526 students studied in 30 countries

361 students received a total of \$645,983 in scholarships and grants.

13 UNT students received the prestigious Benjamin A. Gilman Scholarship

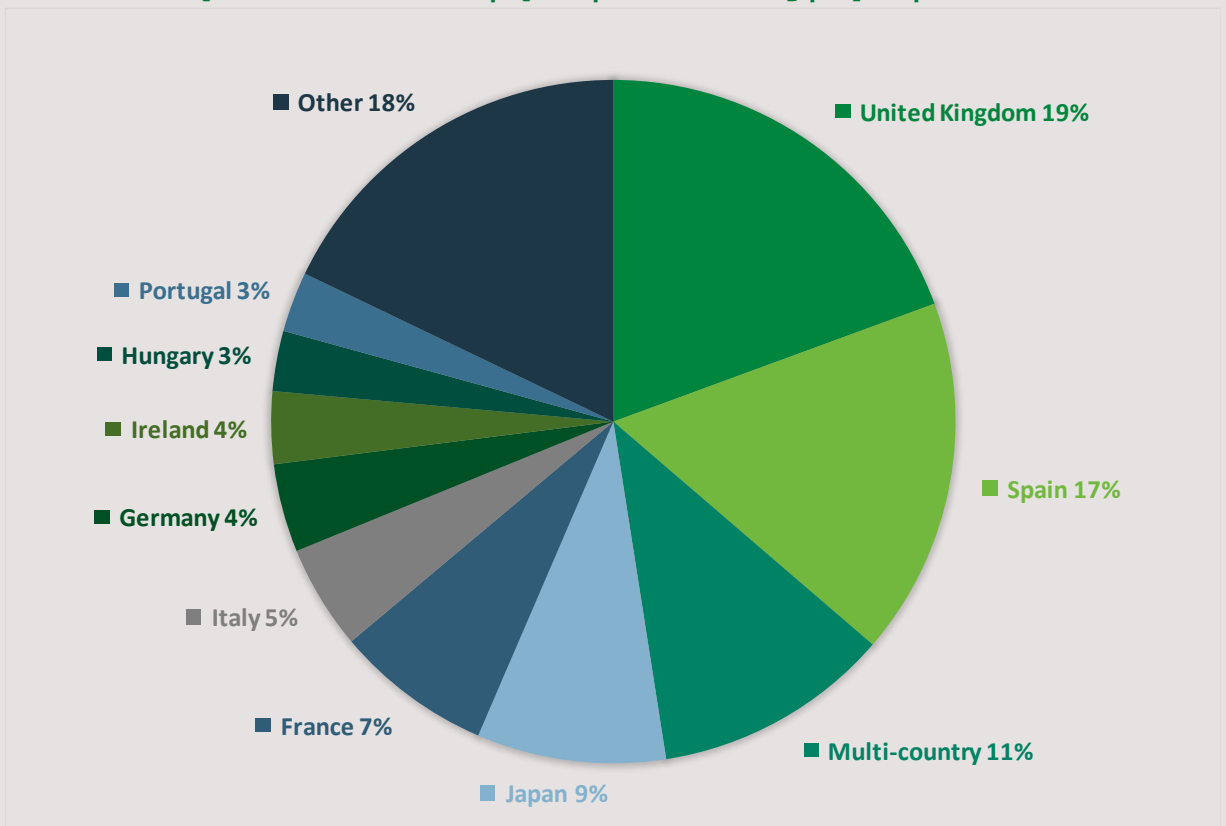

J-1 Exchange Scholars are researchers, professors and specialists from around the world, contributing greatly to UNT's Tier One Research University status.

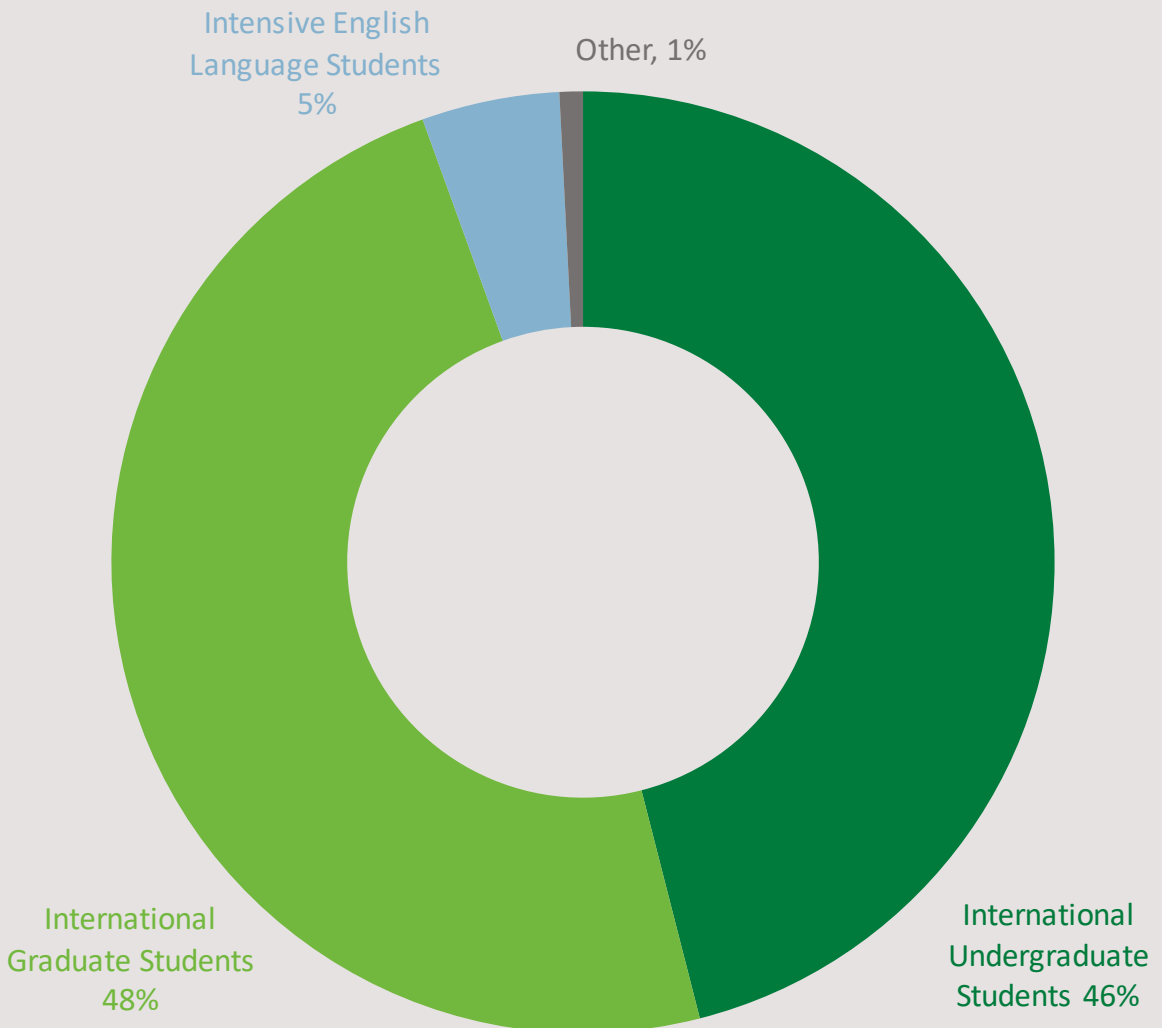

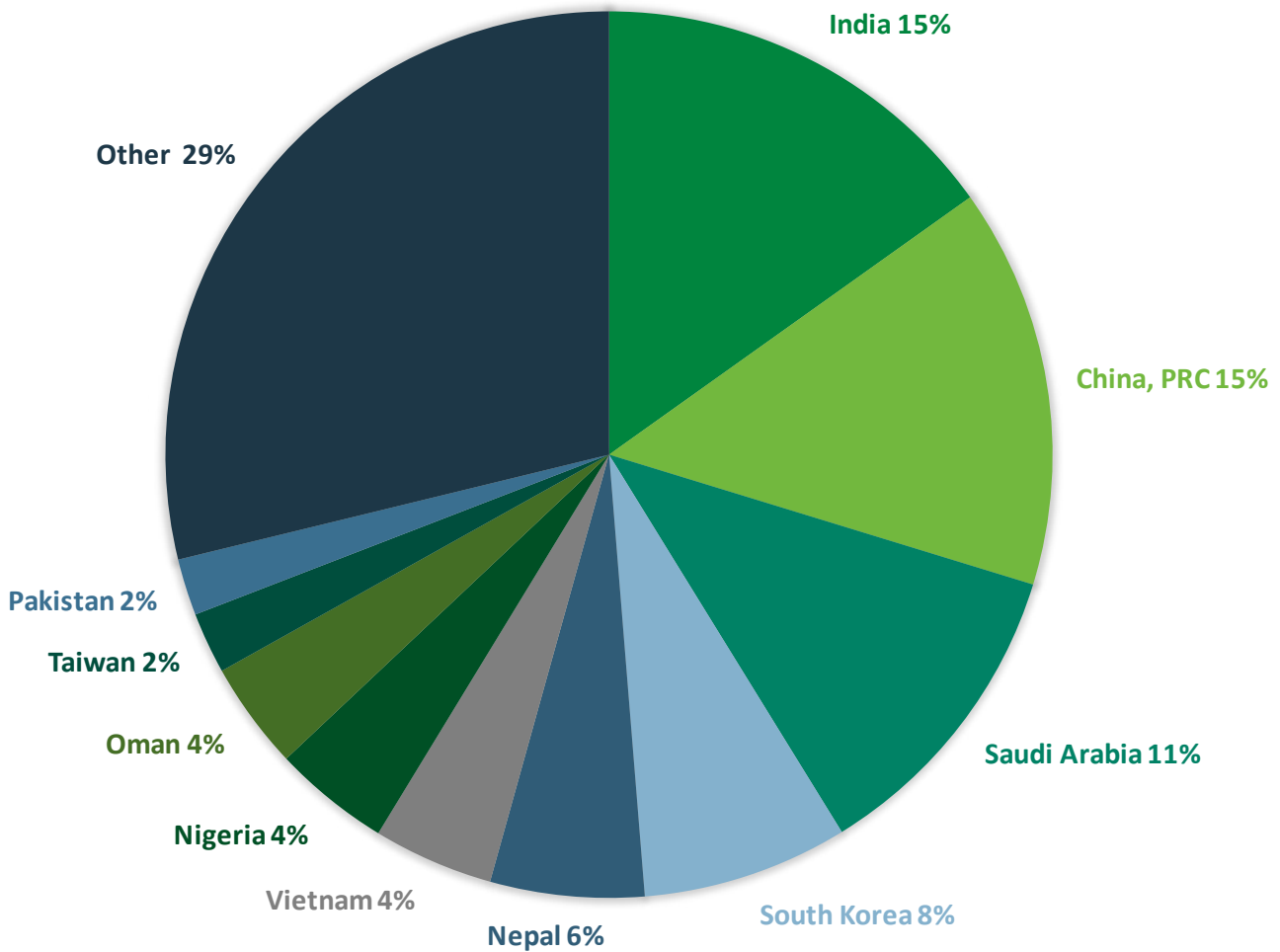
Total International Student Enrollment: 2,371
