WORK HANDLED BY UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES  
DURING FISCAL YEAR 1975

CRIMINAL CASES

FILED - Criminal filings amounting to 46,951 showed an increase of 3,632 or 8.38 percent from the number filed in the previous fiscal year. 80.59 percent of the total was in 17 offenses having 800 or more cases; 13 showed increases while 4 showed decreases. Increases occurred in Weapons Control (2,818 to 3,042), Stolen Property (1,710 to 1,892), Bank Robbery (2,028 to 2,744), Frauds vs/ Government (2,790 to 3,077), Postal Crimes (3,243 to 3,705), while Narcotics (8,567 to 8,323), Selective Service (1,437 to 426), and National Motor Vehicle Act (2,078 to 1,845), showed decreases. Increases took place in 63 districts ranging from 5 in Kentucky Western and Texas Northern to 658 in Missouri Western. Decreases took place in 30 districts ranging from 2 in Wisconsin Western to 350 in Texas Southern.

TERMINATED - Cases terminated increases 2,212 or 4.99 percent more than the previous year's total. Of the total or 46,467 closed, 26,880 involving 33,572 defendants were pleas of guilty, 4,098 (involving 5,709 defendants) were found guilty after trial and 1,082 (involving 1,832 defendants) were found not guilty (including 12 not guilty verdicts by reason of insanity).

PENDING - With 27,898 cases, the pending caseload showed an increase of 1.76 percent over the 27,414\* cases pending at the close of fiscal

year 1974. Of the pending cases, 12,445 cases were awaiting arraignment in court or trial, while 1,874 were awaiting sentence. 7,482 are fugitives and 364 in other status beyond the control of the United States Attorneys.

#### GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS

Grand Jury proceedings, comprised of 27,067 indictments and 155 No True Bills, amounted to 27,222 an increase of 5.56 percent more than the previous fiscal year.

#### CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS

RECEIVED - Complaints received increased to 174,173; this is 1.93 percent more than the 170,865 received in fiscal year 1974. California Southern with 20,426 had the most complaints and California Central with 6,792 and Illinois Northern with 4,902 were the next highest. 86,997 of the complaints were in eleven offenses as shown below:

PENDING - Criminal Complaints pending as of June 30, 1975 rose to 31,613 an increase of 3,491 or 12.41 percent more than the 28,122 pending as of June 30, 1974.

CLOSED - 124,524 Complaints were closed during 1975 without reaching court dockets. Of this number 105,737 or 84.91 percent of the total were closed by declination of prosecution.

#### CIVIL CASES

FILED - Civil Cases filed amounted to 41,341 an increase of 8,274 or 25.02 percent more than the previous year's total. 78 districts had increases and 16 districts showed decreases from the previous year. 16,860 or 40.78 percent of the total was in fifteen districts having filings ranging from 752 to 1,487, Tax Lien cases with 5,743, Tort cases with 2,908 and General Claims cases with 3,450 had 13.89, 7.03 and 8.35 percent respectively of the cases filed.

TERMINATED - With 64 districts showing increases and 30 districts with decreases, civil cases terminated increased to 33,073. This total is over fiscal year 1974 total by 2,075 or 6.69 percent.

5,703 of these cases were suits in which the Government as defendant was sued for \$393,303,131. 676 of them involving \$158,451,846 were closed by compromise amounting to \$20,982,972 and 1,073 involving \$55,010,764 resulting in judgments against the Government amounting to \$16,033,344. The remaining

3,954 cases involving \$179,840,521 were won by the Government, thus bringing the savings to \$356,286,815 an increase of \$248,033,305 or 229.12 percent from the \$108,253,510 saved in Fiscal Year 1974.

PENDING - Civil cases pending as of the close of the fiscal year increased by 8,268 or 23.08 percent to 44,087. 18,670 or 42.35 percent of the caseload was in fourteen districts with caseloads ranging from 826 in Florida Southern to 2,619 in New York Eastern. Tax Lien cases with 7,437 increased to 16.87 percent of the total as compared to 6,011 or 16.66 percent of the total pending as of June 30, 1974. Land cases with 2,026 or 4.60 percent increased from 1,915 or 5.31 percent of the total.

#### CIVIL MATTERS

RECEIVED - Civil Matters received amounted to 45,268 an increase of 4,272 or 10.42 percent more than the 40,996 in Fiscal Year 1974. Tax Lien matters with 5,772 and Tort matters with 3,001 comprised 12.75 percent and 6.63 percent respectively of the total. Delegated General Claims matters amounted to 4,073 or 9.00 percent of the total. 15,456 or 34.14 percent of the total was in twelve districts having totals ranging from 1,024 in Florida Middle to 1,420 in New York Eastern.

TERMINATED - Civil matters terminated without reaching court dockets amounted to 5,244 an increase of 185 or 3.66 percent more than the fiscal year 1974 total of 5,059.

PENDING - 9,525 civil matters were pending as of June 30, 1975 as compared to 10,842 as of June 30, 1974. This is a decrease of 1,317 or 12.15 percent.



MAN-HOURS

A total of 536,493 man-hours were spent in court during Fiscal Year 1975. This is an increase of 72,369 or 15.59 percent over Fiscal Year 1974. Following is a breakdown of those hours.

Based on an average employment of 1,458 each Assistant United States Attorney averaged 36.80 hours per month in courtroom work during the fiscal year. This compares with an averaged 36.92 hours per month in Fiscal Year 1974.

COLLECTIONS

Collections for Fiscal Year 1975 amounted to \$198,180,168, an increase of \$40,373,240 or 25.58 percent more than the \$157,806,928 collected in Fiscal Year 1974.

PERSONNEL

During the year United States Attorneys' employment averaged 3,049 employees and 3,155 were on the rolls as of June 30, 1975. Cases handled per Assistant United States Attorney decreased from 110.5 in Fiscal Year 1974 to 103.9 in the current year while cases terminated decreased from 59.8 to 54.5.

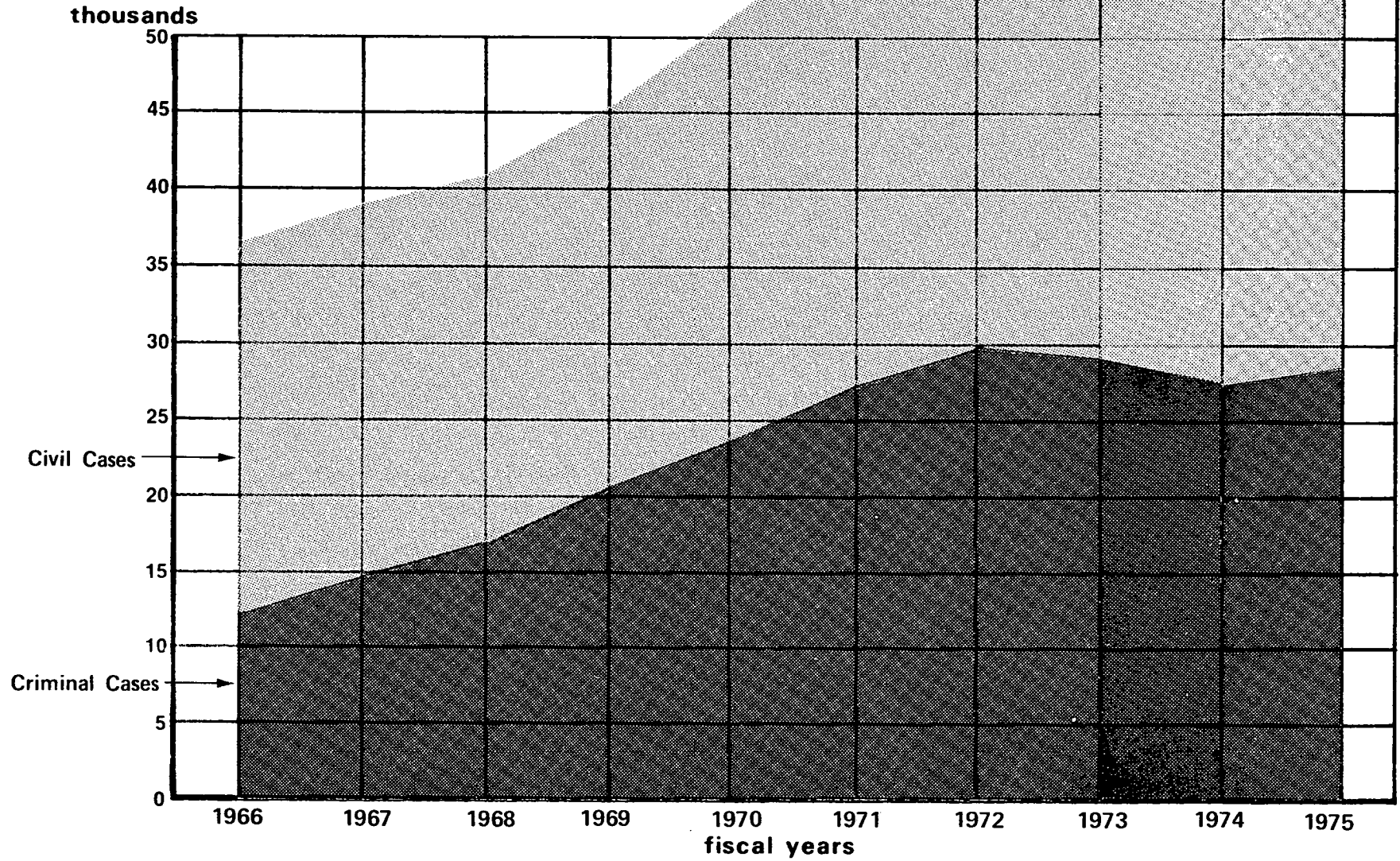
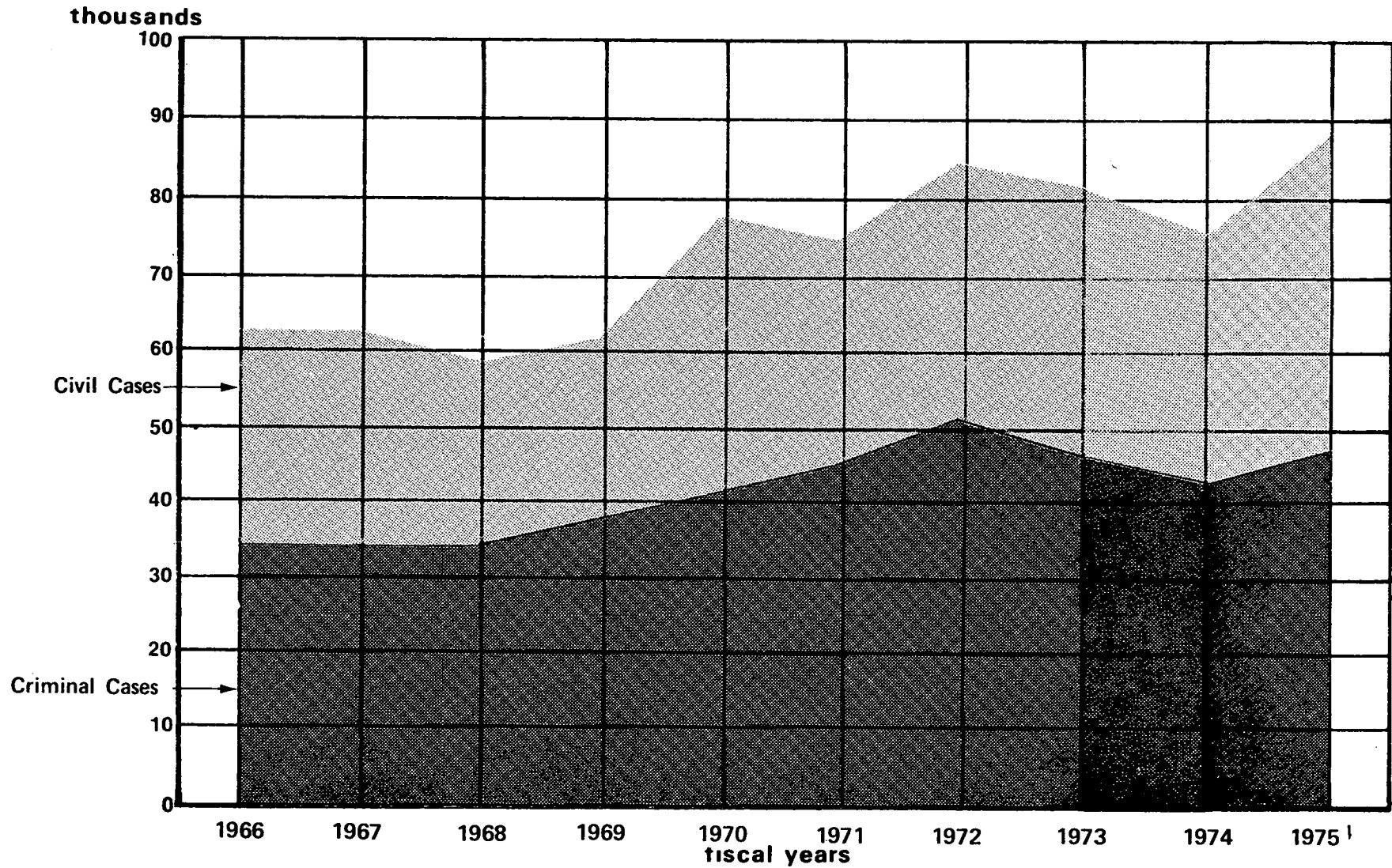

# Criminal and Civil Cases Terminated in United States Attorneys' Offices

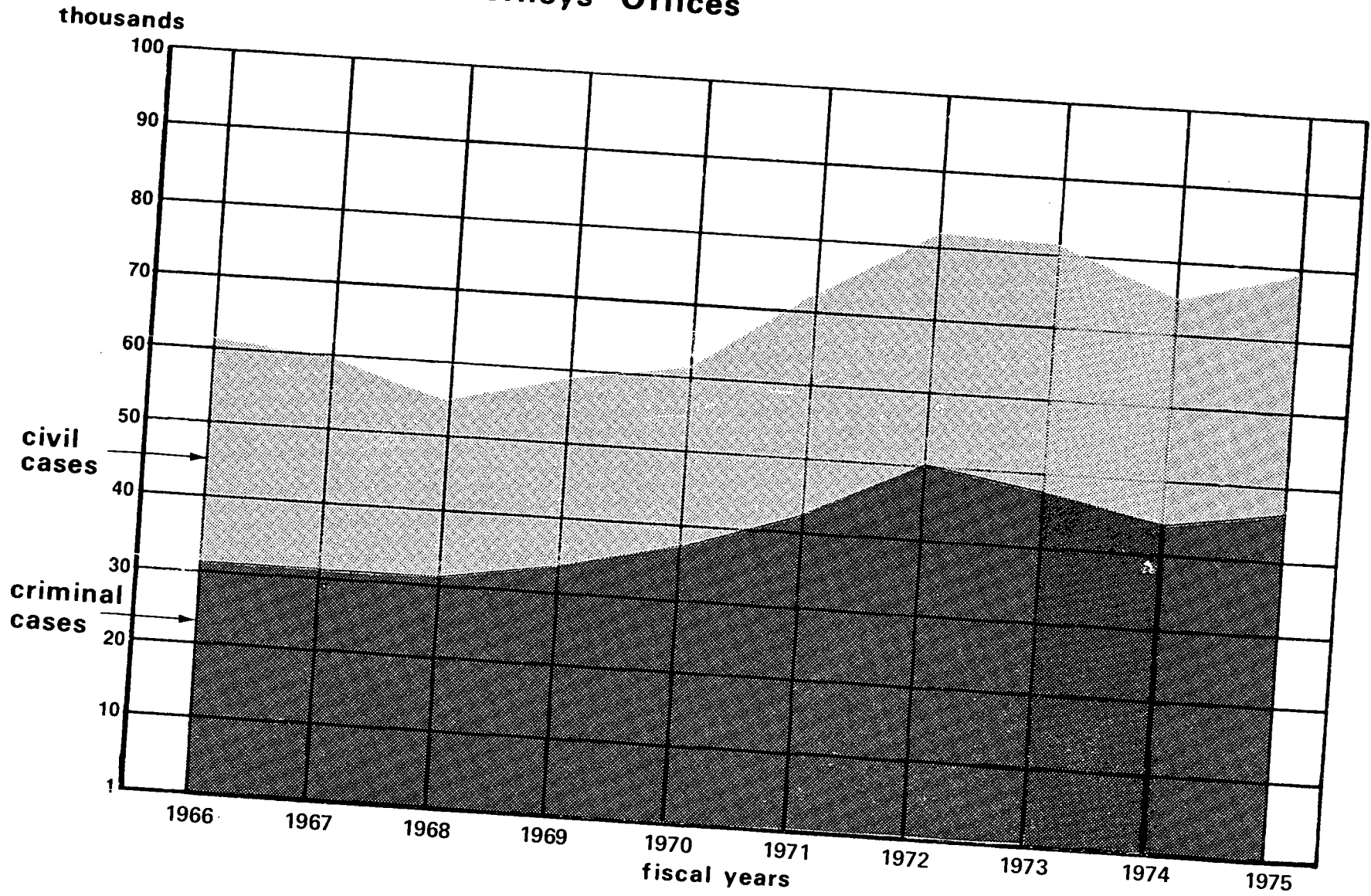

### Criminal and Civil Matters Received in United States Attorneys' Offices

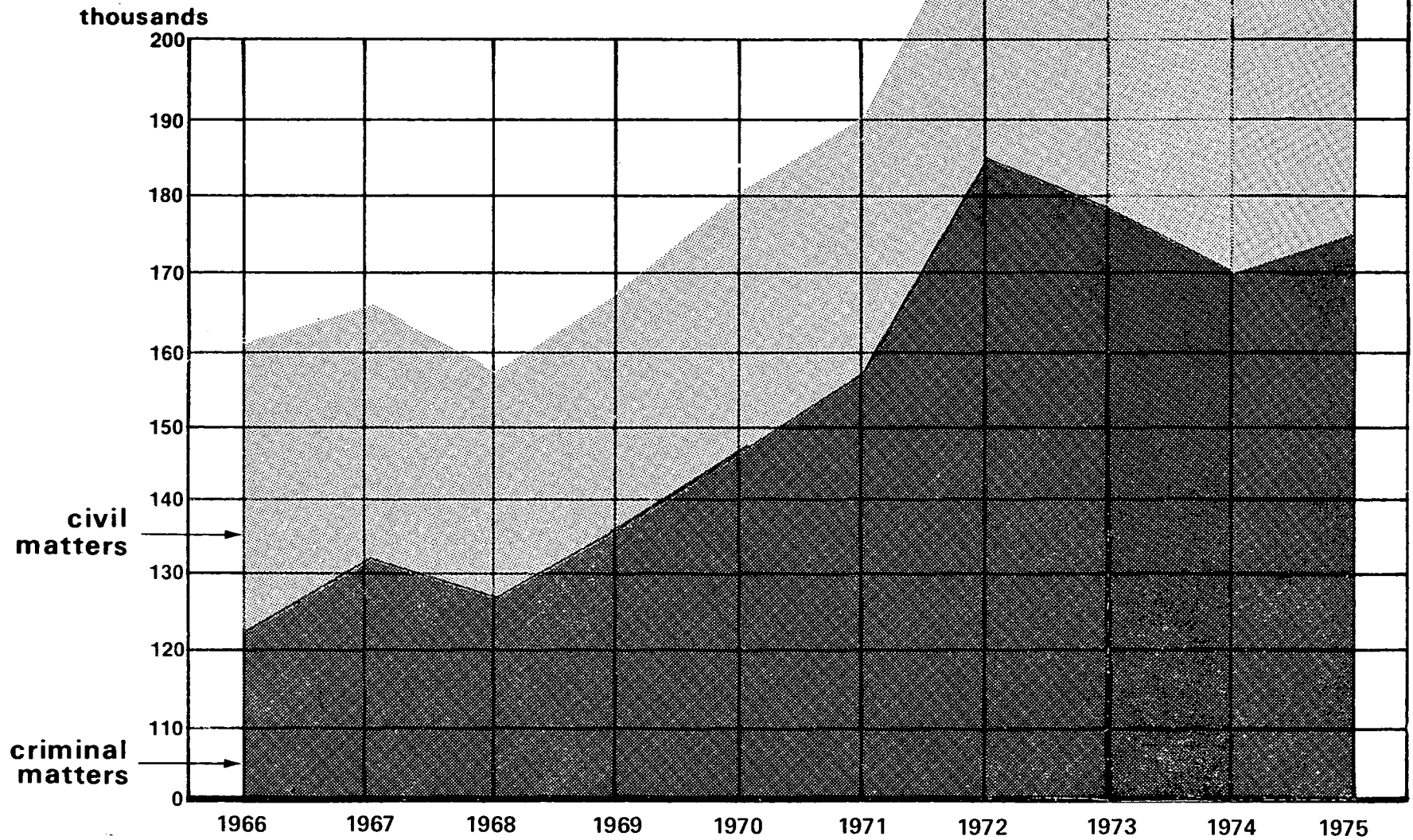

# Trials in Criminal and Civil Cases in United States Attorneys' Offices

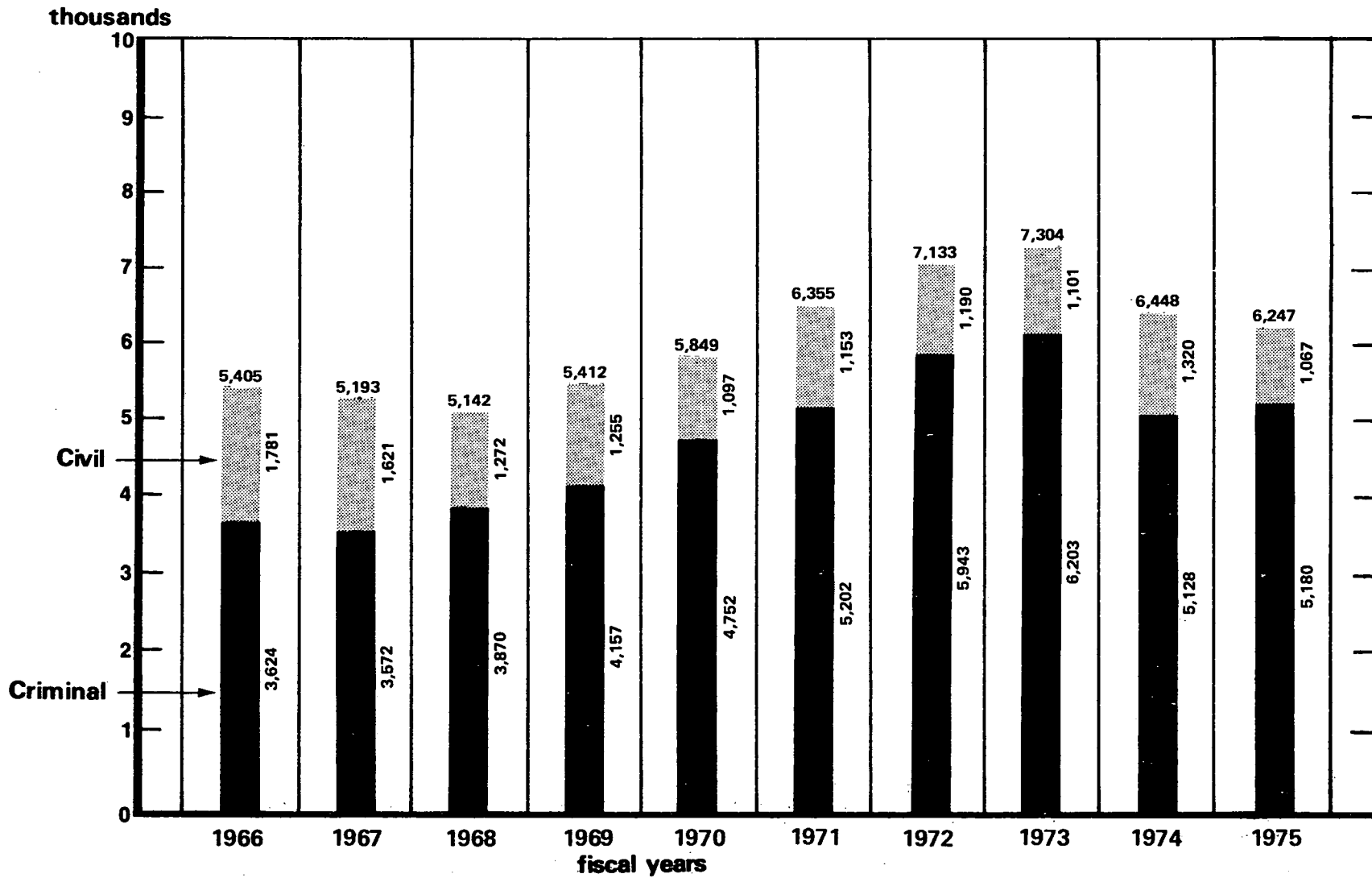

Total 27,898 Cases**

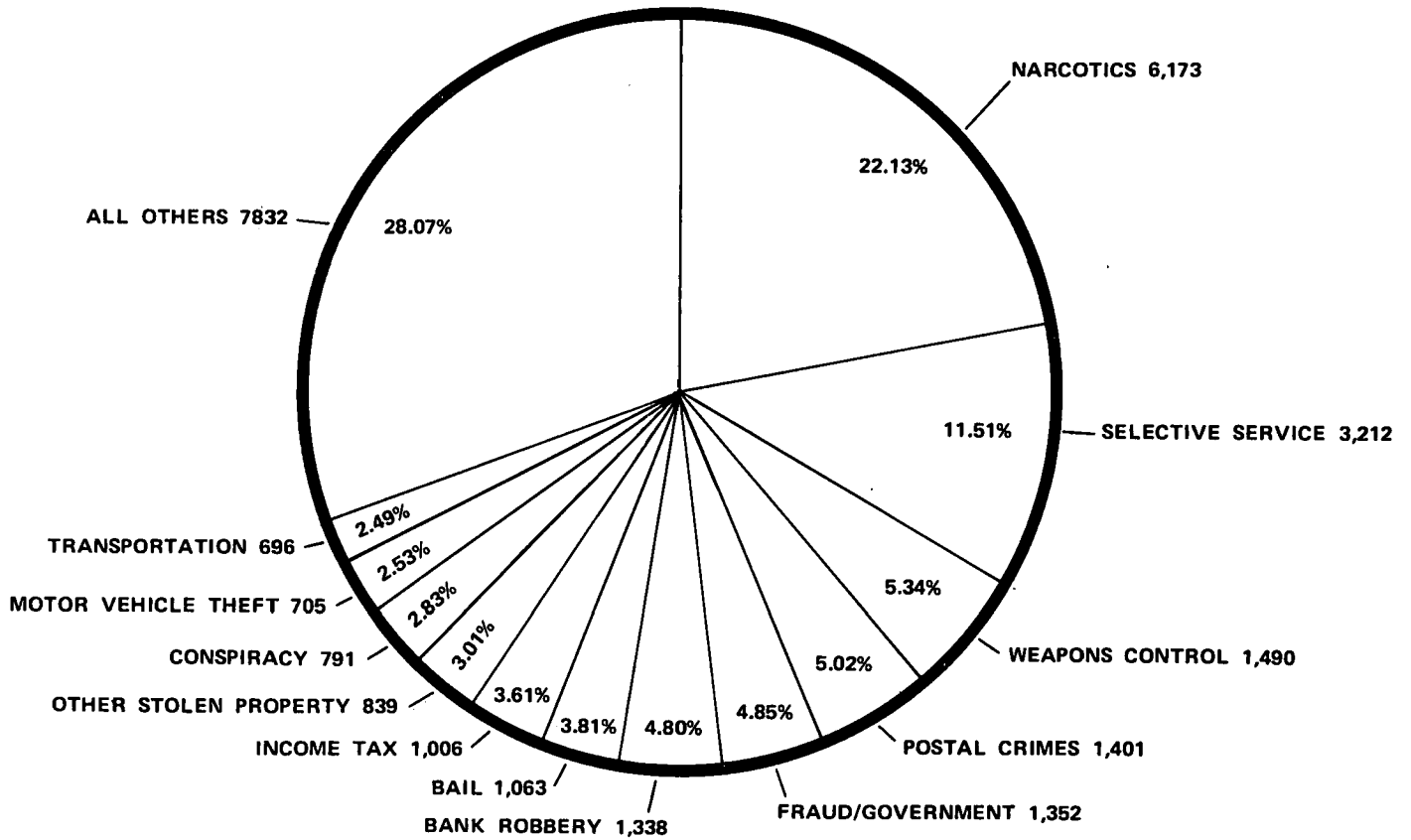

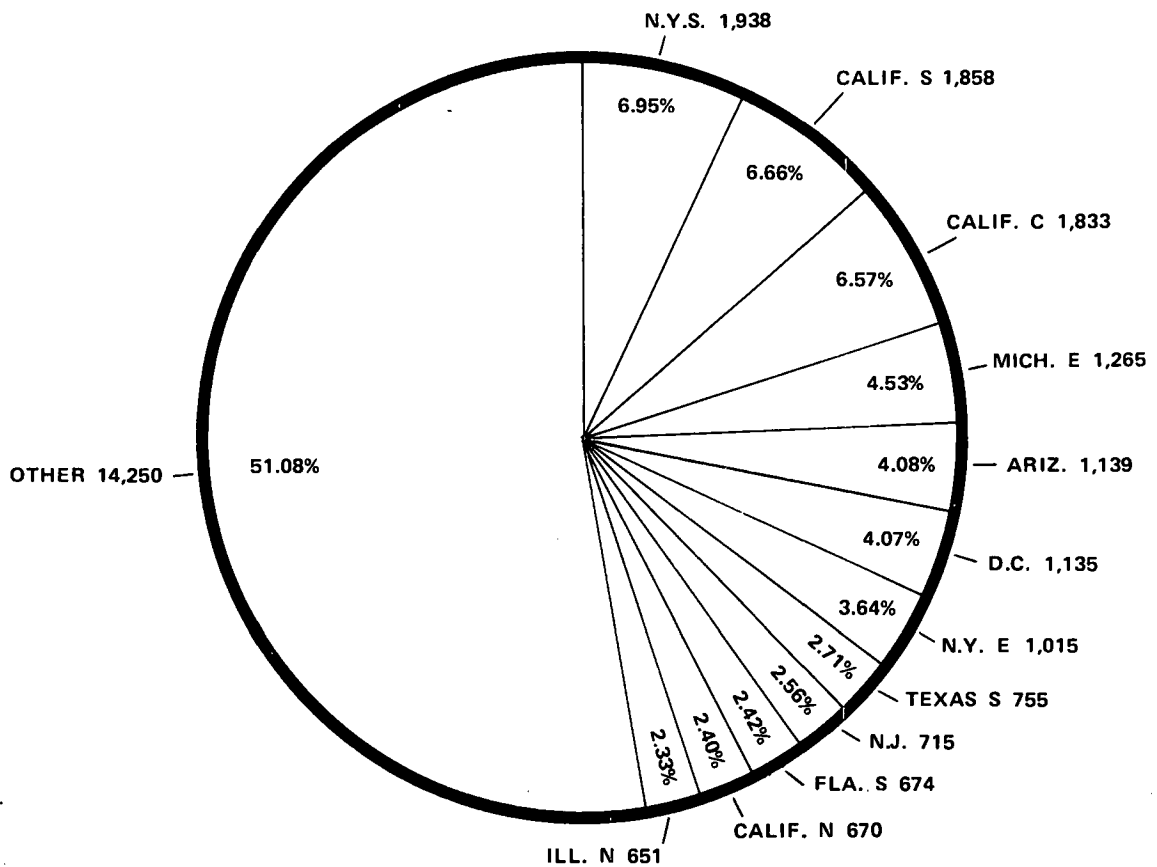

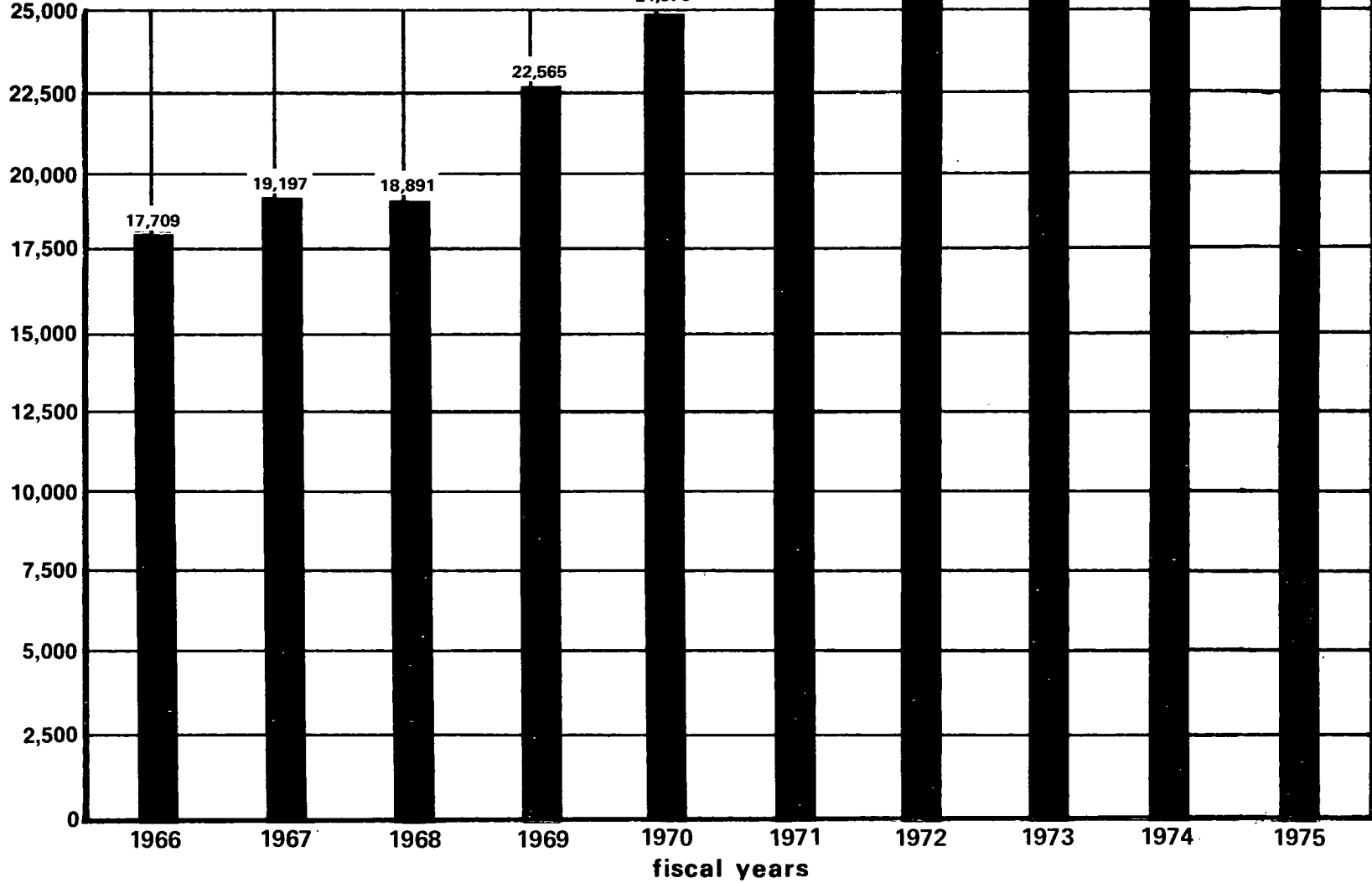

Total Cases Criminal 27,898 Civil 42,061

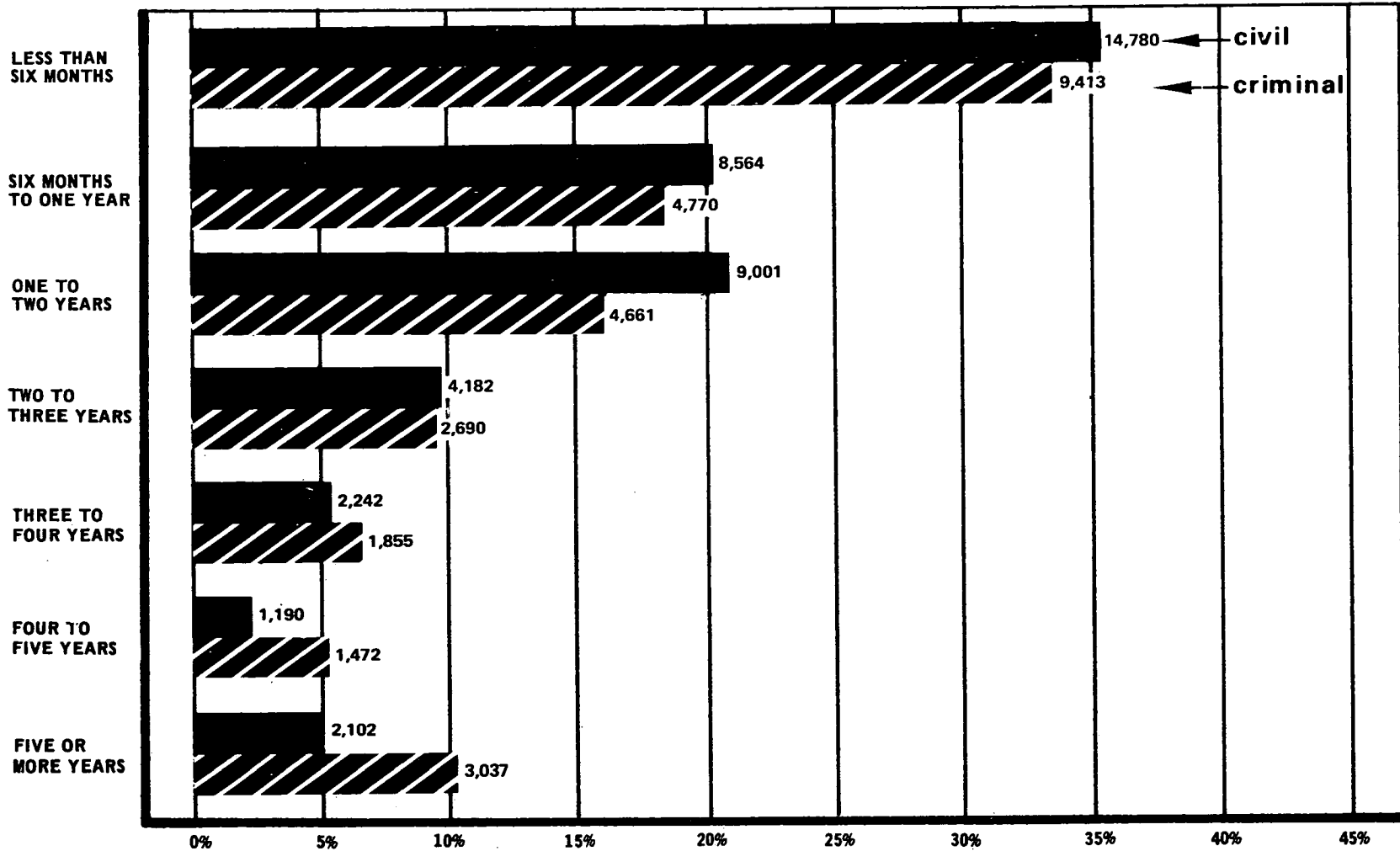

Total 44,087 Cases**

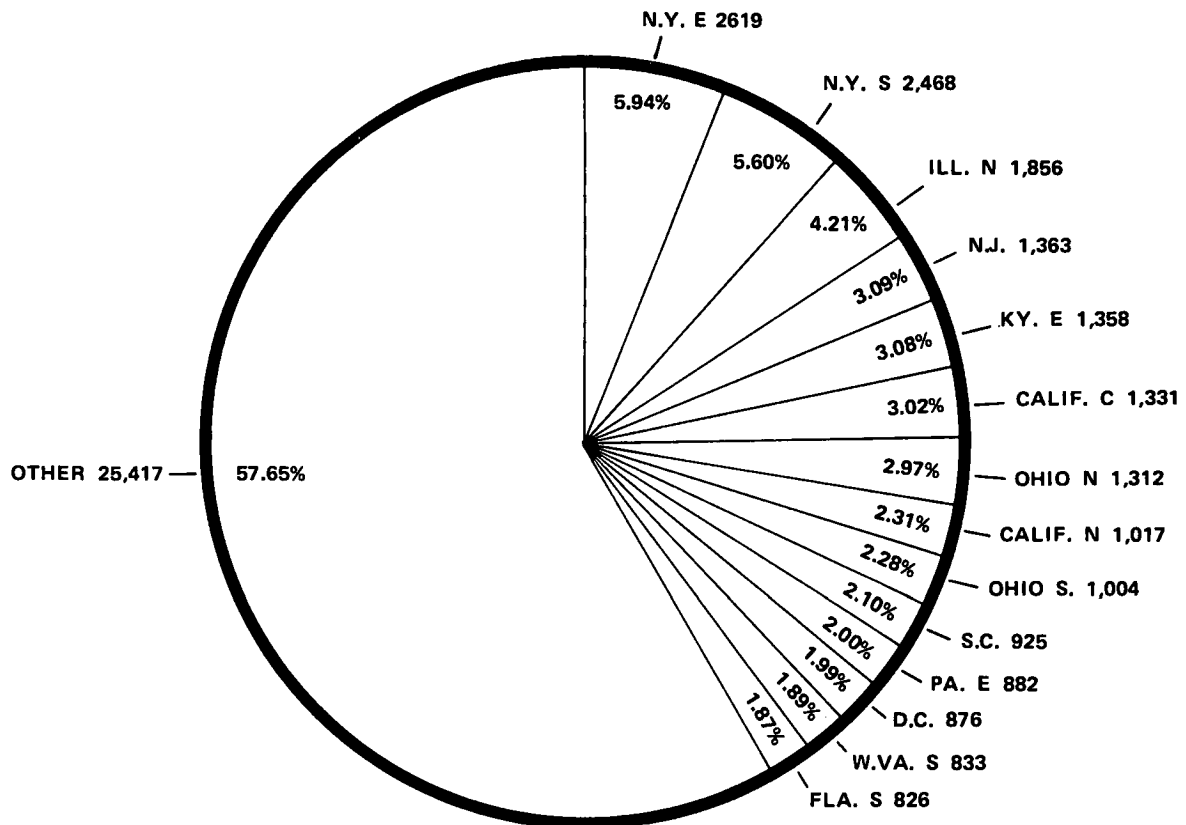

Total 44,087 Cases**

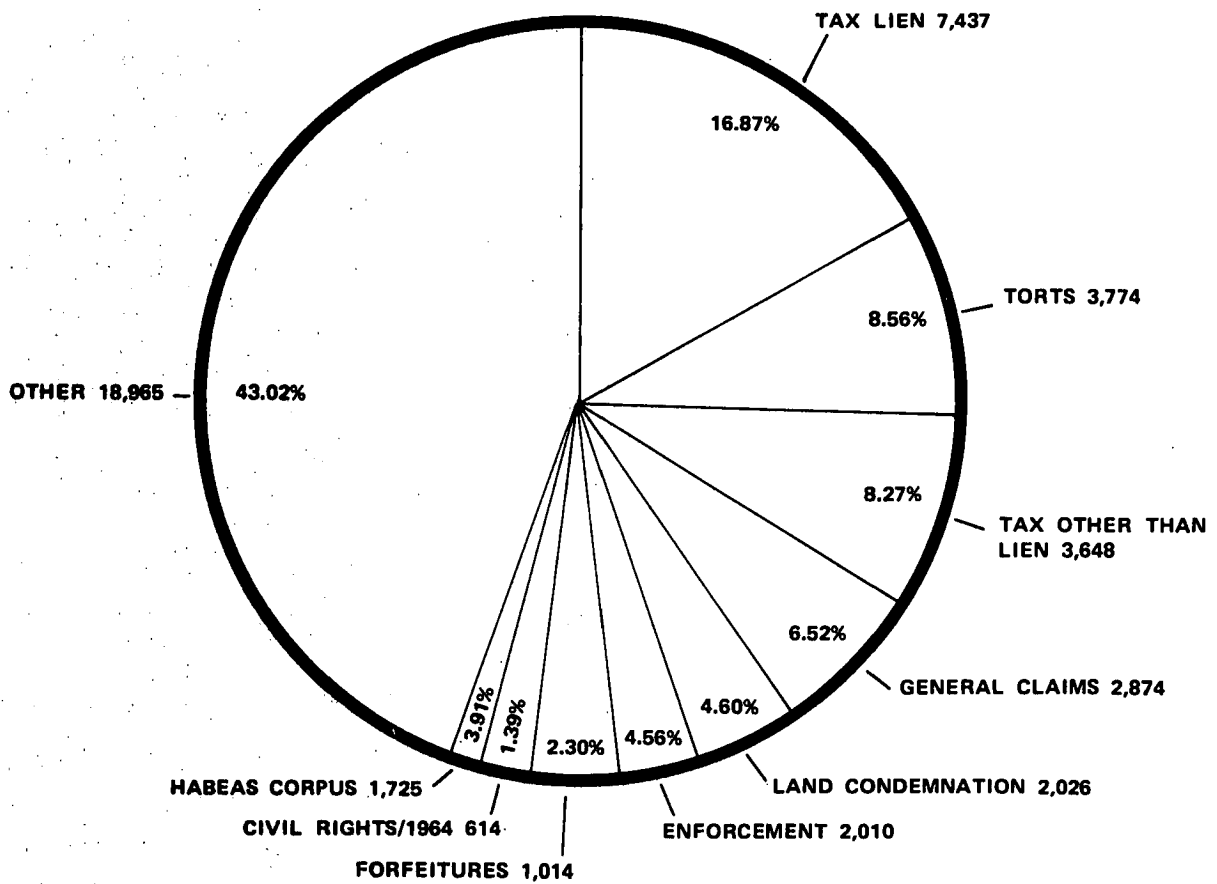

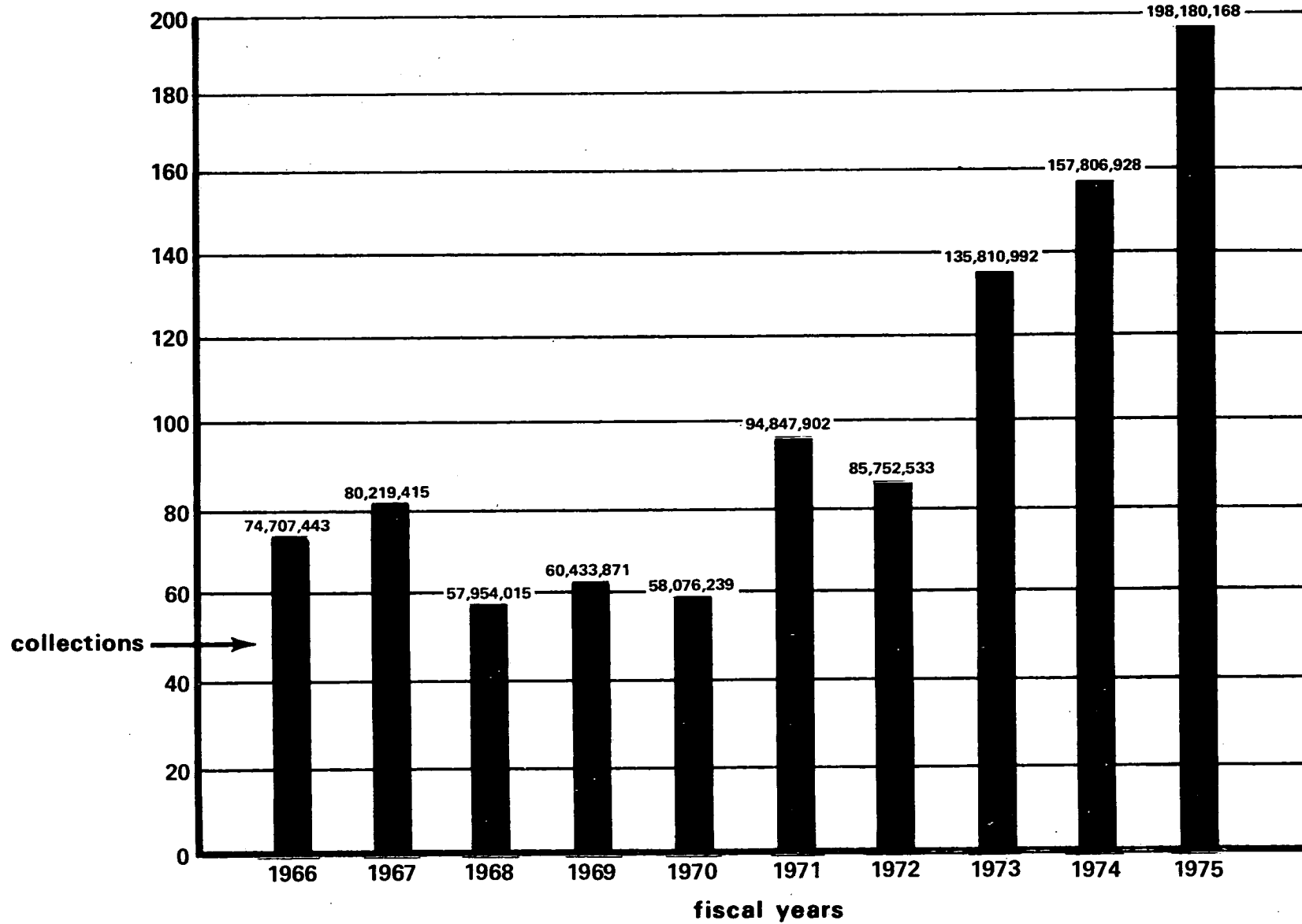
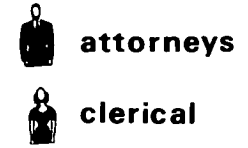


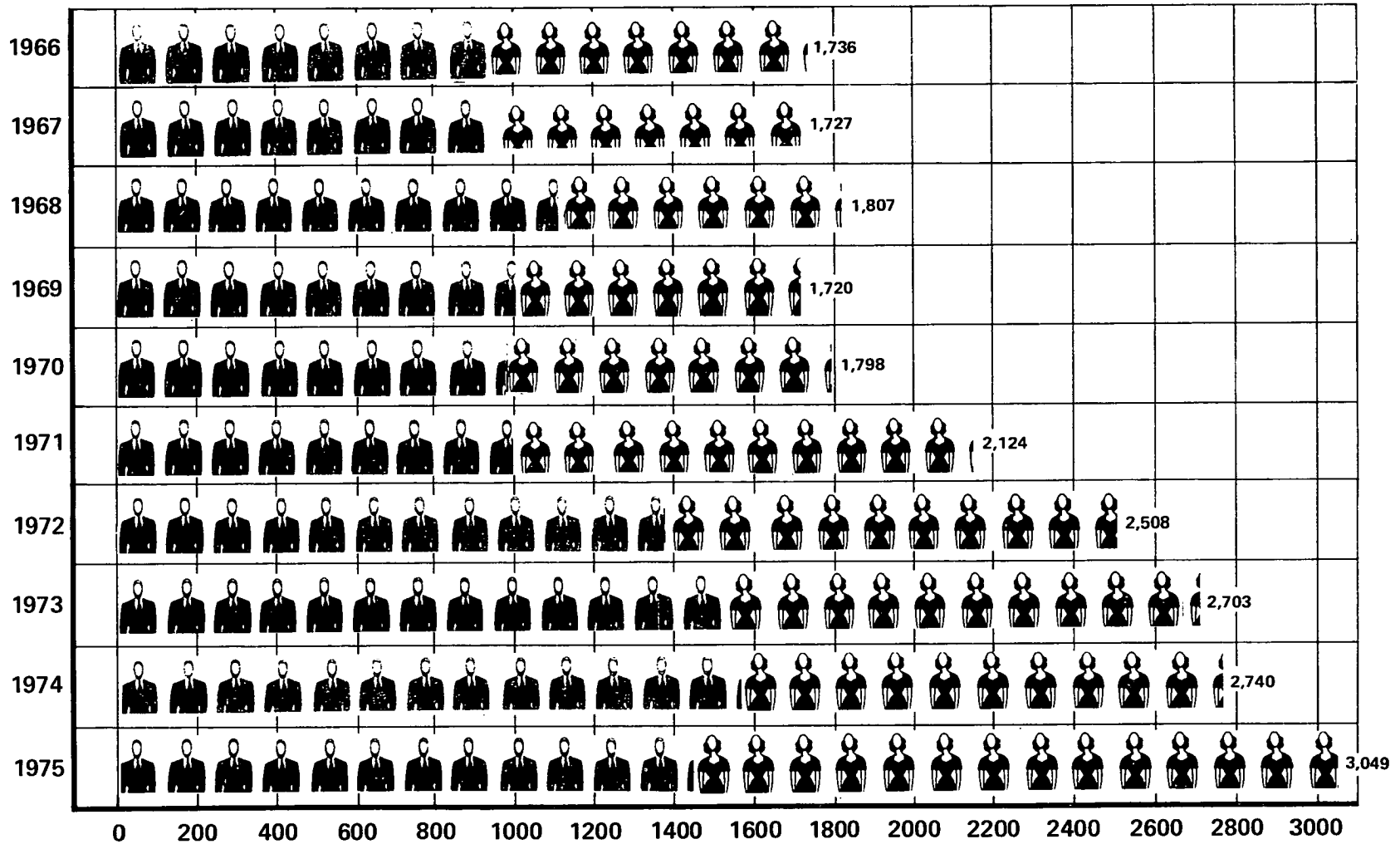
