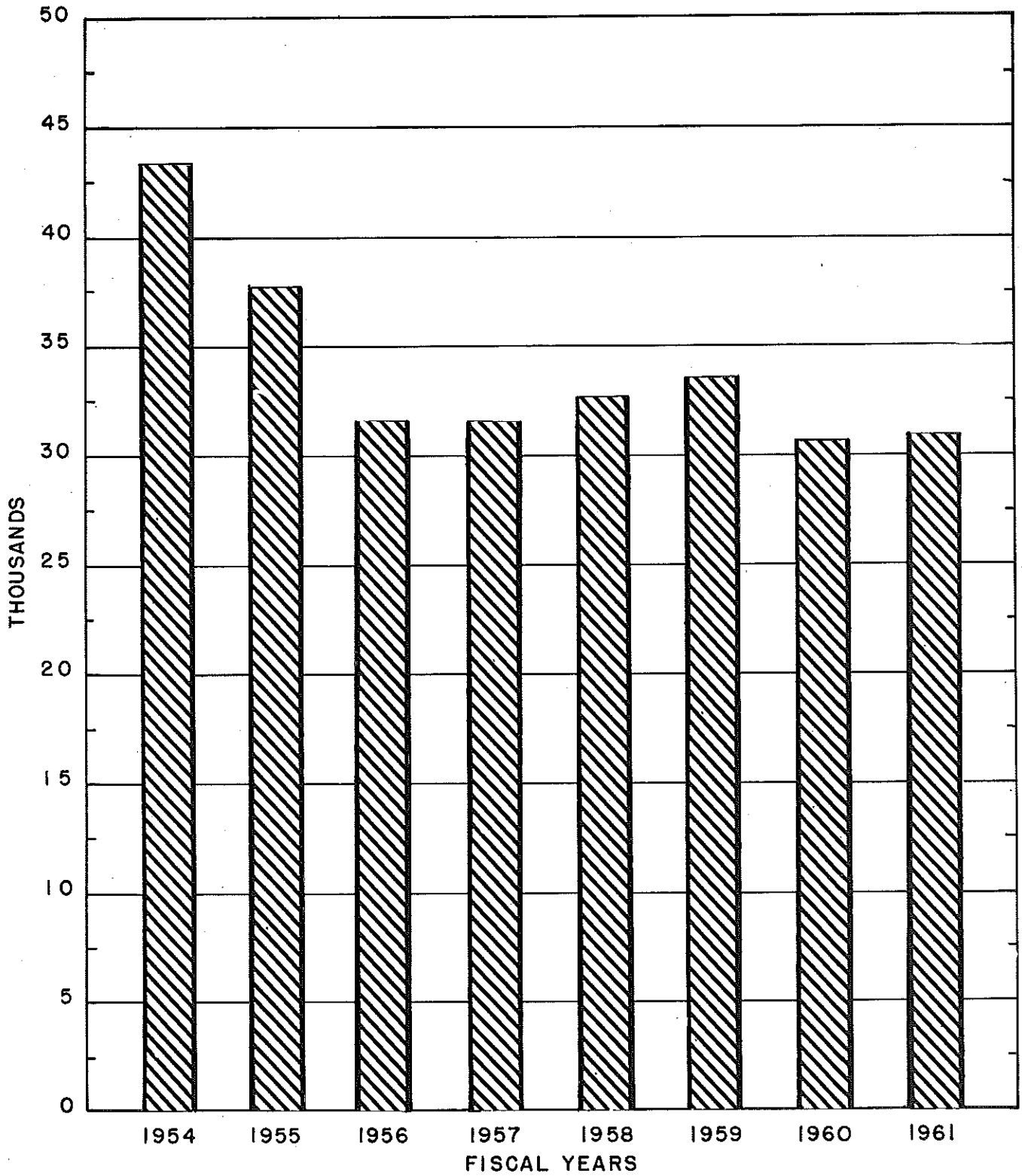

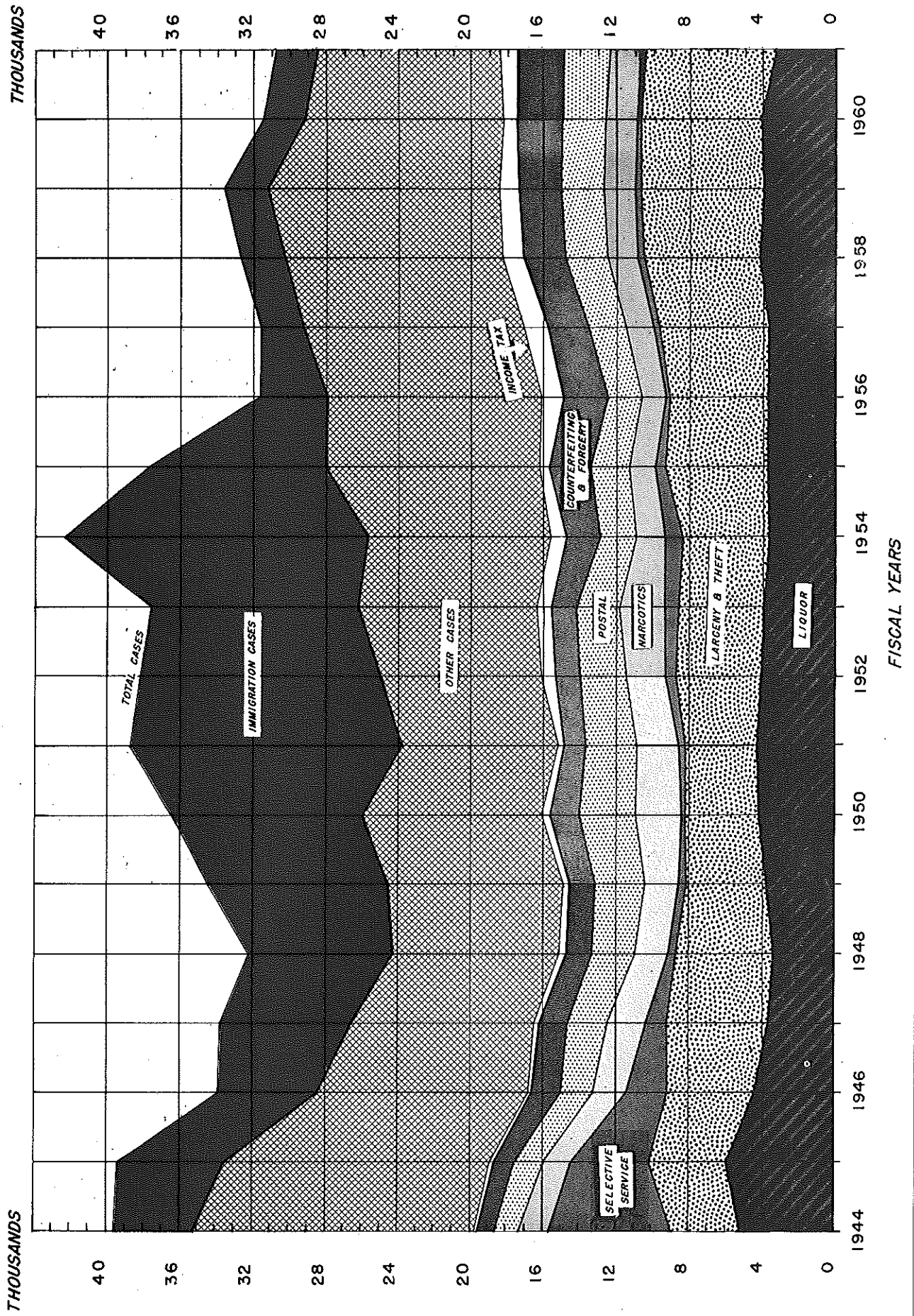
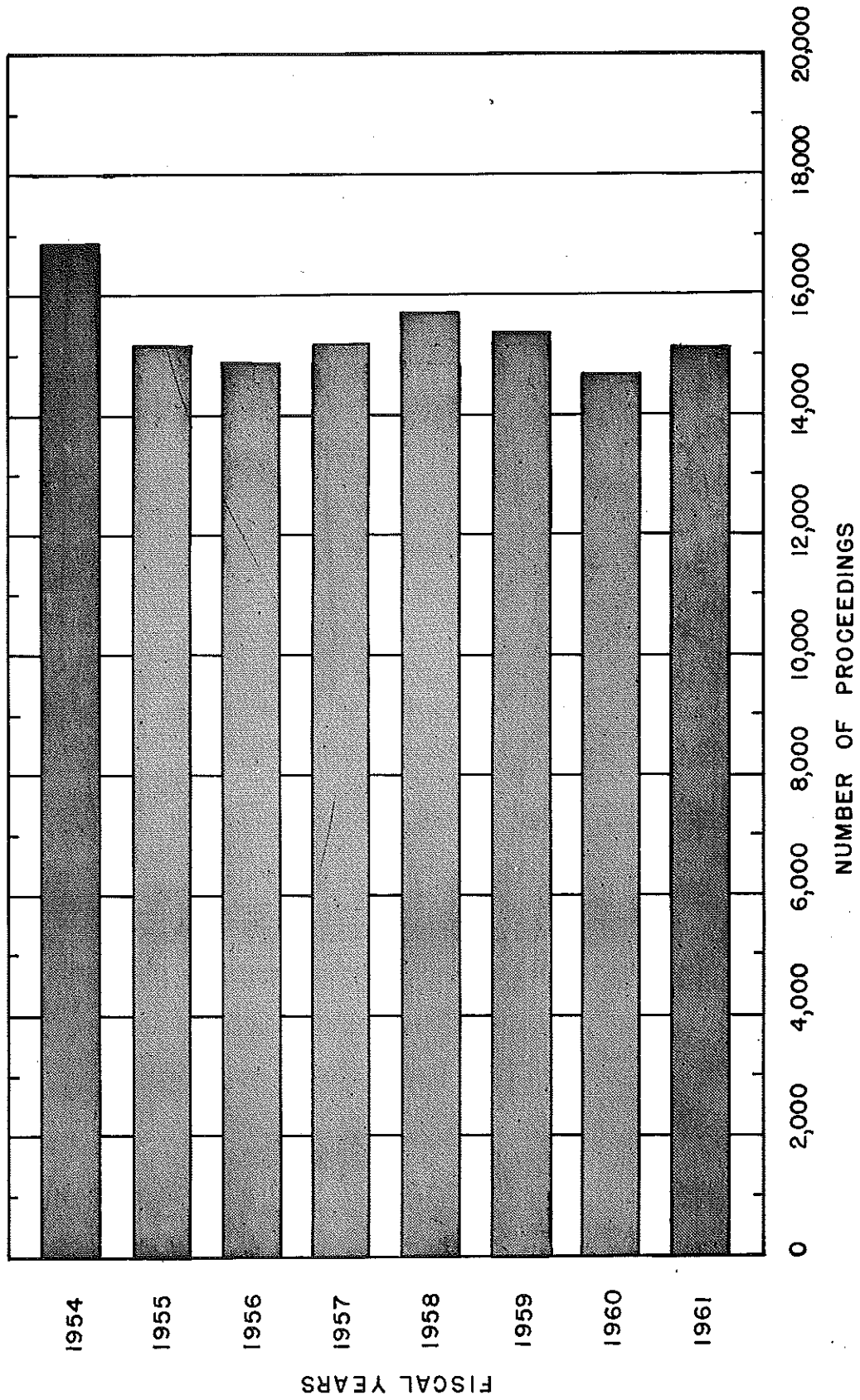

## CRIMINAL CASES TERMINATED

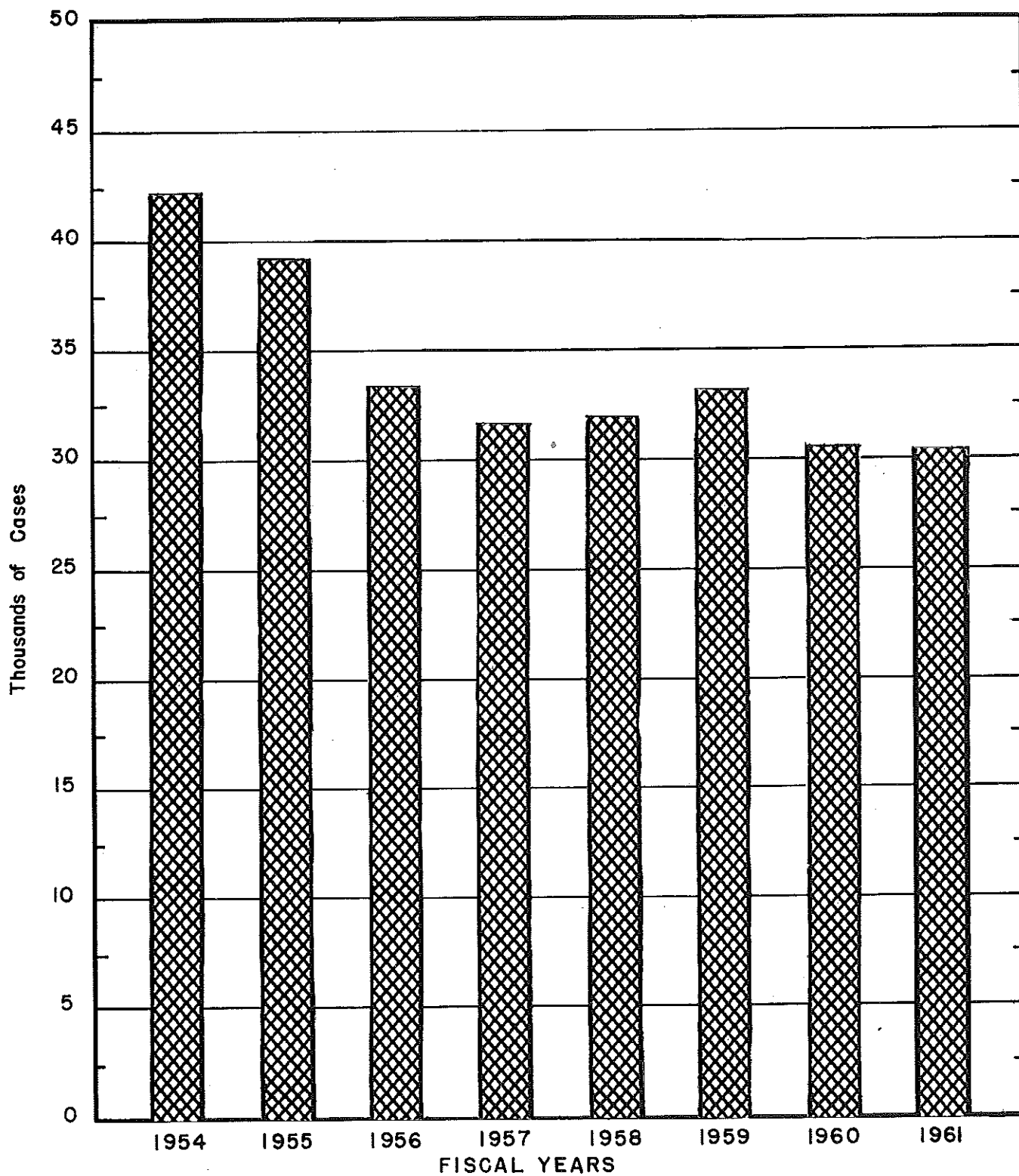

TRIALS IN CRIMINAL CASES

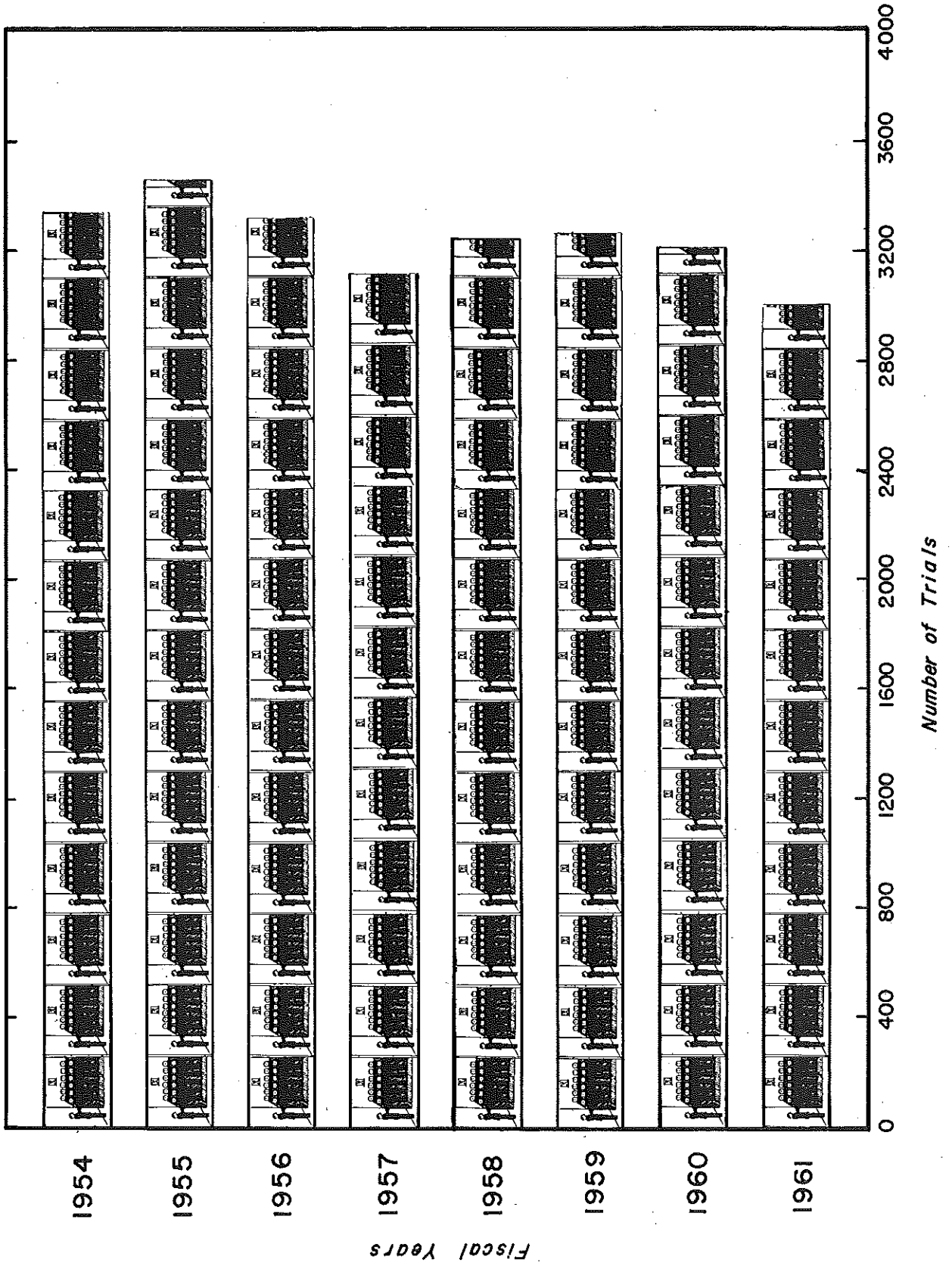
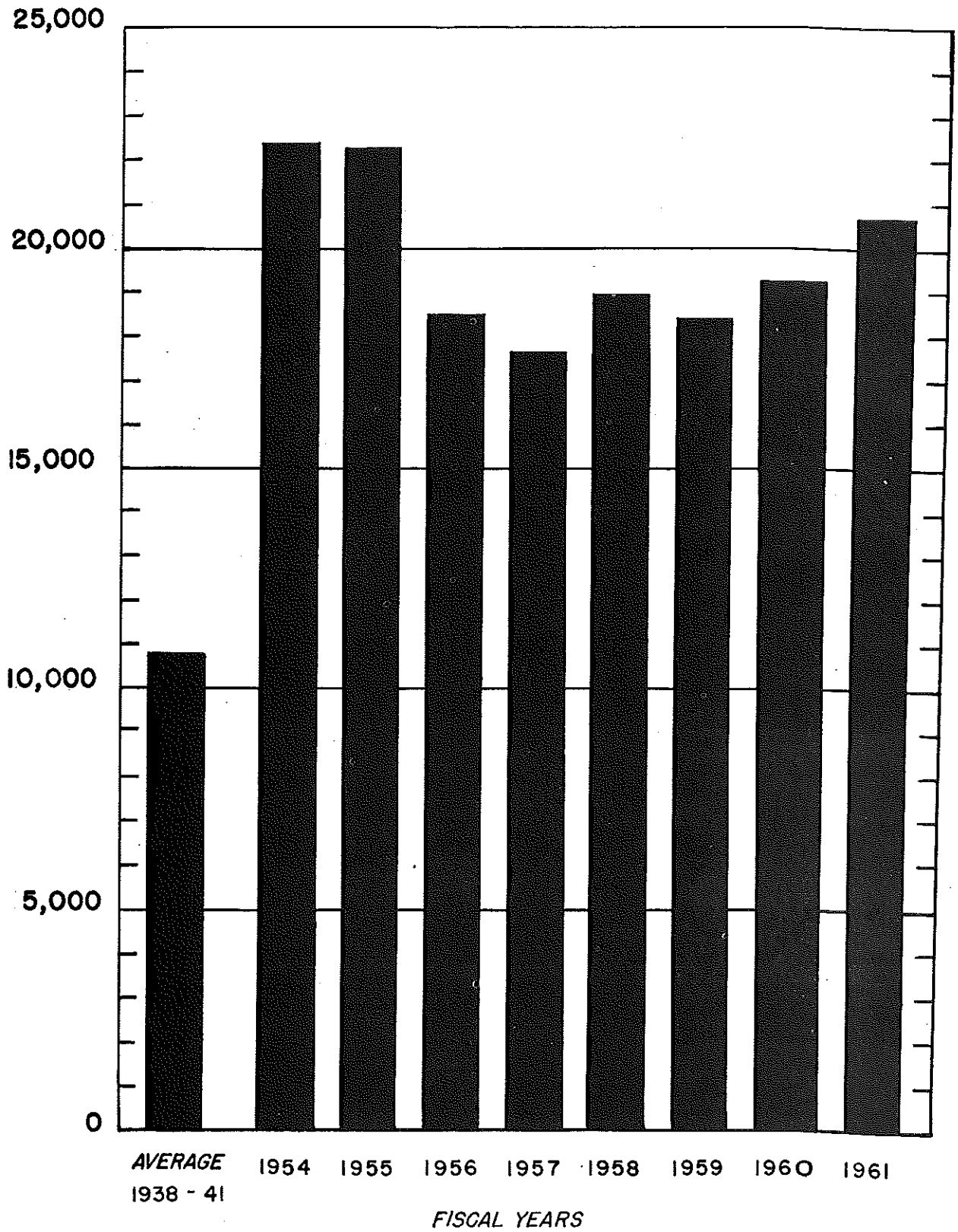


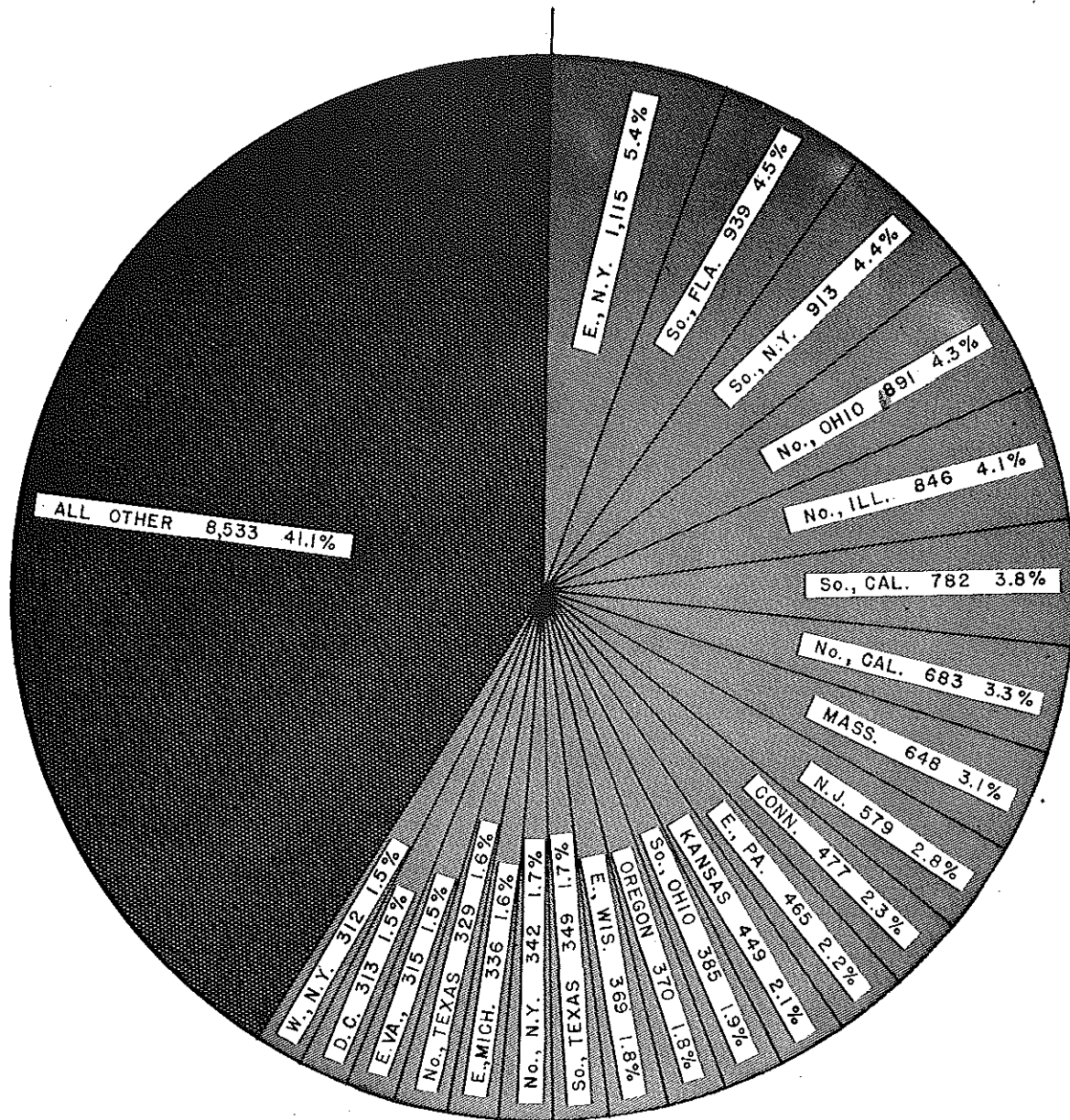
CHART NO. II

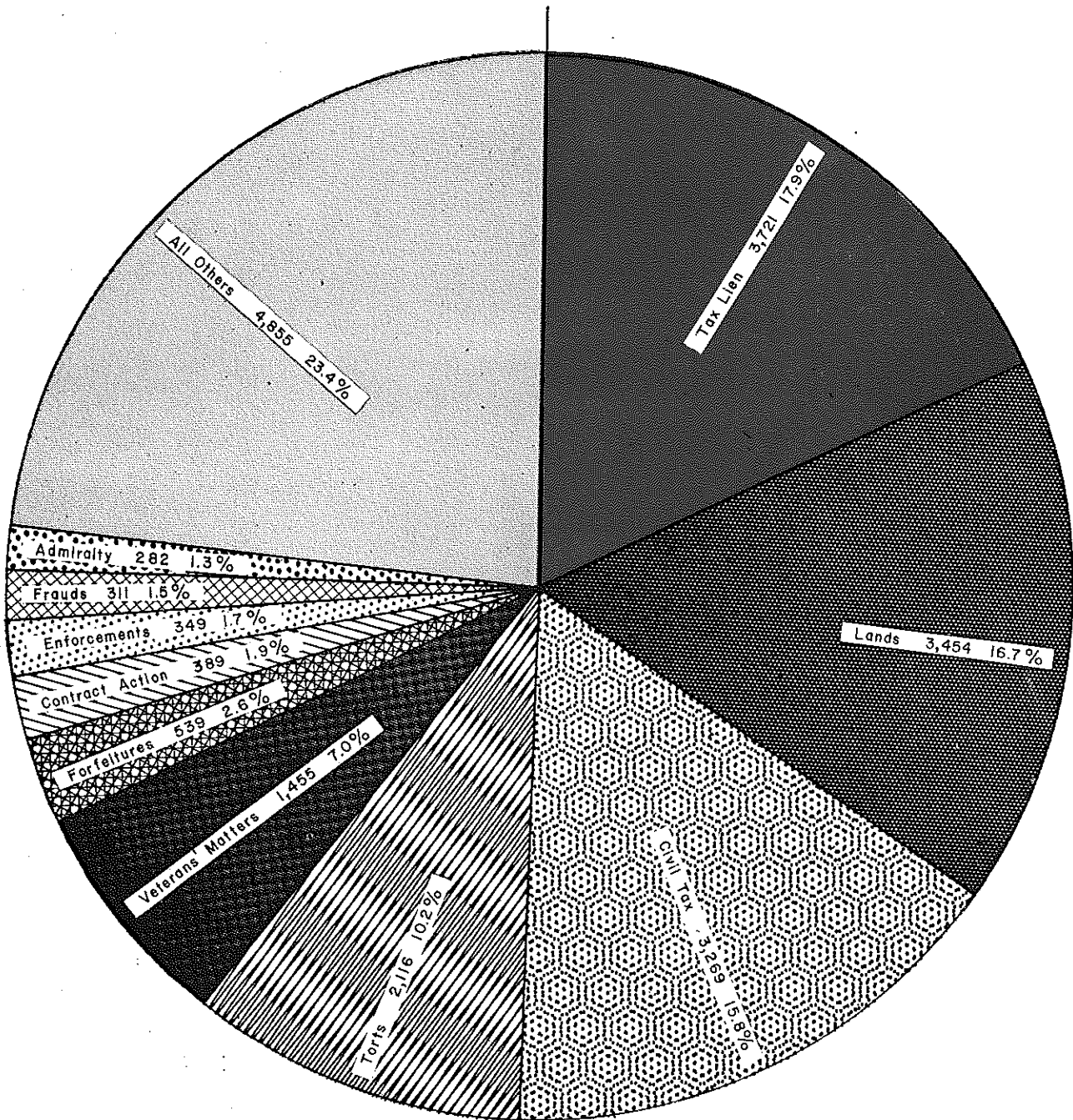
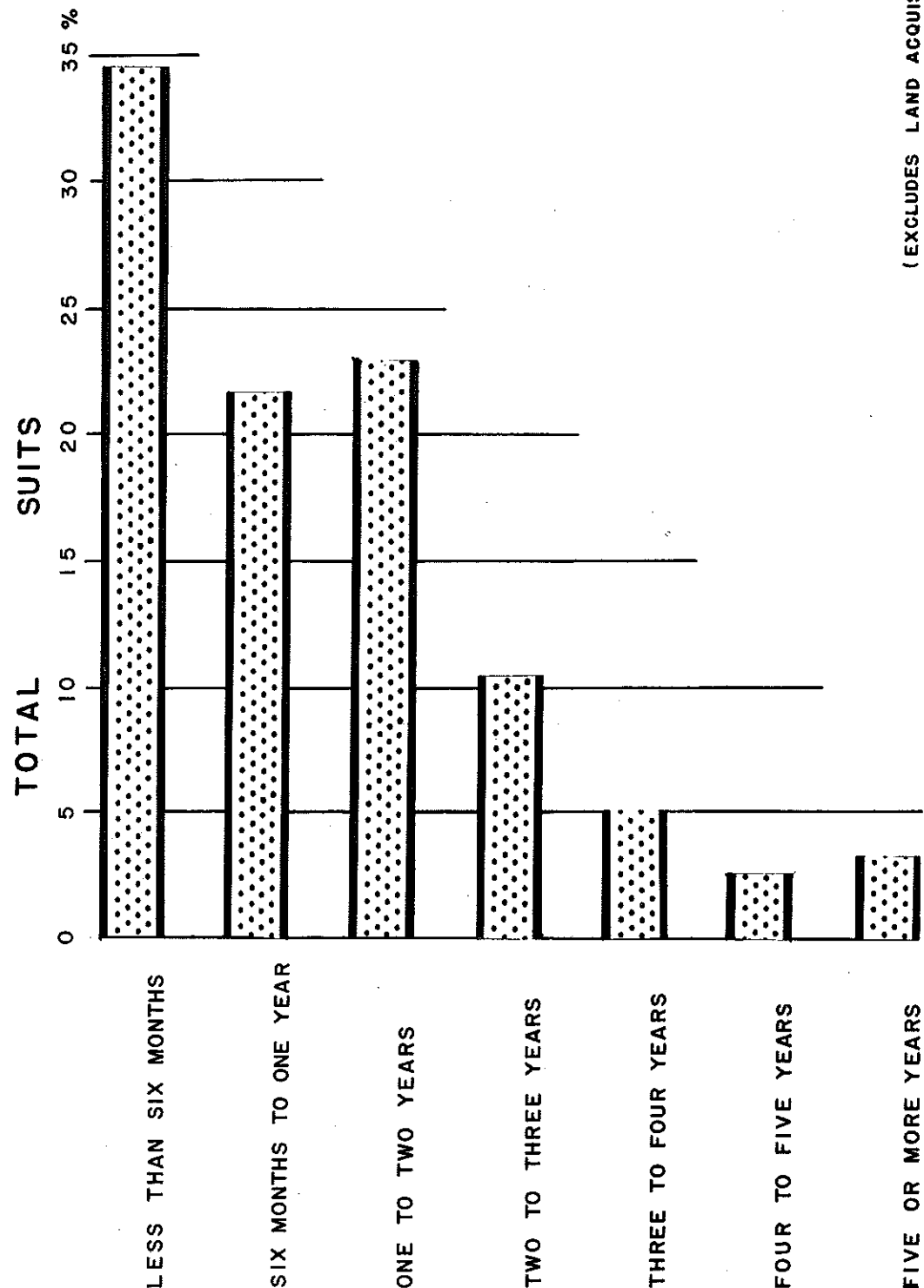


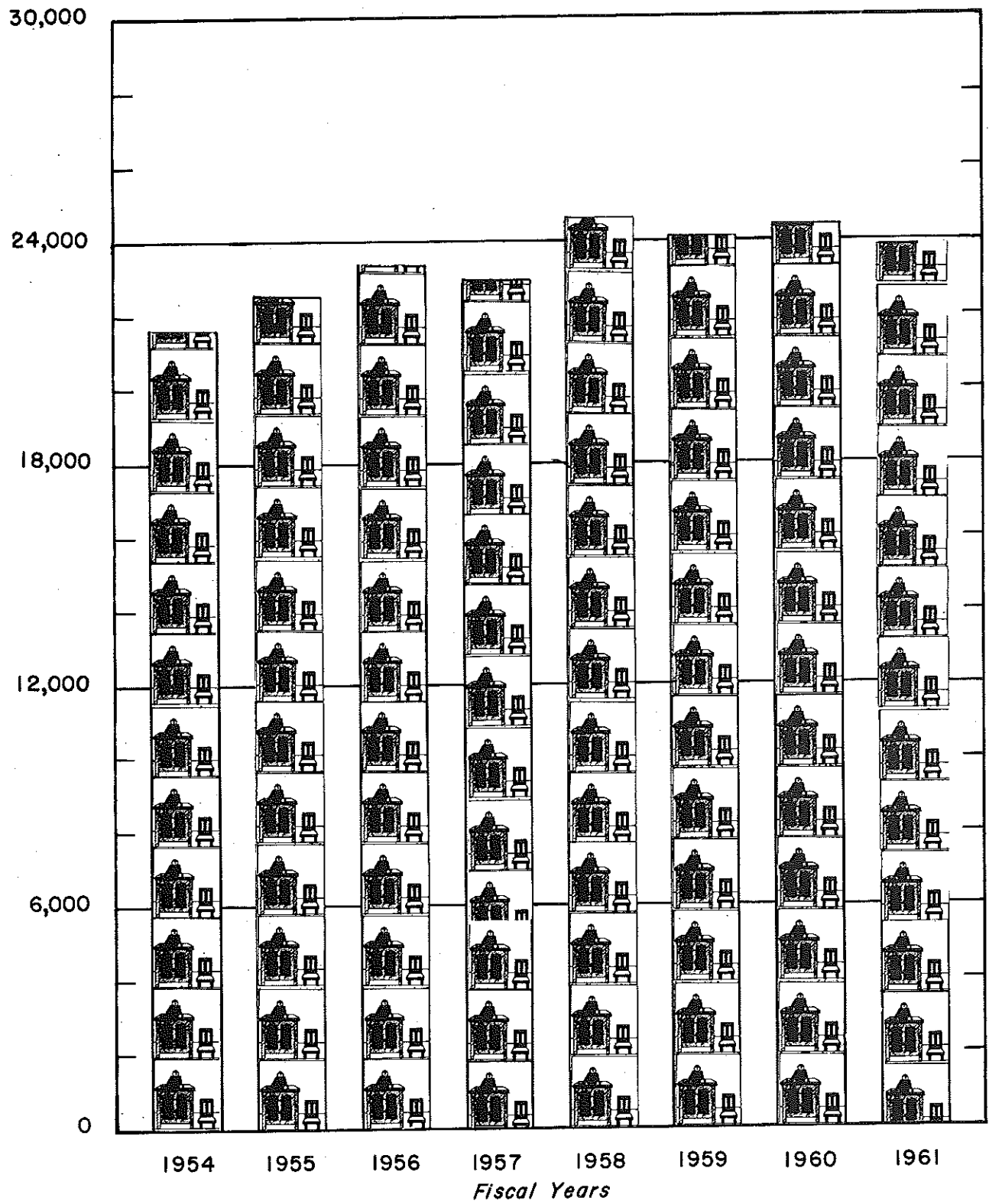
CHART NO. 14

## CIVIL MATTERS RECEIVED

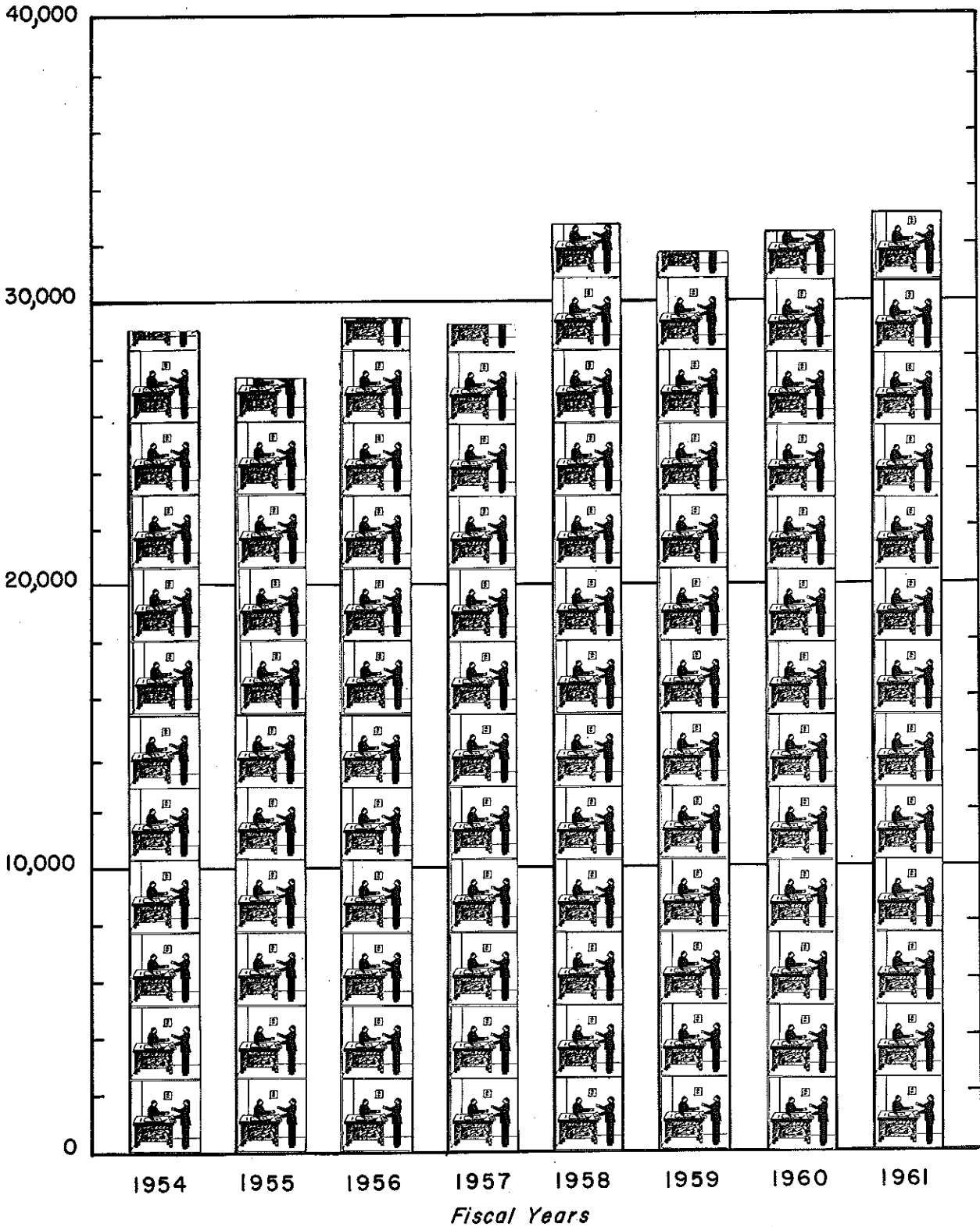
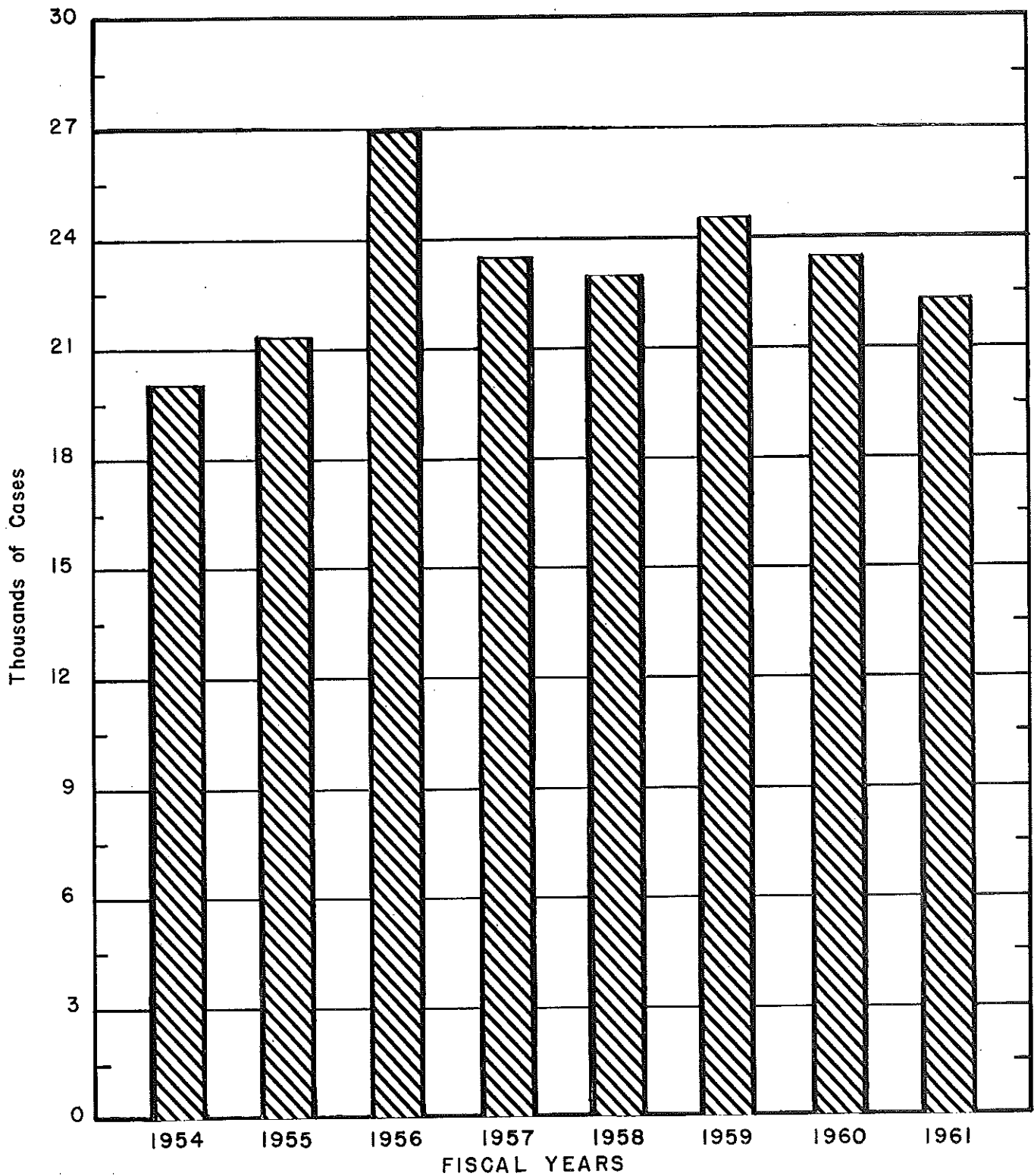

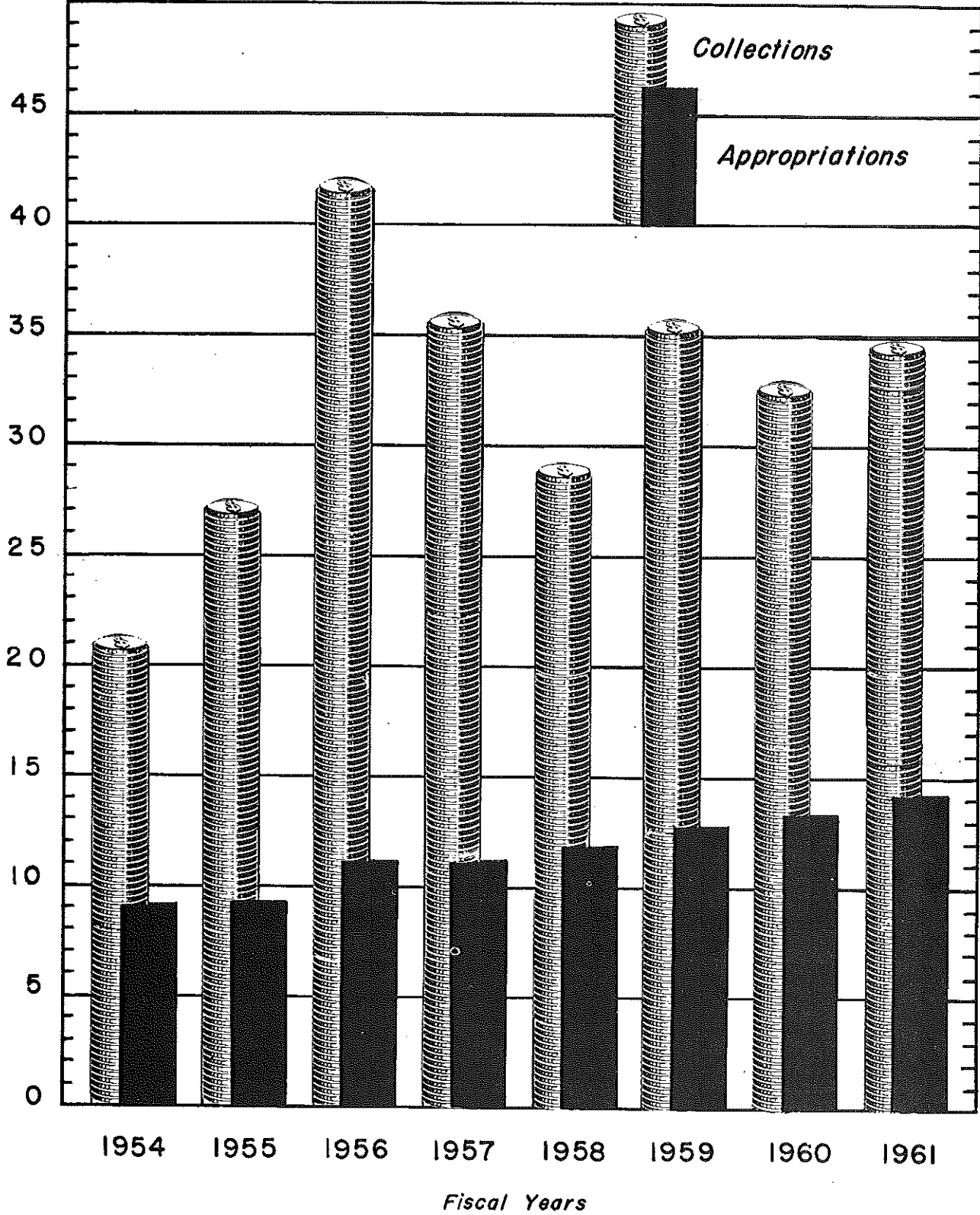

 ACCESSIONS AND SEPARATIONS - UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

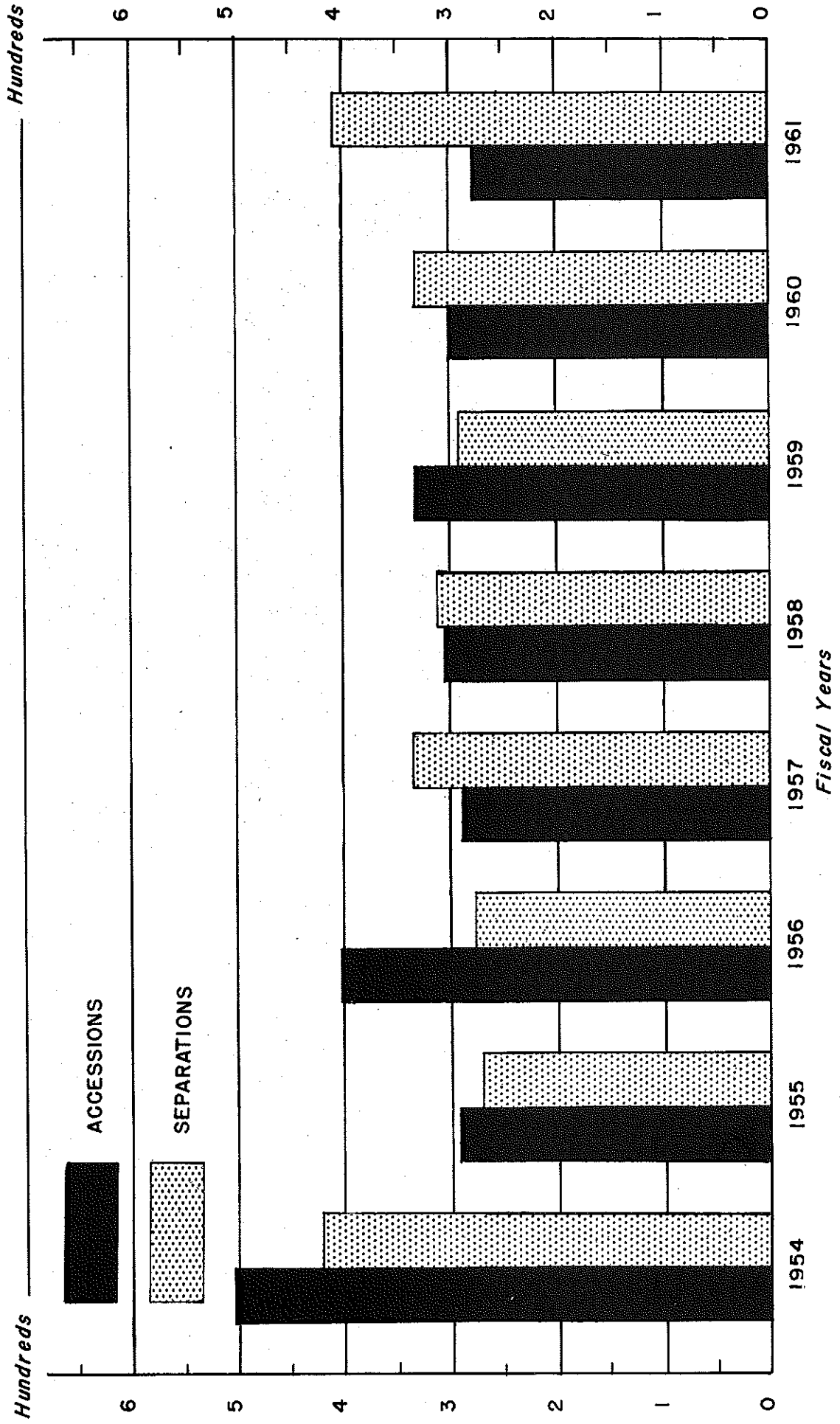
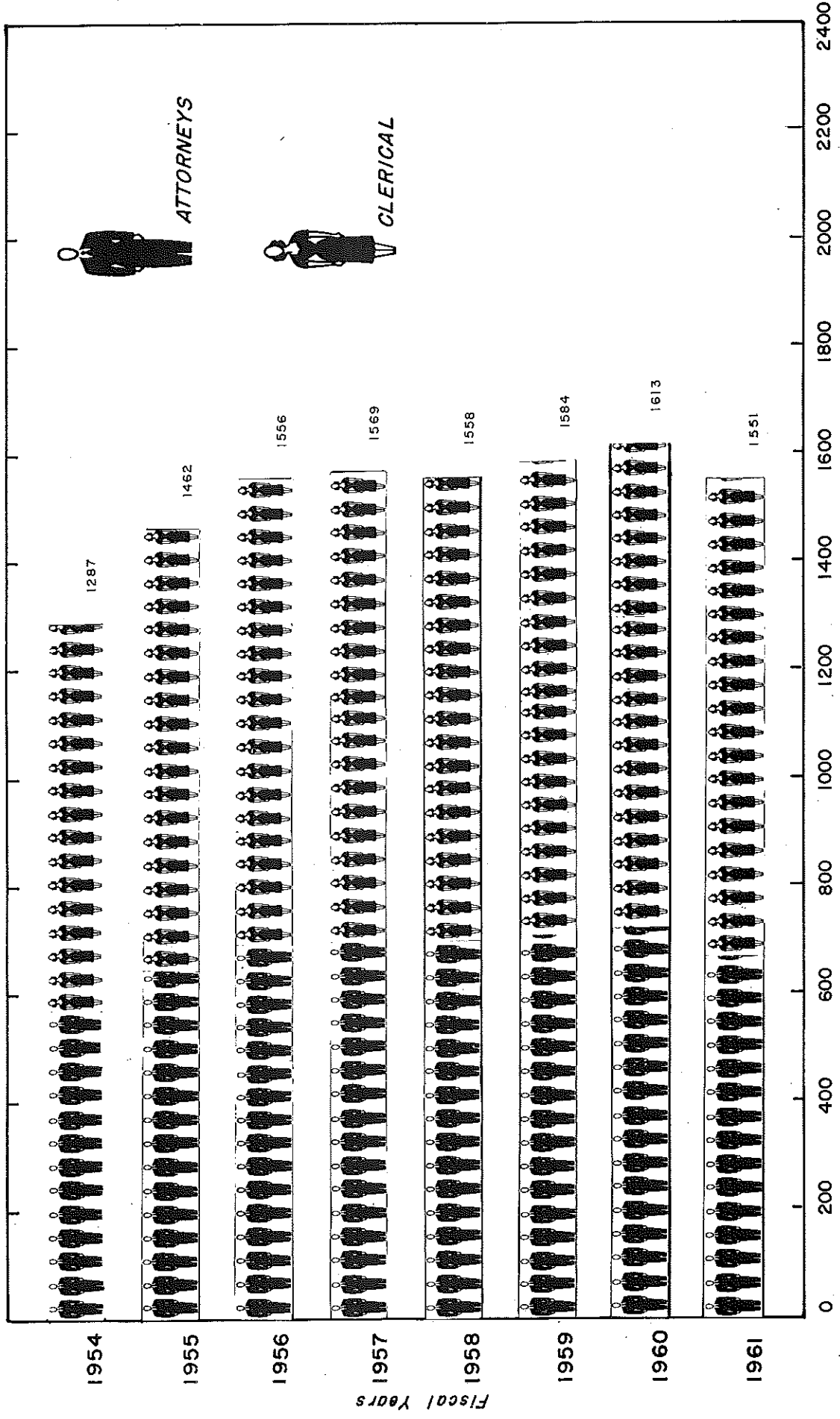
