WORK HANDLED BY UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES

DURING FISCAL YEAR 1971

CRIMINAL CASES

FILED - Criminal filings amounting to 45,880 showed an increase of 5855 or 14.6 per cent from the number filed in the previous fiscal year. About 80.0 per cent of the total was in 18 offenses having 700 or more cases; 15 showed increase while 3 showed a decrease. Increases occurred in Bank Robbery (1444 to 1891), Weapons Control (1275 to 1791), Selective Service (3900 to 4724), Postal Crimes (2492 to 3371), Narcotics (3078 to 5232), Income Tax (783 to 906), National Motor Vehicle Act dropped from 4454 to 2857. Increases took place in 56 districts ranging from 1 in Guam to 955 in the District of Columbia. Decreases took place in 37 districts ranging from 1 in Kansas to 382 in California Southern.

TERMINATED - Cases terminated increased 4892 or 13.2 per cent over the previous year's total. Of the total or 41,948 closed, 23,727 involving 28,329 defendants were pleas of guilty, 3823 (involving 5059 defendants) were found guilty after trial and 1379 (involving 1985 defendants) were found not guilty (including 66 not guilty verdicts by reason of insanity.)

PENDING - With 27,296 cases, the pending caseload showed an increase of 16.8 per cent over the 23,364* cases pending at the close of fiscal year 1970. Of the pending cases, 14,721 cases were awaiting arraignment in court or trial, while 1697 were awaiting sentence. 4453 are fugitives and 490 in other status beyond the control of the United States Attorney.

GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS

Grand Jury proceedings, comprised of 29,079 indictments and 220 No True Bills, amounted to 29,299 an increase of 17.6 per cent over the previous fiscal year.

CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS

RECEIVED - Complaints received increased to 158,824; this is 8.3 per cent more than the 146,602 received in fiscal year 1970. California Southern with 14,750 had the most complaints and California Central with 8,576 and Texas Southern with 5,746 were the next highest. 85,383 of the complaints were in eleven offenses as shown below:

PENDING - Criminal Complaints pending as of June 30, 1971 rose to 35,910 an increase of 2520 or 7.5 per cent over the 33,390 pending as of June 30, 1970.

CLOSED - 109,865 Complaints were closed during 1971 without reaching court dockets. Of this number 94,032 or 85.6 per cent of the total were closed by declination of prosecution.

CIVIL CASES

FILED - Civil Cases filed amounted to 30,349 an increase of 2315 or 8.2 per cent more than the previous year's total. 69 districts had increases and 23 districts showed decreases from the previous year. 11,657 or 38.4 per cent of the total was in fifteen districts having filings ranging from 607 to 1117. Tax Lien cases with 4,101, Tort cases with 1,989 and General Claims cases with 3,017 had 13.5, 6.5 and 9.9 per cent respectively of the cases filed.

TERMINATED - With 72 Districts showing increases and 19 districts with decreases, civil cases terminated increased to 28,942. This total is over fiscal year 1970 total by 4511 or 18.4 per cent.

3,963 of these cases were suits in which the government as defendant was sued for \$191,884,641. 757 of them involving \$58,613,098 were closed by compromises amounting to \$17,715,348 and 830 involving \$30,496,056 resulting in judgments against the government amounting to \$9,001,741. The remaining 2376 cases involving \$102,775,487 were won by the government, thus bringing the savings to \$165,167,552, an increase of \$21,684,839 or 14.8 per cent from the \$143,482,713 saved in Fiscal Year 1970.

PENDING - Civil cases pending as of the close of the fiscal year increased by 1407 or 4.9 per cent to 30,054. 11,596 or 38.5 per cent of the caseload was in twelve districts with caseloads ranging from 702 in Florida Southern to 1848 in New York Southern. Tax Lien cases with 4,752 increased to 15.8 per cent of the total as compared to 4,334 or 15.1 per cent of the total pending as of June 30, 1970. Land cases with 1,923 or 6.4 per cent increased from 1,838 or 6.4 per cent of the total.

CIVIL MATTERS

RECEIVED - Civil Matters received amounted to 33,903, an increase of 204 or .60 per cent more than the 33,699 in Fiscal Year 1970. Tax Lien matters with 4,132 and Tort matters with 2,010 comprised 12.2 per cent and 5.9 per cent respectively of the total. Delegated General Claims matters amounted to 4,021 or 16.2 per cent of the total. 10,839 or 31.9 per cent of the total was in ten districts having totals ranging from 829 in Georgia Northern to 1271 in California Northern.

TERMINATED - Civil matters terminated without reaching court dockets amounted to 5,245 an increase of 11.1 or 523 from the fiscal year 1970 total of 4,722.

PENDING - 11,396 civil matters were pending as of June 30, 1971 as compared to 10,679 as of June 30, 1970. This is an increase of 717 or 6.7 per cent.

MAN-HOURS

A total of 309,569 man-hours were spent in court during Fiscal Year 1971. This is an increase of 69,968, or 29.2 per cent over Fiscal Year 1970. Following is a breakdown of those hours:

Based on an average employment of 886.6 each Assistant United States Attorney averaged 34.9 hours per month in courtroom work during the fiscal year. This compares with an averaged 29.6 hours per month in Fiscal Year 1970.

COLLECTIONS

Collections for Fiscal Year 1971 amounted to \$94,847,902, an increase of \$36,771,748 or 63.3 per cent more than the \$58,076,239 collected in Fiscal Year 1970.

PERSONNEL

During the year United States Attorneys' employment averaged 2,122 employees, and 2,419 were on the rolls as of June 30, 1971. Cases handled per Assistant United States Attorney increased from 139.8 in Fiscal Year 1970 to 144.6 in the current year while cases terminated increased from 73.9 to 79.9

Cases Pending in United States Attorneys' Offices

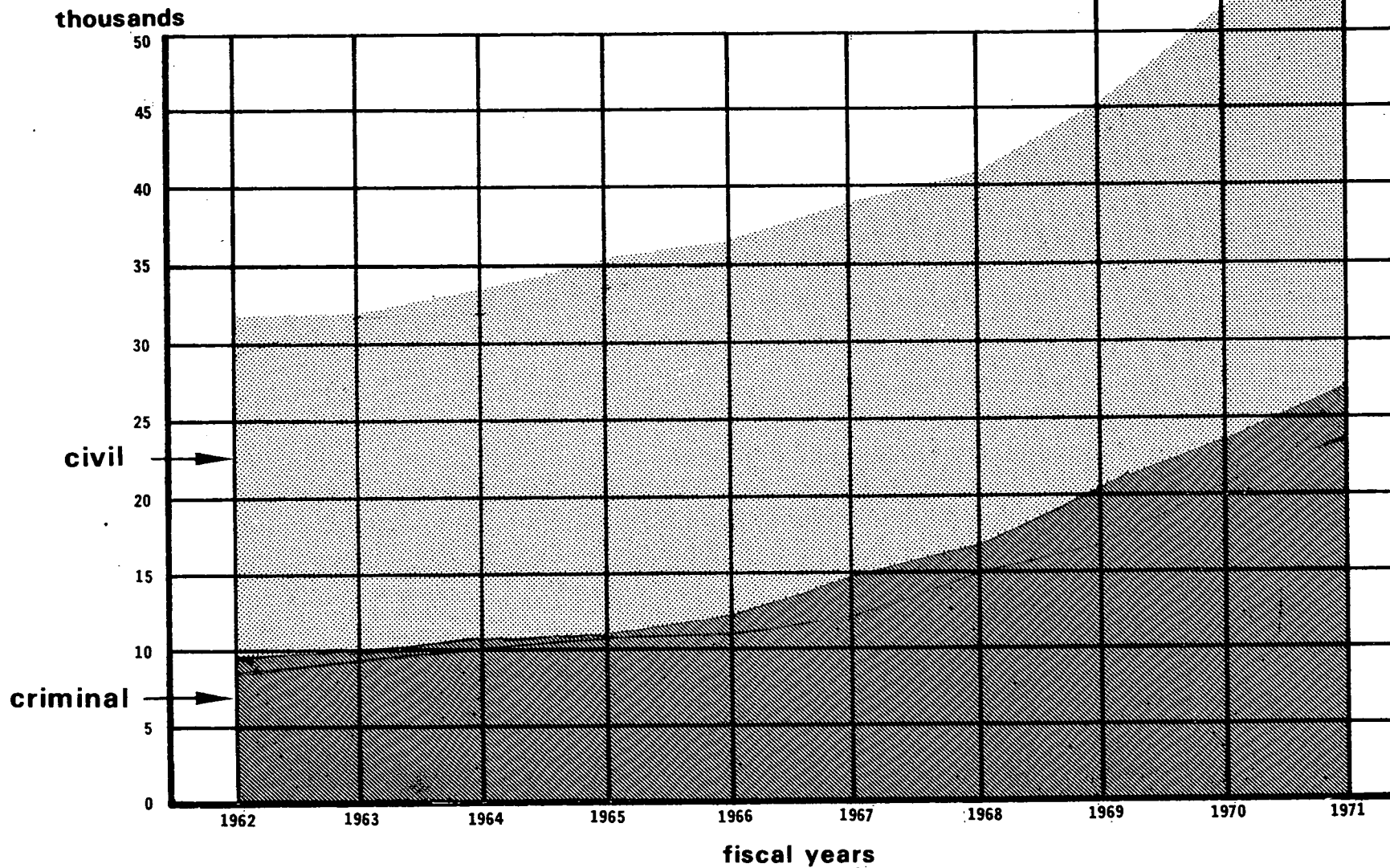

Criminal and Civil Cases Filed in United States Attorneys' Offices

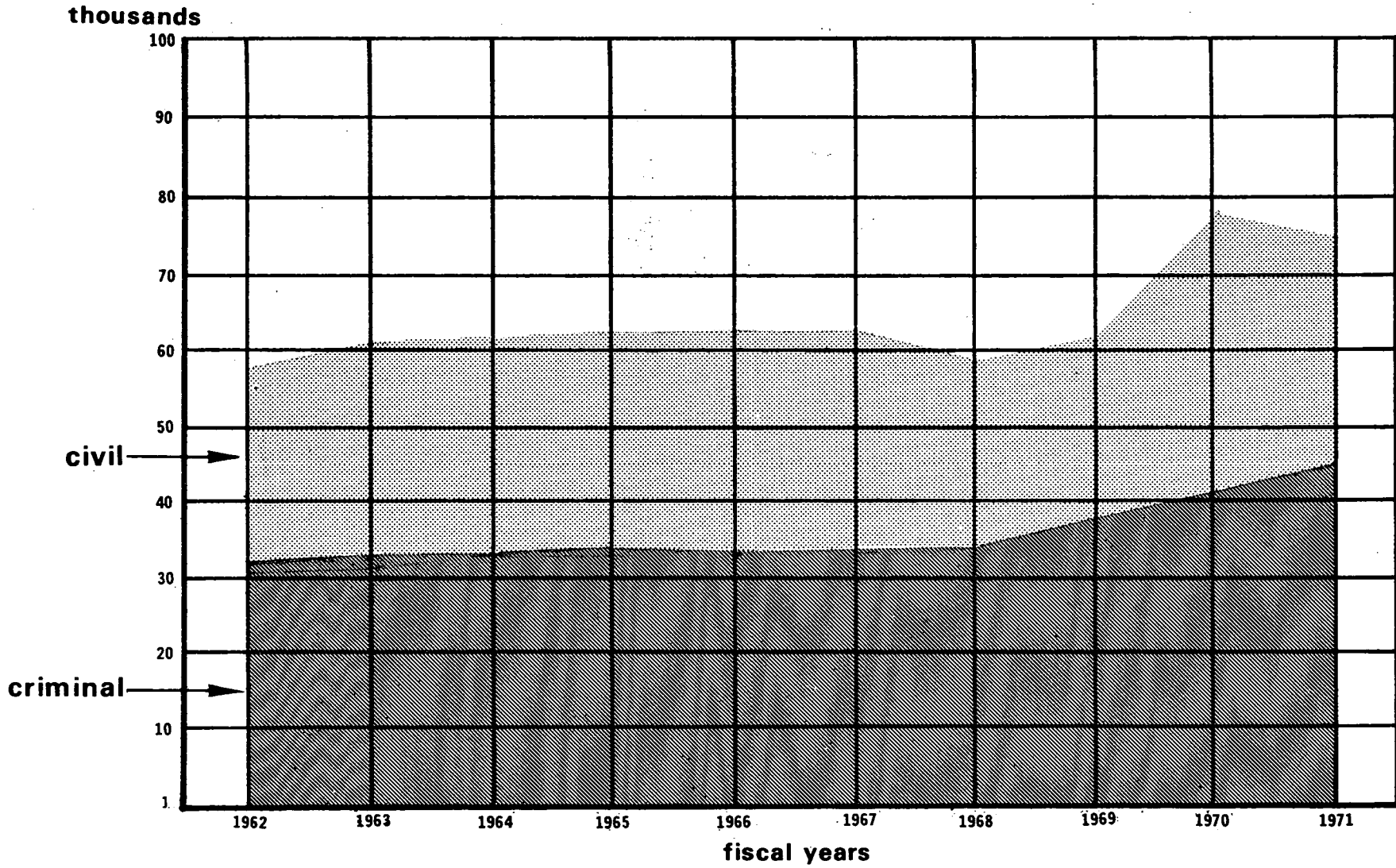

Criminal and Civil Cases Terminated in United States Attorneys' Offices

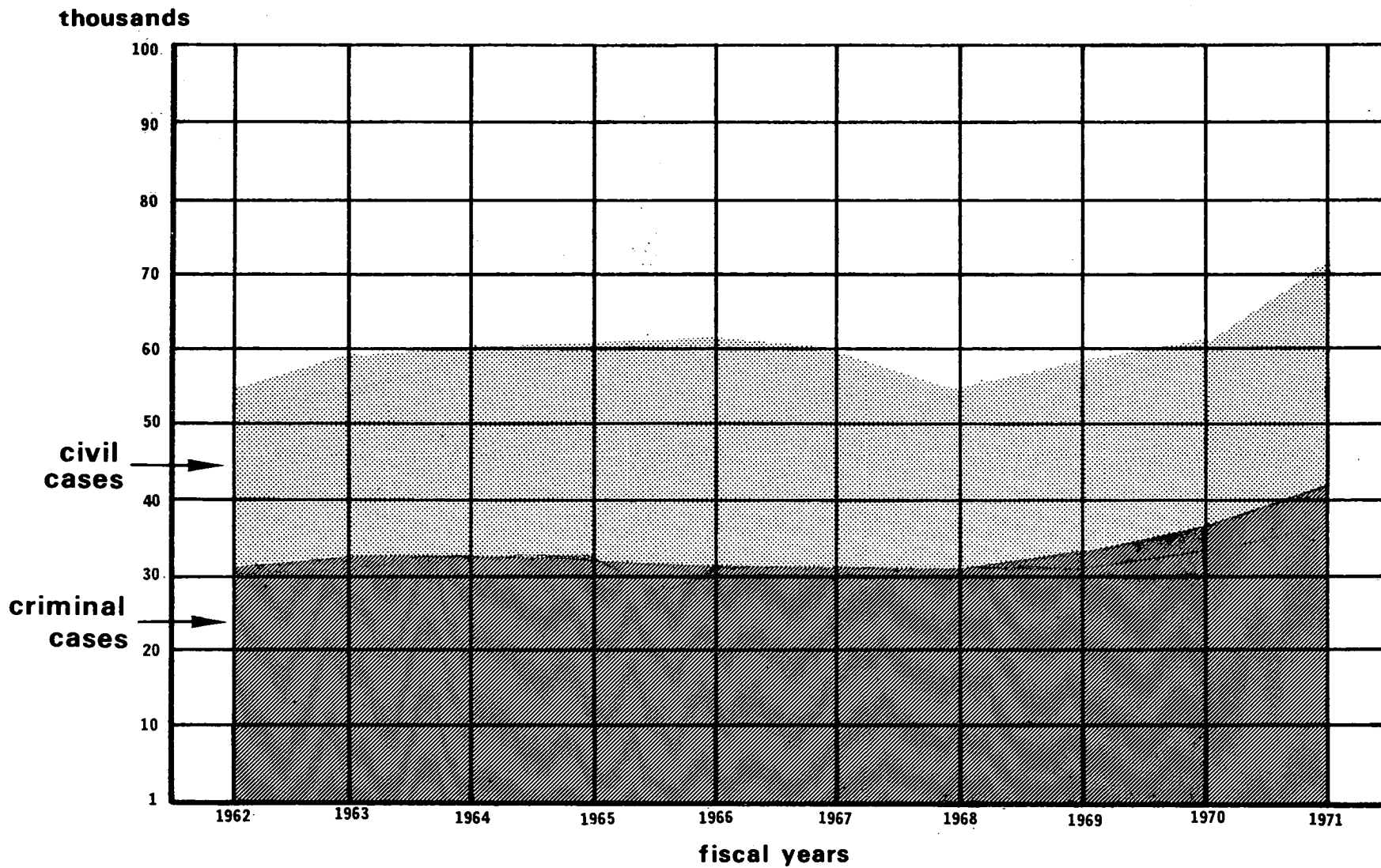

Criminal and Civil Matters Received in United States Attorneys' Offices

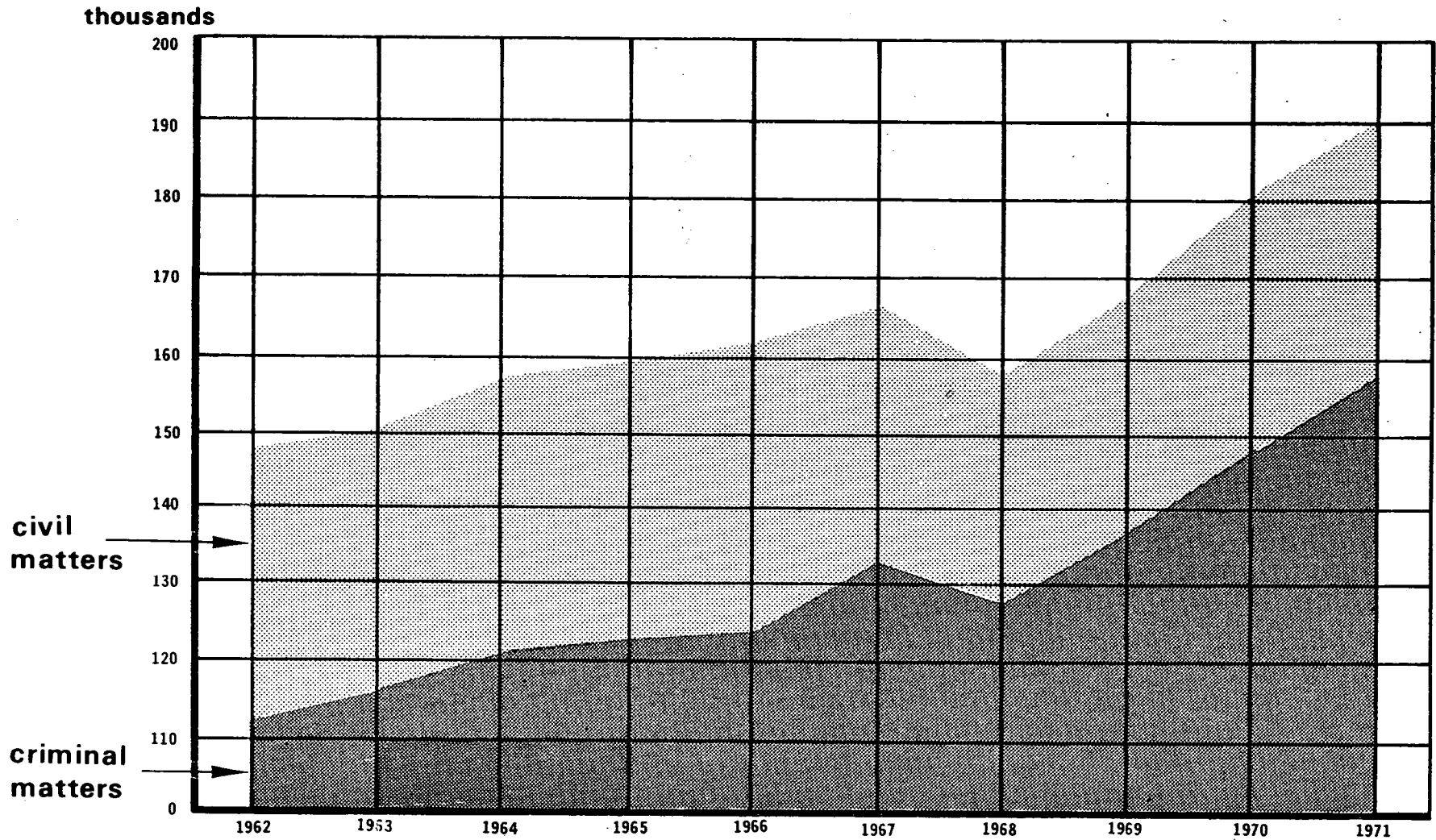

Trials in Criminal and Civil Cases in United States Attorneys' Offices

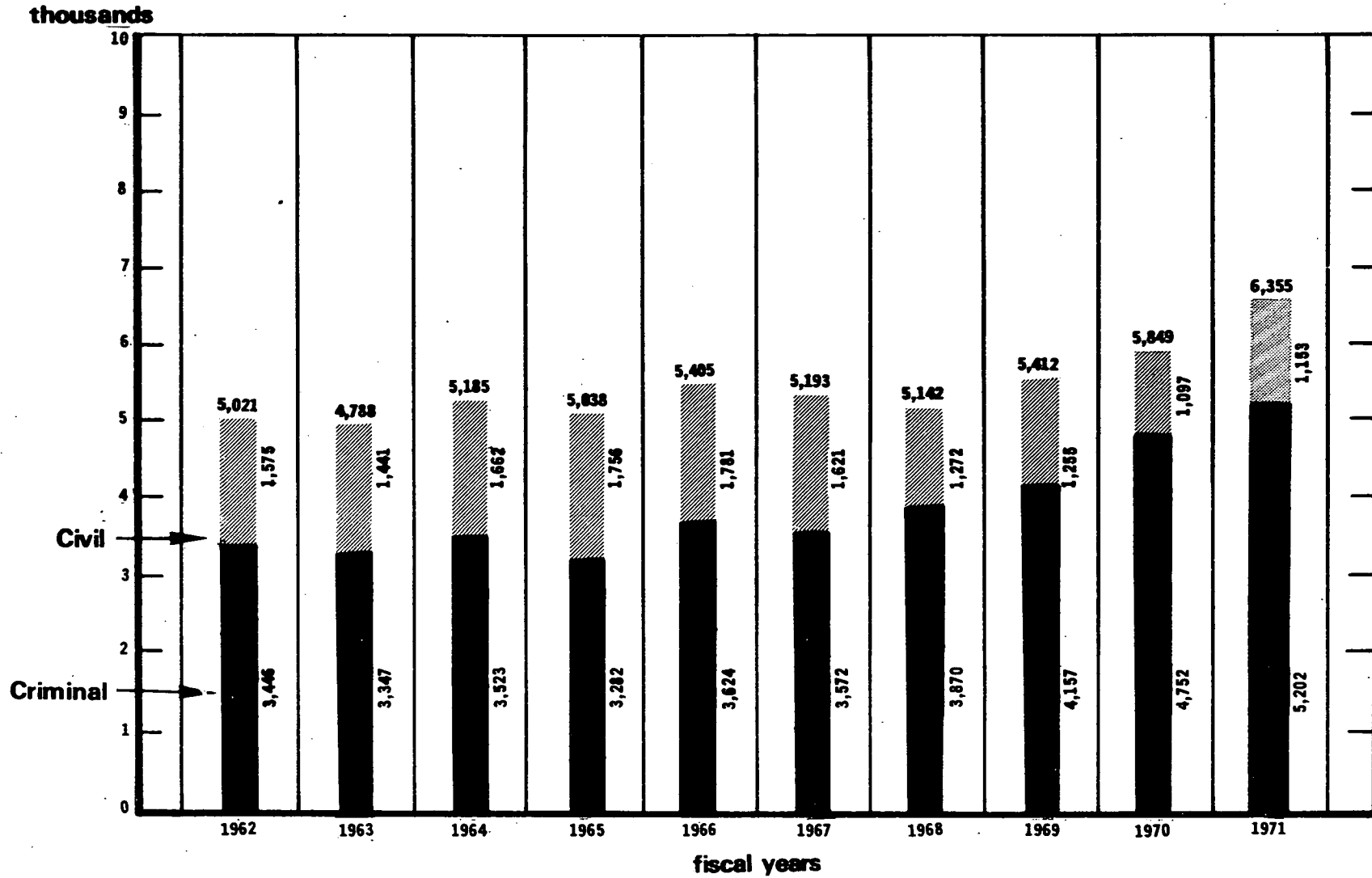

Total 27,296 Cases**

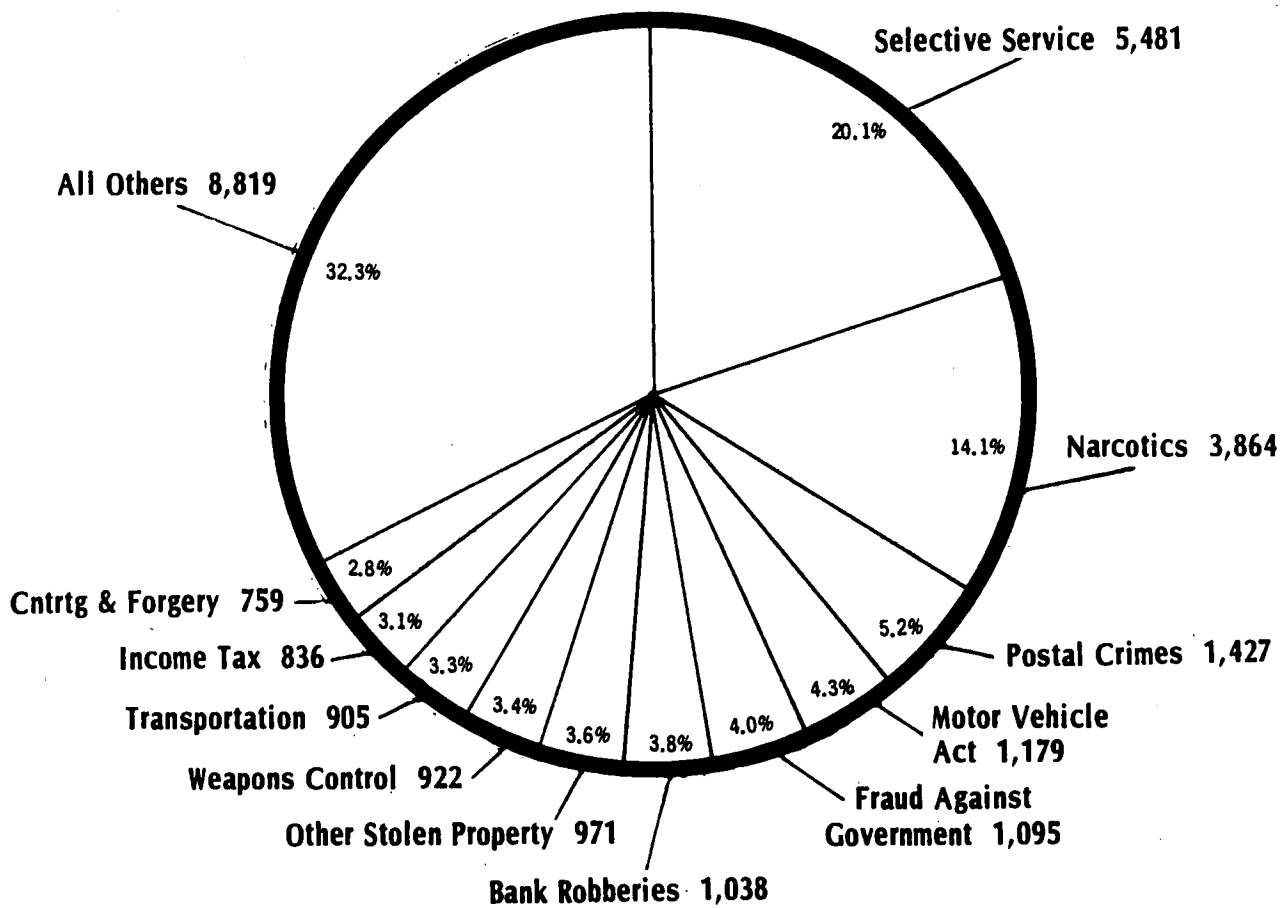

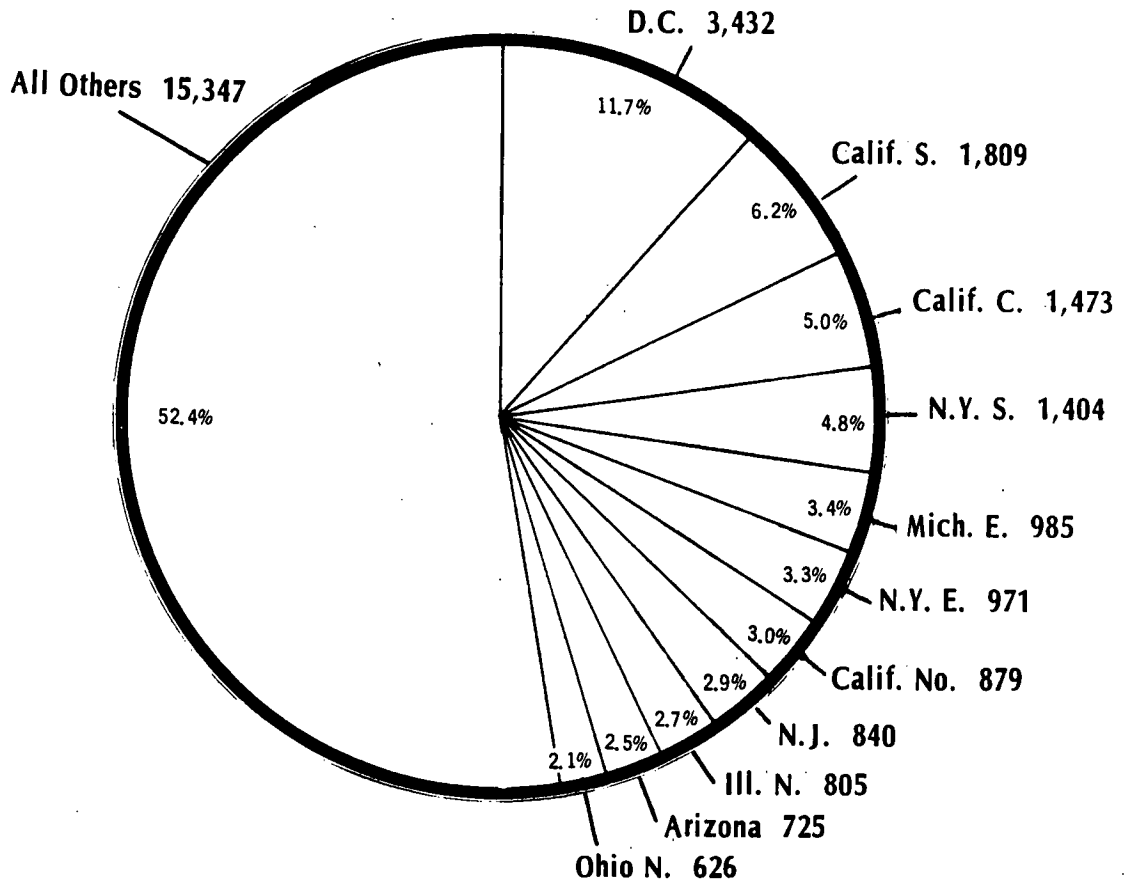
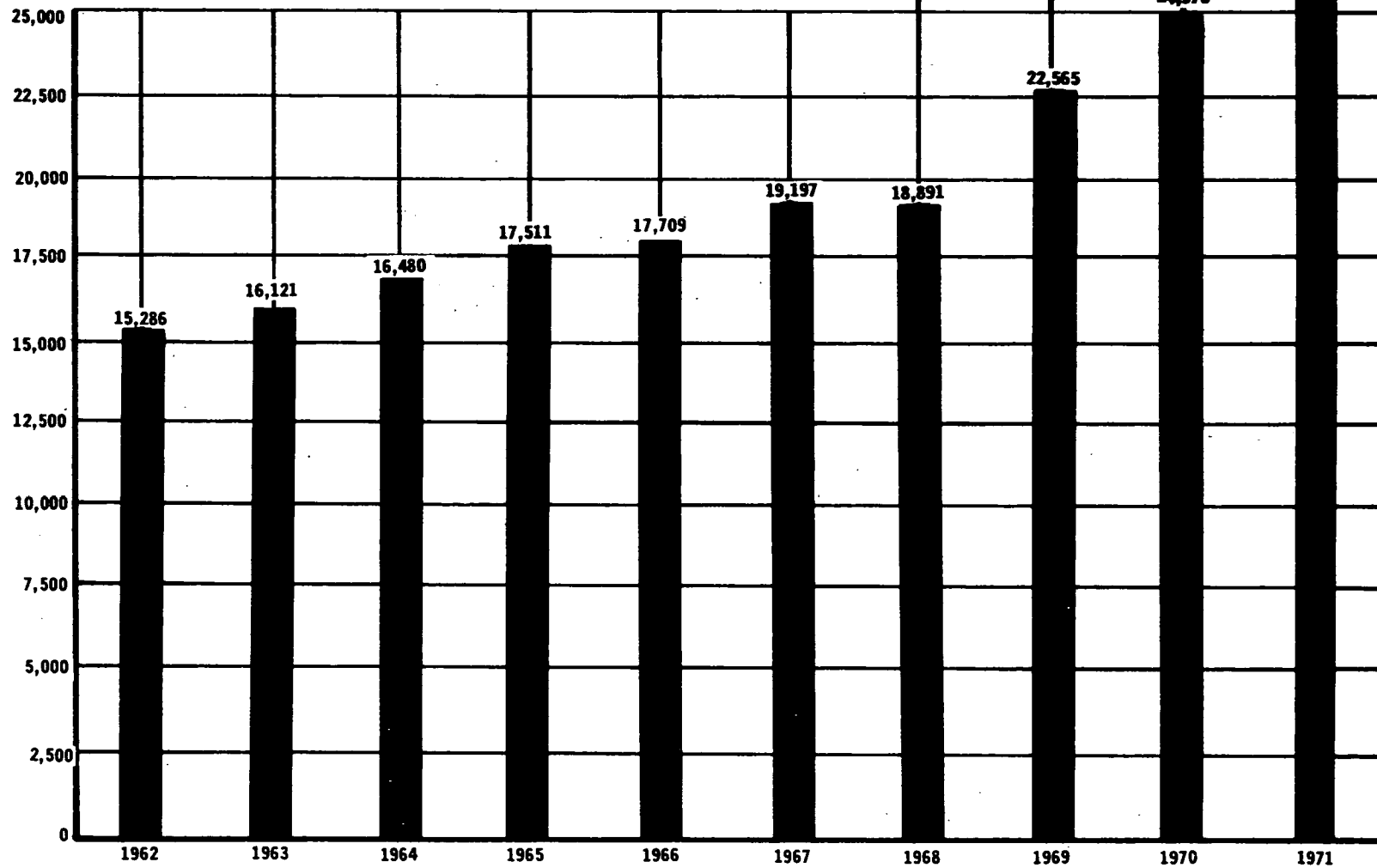

Total Cases Criminal 27,296 Civil 28,131

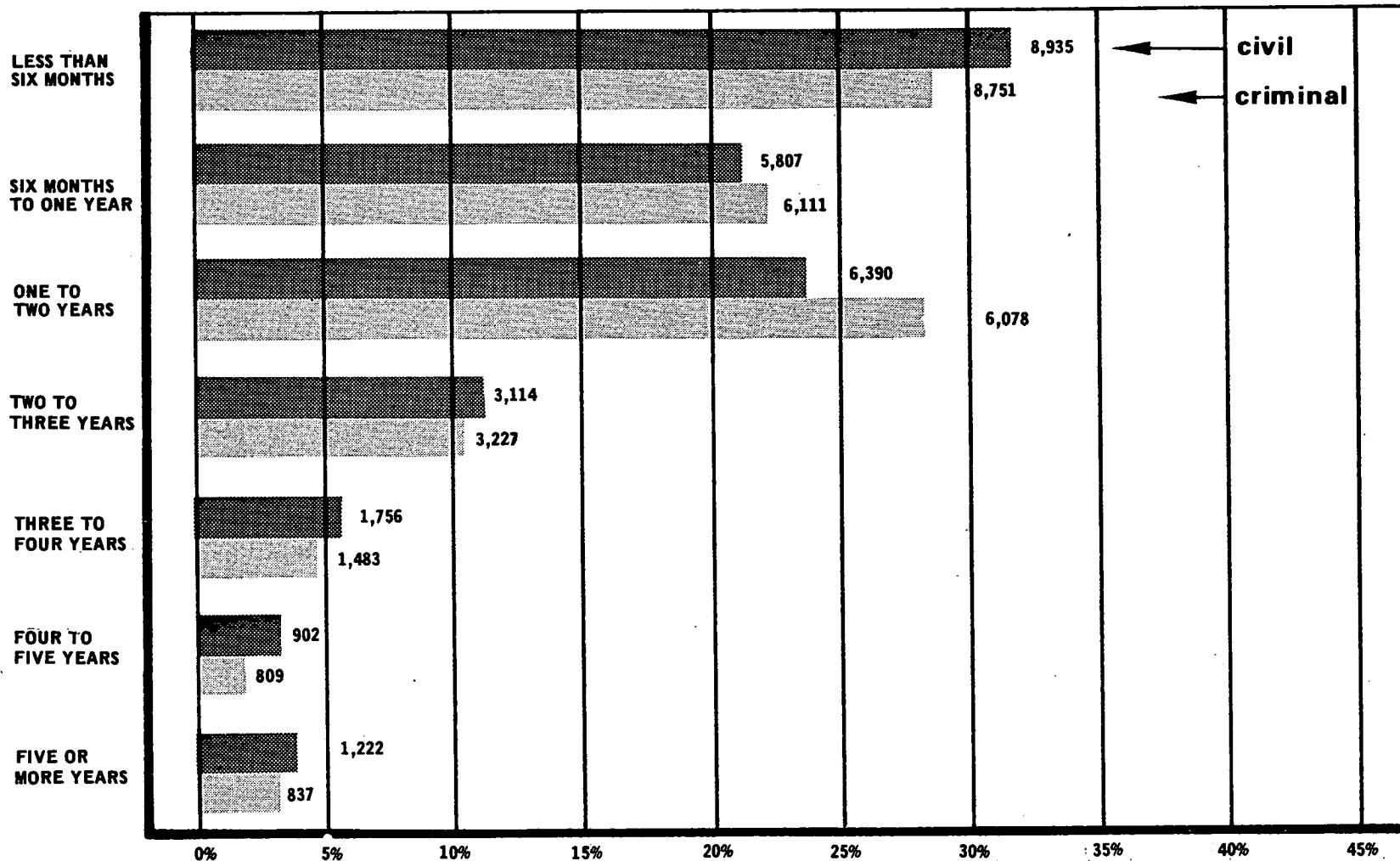

Total 30,054 Cases**

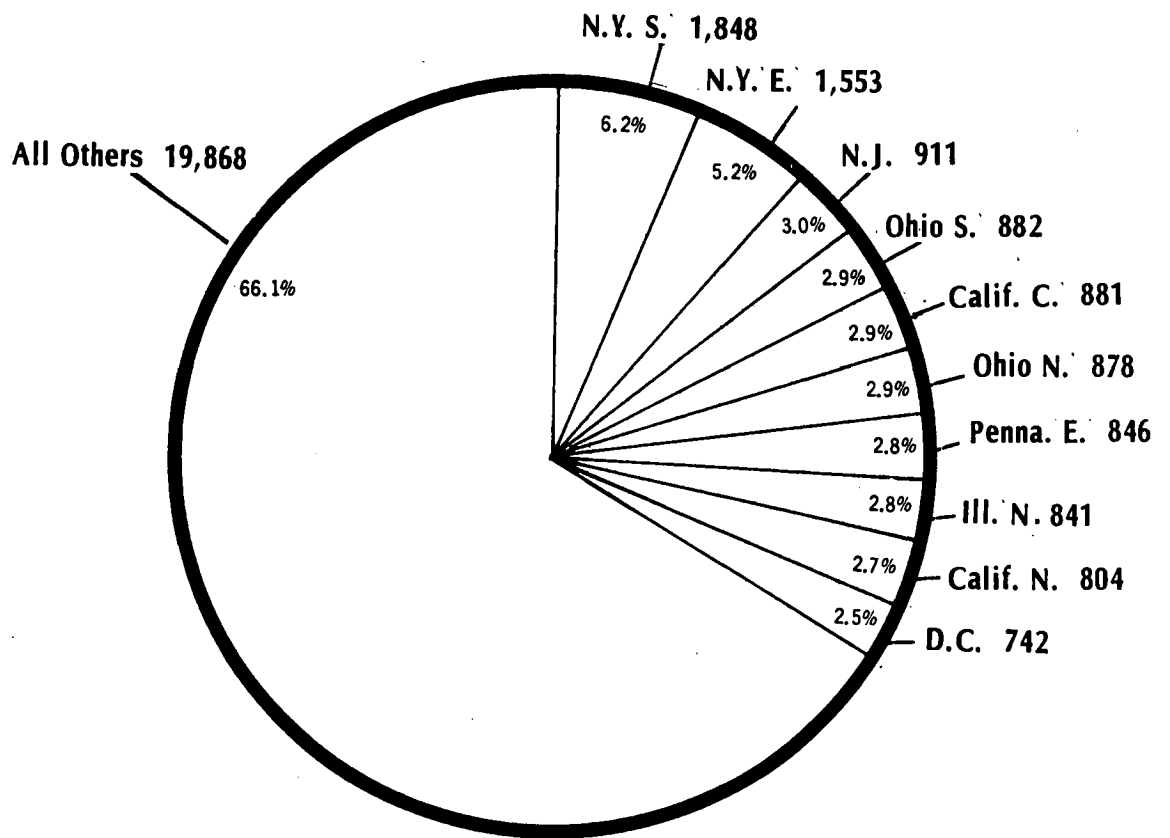

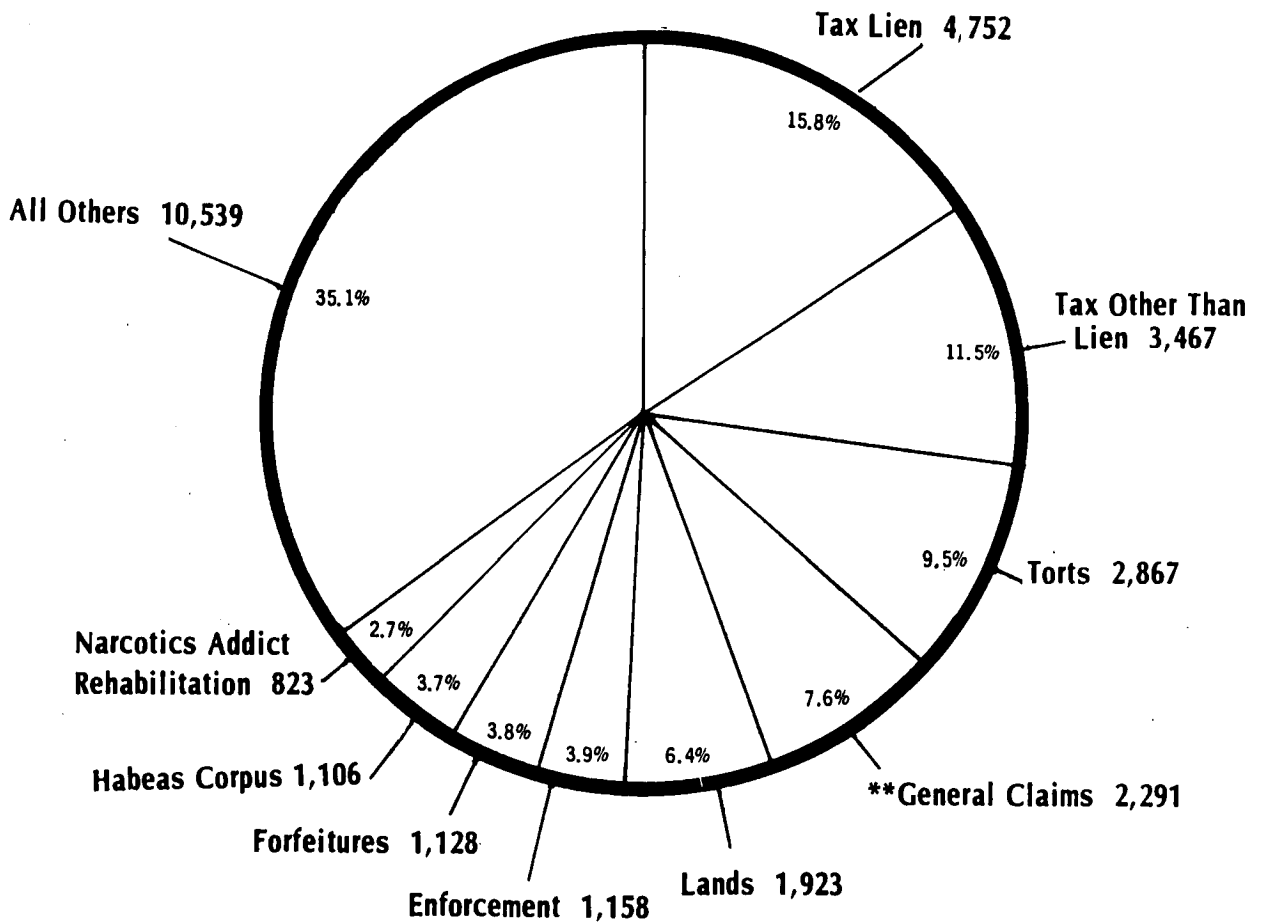

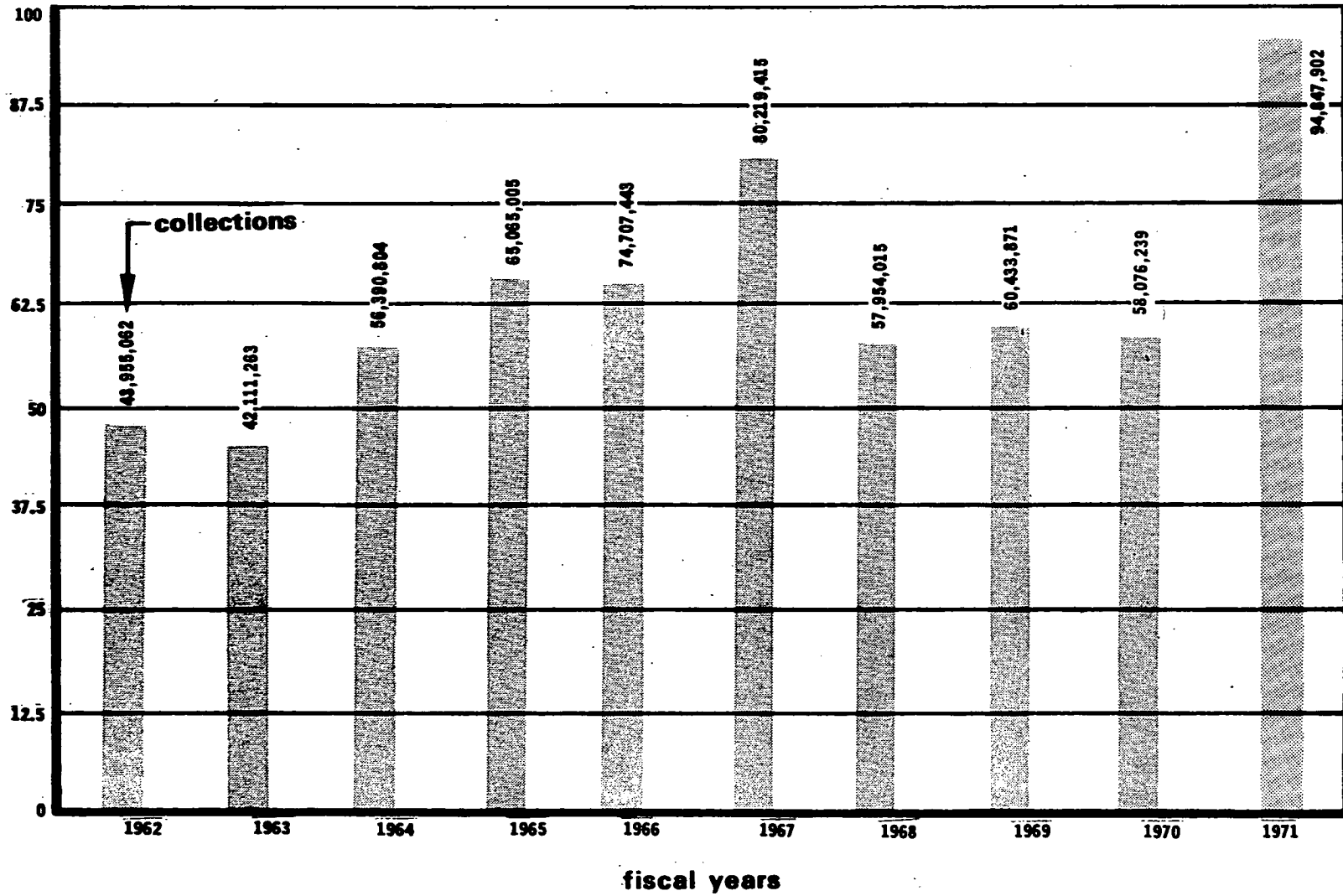
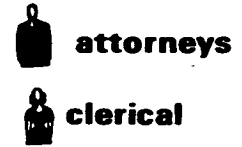
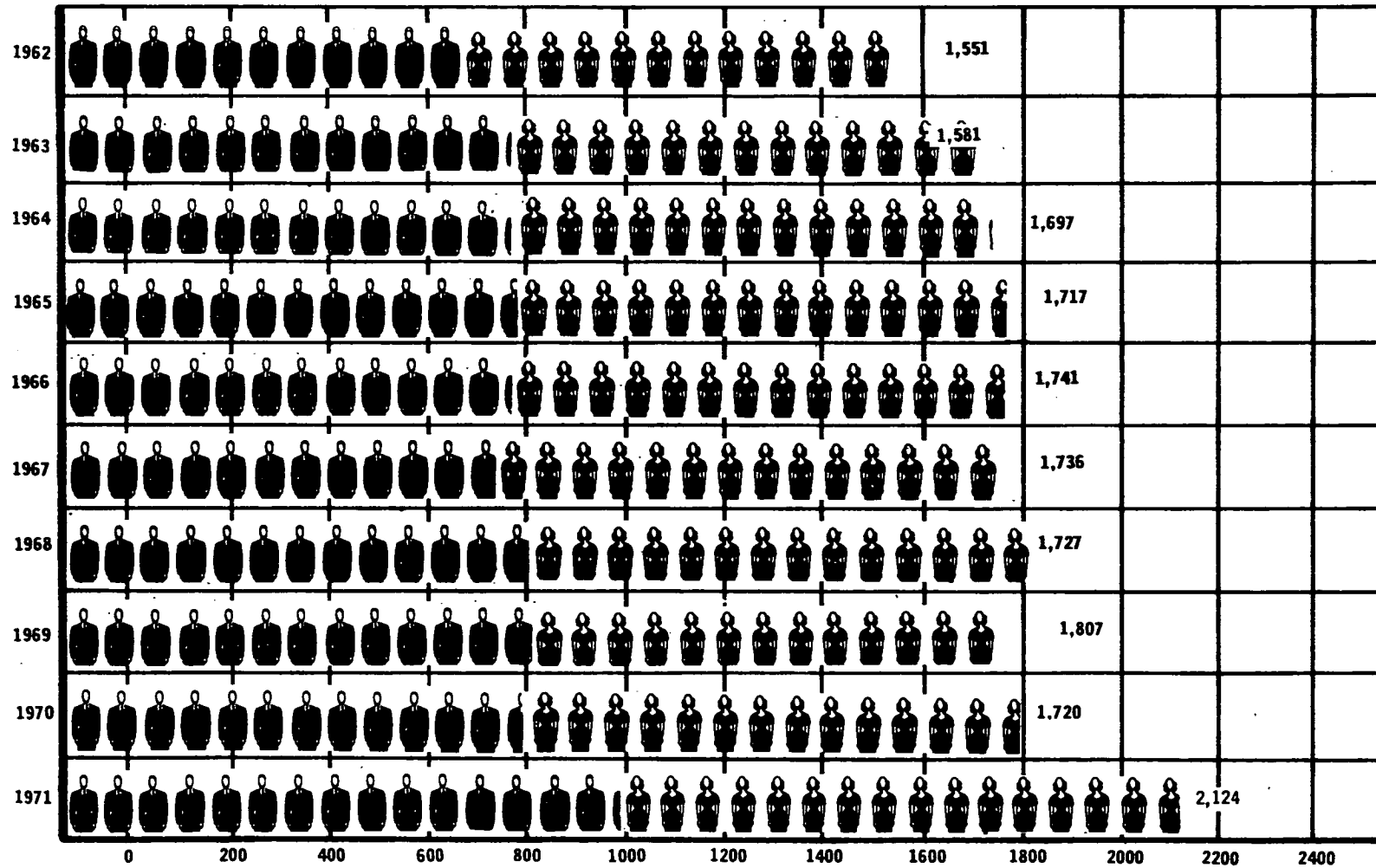
