

#### Year/Year GDP Growth, 2016:Q1 - 2018:Q2 (Projected)



### Small businesses are optimistic


#### Share of Small Businesses Reporting "Now Is a Good Time to Expand", 1974–2018

#### Unemployment Insurance Initial Claims as a Share of the Labor Force, 1948–2018


